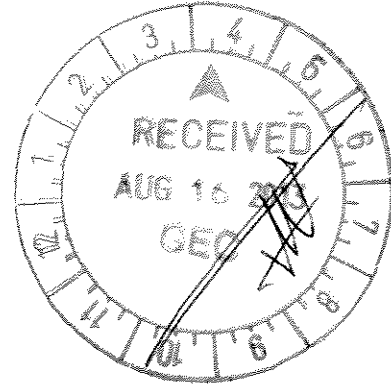



COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesia Affairs, Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform convened a public hearing on Tuesday, July 9, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of **Florida Sanchez to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board** [Length of Term: Three (3) Years] whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on June 6, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on June 6, 2013;
- Packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on June 12, 2013.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via e-mail and facsimile to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on June 28, 2013 (5-Day Notice), and again on July 3, 2013 (48-Hour Notice), thereby meeting the noticing requirements of the Open Government Law. Notices were also transmitted to various stakeholders and government agencies.

Senator Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing for the appointment of **Florida Sanchez to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board (GEPA)** to order at 9:00 A.M. and invited the panel to testify.

Senator Respicio called both appointees up, Ms. Florida Sanchez and Mr. Robert Perron along with the GEPA Administrator, Mr. Eric Palacios to testify. Senator Respicio noted that both appointees are currently serving under the GEPA Board and that these were re-appointments. He noted his appreciation for them to continue to serve on the Board. He asked them to continue to level the playing field and not provide any artificial barriers to businesses that would like to get a permit for any business operation they would like to have. He then gave the nominees and administrator the opportunity to provide testimony before the committee.

Ms. Florida Sanchez thanked the Committee for hearing her appointment from Governor Eddie B. Calvo. She stated that she has been on the board for about ten (10) years and appreciates working with the GEPA staff that are diligent, dedicated and probably overworked. She stated she has been with two (2) types of boards who come from different backgrounds and were very pragmatic. She feels that there is a lot of work to be done with GEPA and the community. She shared that she enjoys working with the board, especially because this is our island home which we are trying to protect.

Mr. Robert Perron thanked the Governor for re-nominating him to the GEPA Board and also thanked the Guam Legislature for their time and consideration of his nomination. He would like to see the Bottle Bill be fully implemented. He believes that it would help to keep the island clean and preserve valuable resources and reduce waste going into the Layon Landfill. He also looks forward to working with the hardworking people at the agency. He stated that with the recent losses that he has suffered, it is important for people to step up to fill these positions. He said that with his experience and training, he can have a positive impact with the agency.

Mr. Eric Palacios, Administrator of GEPA, provided oral testimony in support of both nominations. He stated that in his tenor as the administrator of GEPA, both of these individuals have been nothing but supportive for the agency. He noted that they are always quick to offer suggestions and solutions in working with them to achieve results. He also pointed out that they help the agency strike a balance. He stated that these two (2) board members make it a point to address issues and decisions objectively and will be a great asset to the board and the community.

Senator Respicio then opened the floor to senators for follow-up questions.

Senator V. Anthony Ada thanked the nominees for continuing to commit themselves to the department. He stated that their willingness to work for the people of Guam is truly admirable. He noted they have his full support.

Senator Christopher M. Duenas stated he was impressed they are willing to serve another term. He said they are there for a purpose and they are the gatekeepers when it comes to the environment and the well-being of our people. Senator Duenas gave them his full support for their nomination.

Senator Michael Lintiacco thanked the nominees for stepping up to continue working with the board. He noted they make great re-appointees and can share the same concerns for finding alternatives for our landfill. He hopes they pursue the endeavors that the board members have in improving our environment.

Senator Respicio thanked the panel for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Senator Respicio then declared that **appointment for Florida Sanchez to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board** was duly heard.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS
