COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Ginger S. Porter to serve as a member of the Guam Regional Transit Authority Board of Directors was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on October 11, 2013. The appointment packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on October 11, 2013. The appointment of Ginger S. Porter was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations on October 14, 2013.

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns and Future Generations convened a public hearing on December 10, 2013 at 10:05 a.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of Ginger S. Porter. The hearing was adjourned at 11:40 a.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas introduced the nominee, Ginger S. Porter, who was re-nominated by the Governor for the position. He first called Berni Grajek to provide testimony.

Berni Grajek stated that she and Ms. Porter have known one another for a long time, as they both work in the field of providing support services for individuals with disabilities. She stated that the nominee has been a staunch community advocate for individuals with disabilities especially in the area of public transportation. She mentioned that she has seen an increase of people using public transportation but states that more funding needs to go toward the improvement of Guam's public transportation system. Ms. Grajek praised Ms. Porter's prior service on the Board and said that she has made great contributions while in her position. She stated her support for the nomination of Ms. Porter.

Chairman San Nicolas mentioned that written testimony was submitted by Ben Servino, Director of DISID, and will be included in the record. He then recognized the nominee to provide testimony.

Ginger Porter spoke about several of the reasons why she would like to continue serving on the Board. She mentioned that the issue of transportation is a passion of hers. She mentioned some of the improvements that were made during her time on the Board. She identified the following as areas or issues that she wants to address if confirmed:

- advocate for customer service improvement pointing out the fact that she receives many calls from riders with concerns,
- establishment of a premium paratransit service structure as she feels it can benefit the community,
- initiation of an advisory committee that can help provide input on how to improve GRTA services,
- improve public visibility and perception of transit system,
- improve customer communication by getting information out to public through use of social media,
- implement software that makes it easier to communicate with riders with regards to travel routes and times,
- implement an easily identified and distinctive logo for GRTA fleet,
- attain more funding to support general operations.

Ms. Porter stated that she is familiar with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), federal regulations dealing with transit systems, and best practices for transit systems in the nation. She would like to continue serving on the Board so that she can bring ideas about what can and will work for our local transit system.

Chairman San Nicolas thanked Ms. Porter for her service on the Board and mentioned that she brings a wealth of institutional knowledge. He asked the status of the search for a permanent Executive Manager for GRTA, and inquired about the overall selection process.

Ms. Porter stated that several previous searches did not result in an individual being selected for the position. She stated that the Board is in the process of reopening the application process and leaving it open until it is filled. She stated that the position is not an easy job and requires someone who has experience and vision. She felt that the absence of a permanent Executive Manager has caused a domino effect and has left GRTA short-staffed.

Chairman San Nicolas agreed on the importance of having a permanent Executive Manager. He asked how long since the position was permanently filled.

Ms. Porter answered four years; since the inception of GRTA. She mentioned that prior to that the position was filled by an appointee of the Department of Administration.

Chairman San Nicolas asked about the status of the GRTA bus order.

Ms. Porter stated that she was aware that the order was ready to be sent.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that he has a member of his staff has routinely using the services of GRTA and documenting their experiences, and that the initial results have been positive.

Ms. Porter stated a previous experience she had taking the public transit, and how she had concerns with the condition of the bus and expressed them to management. She mentioned that her concerns were

immediately addressed and rectified. She stated that sometimes the service is good and other times it is unsatisfactory and it is up to the public to remain vigilant in ensuring that services are adequate by making concerns known.

Chairman San Nicolas asked if GRTA is still on a month to month contract with the current service provider.

Ms. Porter said yes.

Chairman San Nicolas inquired about the status of getting a contract that is more concrete.

Ms. Porter stated that, to her understanding, the bid packet and contract was near ready to be sent.

Chairman San Nicolas mentioned that one of the concerns with the GRTA routes are the bus stops, or lack thereof, and asked about the status of procuring additional bus shelters.

Ms. Porter stated that the bus shelter issue has been discussed by the Board. She mentioned that she would like to see more signage that clearly marks the shelter locations. She mentioned that there needs to be additional areas for seating. She also mentioned that there needs to be more of a focus on implementing overhead shelters rather than enclosed shelters. She again stated the need for increased funding to GRTA. She further stated that the system is not fully compliant with ADA. She mentioned that the paratransit has not been able to meet certain guidelines and requirements.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that a good step in the direction of addressing and improving those areas of concern is permanently filling the Executive Manager position.

Senator Tony Ada asked if GRTA is still on emergency procurement with the bus service provider.

Ms. Porter answered yes.

Senator Tony Ada asked how long emergency procurement has been in place and why.

Ms. Porter stated that it has been eight years. She mentioned that local law has prevented GRTA from negotiating the procurement of certain services such as management, which is not listed as an acceptable professional service. She stated that, when putting out a request for proposal, GRTA would have to list out and specify everything that is needed in order to guarantee the type of service necessary for its operations. She added that the office and bid process encountered delays but a request for proposal is ready to be sent out.

Senator Tony Ada inquired about the cost of the month to month emergency procurement.

Ms. Porter stated that GRTA pays per hour and was not sure about the total monthly costs. She added that it was difficult for GRTA to properly plan ahead because there is no long term contract in place to properly engage in financing.

Senator Tony Ada stated that the delays GRTA encountered may require lawmakers to revisit procurement law and see if certain aspects of the law need to be changed.

Ms. Porter stated that parts of the procurement law, such as the procurement of professional services, should be expanded or modified and those changes would allow for a better provision of service by

GRTA. She mentioned that it is difficult to write specifications for certain professional services which are needed by GRTA.

Senator Tony Ada asked if GRTA has a grant writer.

Ms. Porter answered that they do have a planner who writes grants.

Senator Tony Ada stated his support for Ms. Porter's nomination.

Senator Tommy Morrison thanked the nominee for her willingness to again serve. He asked if all the contracted busses are ADA compliant.

Ms. Porter stated that all busses are ADA compliant but admitted that there are times when all services, which are requested, cannot be met. She stated that having all busses be compliant is an improvement from previous years.

Senator Morrison asked the nominee about her thoughts, or the thoughts of GRTA, on privatization.

Ms. Porter stated that GRTA is partially privatized and some of the privatized functions have encountered problems. She said that public transportation is a service not a business adding that it never runs a profit. She stated that it is sensible to privatize certain parts of the operations while keeping others government run.

Senator Morrison indicated his support for the nomination.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that a reliable public transportation system is beneficial for the community and provides a community alternative for individuals not wanting to drive. He reiterated the importance of selecting a permanent Executive Manager so that the problems and challenges can be addressed and improvements can be made. He stated that this action will also help the Committee engage in more participatory oversight because there will be one specific individual responsible for the operations of GRTA. Chairman San Nicolas reiterated his support for the confirmation of the nominee.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Aviation, Ground Transportation, Regulatory Concerns, and Future Generations hereby reports out the nomination of Ginger S. Porter to serve as a member of the Guam Regional Transit Authority Board of Directors, for a term of four (4) years beginning, with the recommendation

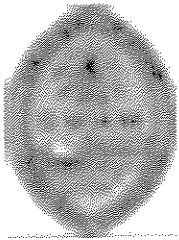

My name is Ben S. Servino, and I serve as the Director for the Department of Integrated
Services for Individuals with Disabilities (DISID).

I am submitting this written testimony in full support of the nomination of Ms. Ginger S.
Porter as a member of the Guam Regional Transit Authority (GRTA) Board of Directors.

I have had the distinct honor and privilege of working with Ms. Porter during her tenure
as one of the Deans at the Guam Community College (GCC) and in her role as the
Leadership & Systems Change Initiative Area Coordinator and Training Associate for
Transportation & Quality Assurance at the Guam Center for Excellence in
Developmental Disabilities Education, Research, and Service (CEDDERS) at UOG.

In 2011, I had worked closely with Ms. Porter in collaboration with the Board and staff at
GRTA to apply for funding from the U.S. Department of Transportation for the Veterans
Transportation and Community Living Initiative (VTCLI) Capital Grants Program to
establish a "One-Call, One-Click" Transportation Dispatch Center for military, veterans
and community transportation providers that are highly impacted by limited access to
public transit options.

The grant selection process was highly competitive, and after reviewing 70 eligible
proposals representing \$52 million in funding requests, the Federal Transit
Administration (FTA) awarded GRTA \$1.3 million to establish the "One-Call, One-
Click" Center within our region.

The "One-Call, One-Click" Center offers comprehensive information on local transportation options, and other community services, with just a single phone call or click of the mouse. Typically, such information is not available in one convenient place, and better local coordination will result in better services for veterans and nonveterans alike.

I truly feel that it was through Ms. Porter's diligence, collaborative input, research, time contribution, commitment, and encouragement that the VTCLI grant proposal was submitted and successfully approved for funding by FTA.

Ms. Porter should also be commended for her direct involvement in the coordination of community forums regarding public transportation that were hosted by CEDDERS and for the implementation of the various trainings targeting transit operators on safety and service for customers with disabilities and for transit riders regarding their rights and responsibilities.

I seek your consideration approval to allow Ms. Porter to continue serving as a member of the Board of Directors of GRTA and look forward to working collaboratively with her to help enhance access to local, affordable public transportation services for individuals with disabilities, military families and spouses, and wounded warriors on Guam.
