COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education, Public Library and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on July 25, 2013 at 9:00 am in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Ms. Maria Snively to serve as a Student Member of the Guam Public Library System Board, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by the Governor of Guam on June 6, 2013, for a term of One (1) year;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on June 7, 2013;
- Appointment packet forwarded to the Committee for public consideration on June 10, 2013.

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on July 17, 2013, (5-Day Notice) and July 22, 2013 (48-Hour Notice) via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the committee report.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** called the nominee Ms. Snively to testify before the committee.

- **Ms. Snively's** testimony is appended to the committee report.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D** asked Ms. Snively to elaborate about her statement that the library could improve in the areas of reference books and artistic designs.
- Ms. Snively** explained that she was unable to find information at the library concerning a UOG class assignment. She commented the library needs to increase its resources.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D** asked if the library is lacking hard copy materials or internet access.
- Ms. Snively** replied it is important for students to have access to hard copy materials to conduct their research.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** asked the nominee to expand on her statement concerning artistic design.
- **Ms. Snively** replied that her generation enjoys visual concepts and they would like to see color and design within the library building.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** commented instead of the plain white walls.
- **Ms. Snively** replied yes.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D** asked the nominee how she would attract her peers to volunteer their services to the library.
- **Ms. Snively** recalled when she was in the national honor society, the society would participate in community services. She questioned why the national honor society did not assist the libraries.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** suggested reaching out to students, organizations or artists to provide artwork for the library.
- **Ms. Snively** agreed with the Speaker's suggestion.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** asked the nominee, how she would make the libraries more welcoming to both residents and tourists.
- **Ms. Snively** recommended that the staff should be more customer friendly to the patrons.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** expressed the importance of the library being family friendly and having the material resources available for all ages.
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** asked the nominee how she would envision the library being more family oriented.
- **Ms. Snively** replied she would like to have the library promote itself with street waves and the planting of flowers to improve the landscape of the libraries.

- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** appreciated the suggestions made by the nominee and the Speaker hopes that the library board listens to Ms. Snively's suggestion to heart. Speaker believes that Ms. Snively will be a breath of fresh air to the library board.

- **Vice Chairperson Yamashita, Ph.d.** thanked the nominee for her willingness to be a community leader. The Vice Chairperson stated the Speaker had raised many of the issues she was thinking about. The Vice Chairperson expressed confidence in the nominee that she will be thinking of ways to bring into realization different things to the library. The Vice Chairperson wanted the nominee to know that the library staff is working hard people faced with limited financial resources. The Vice Chairperson appreciated the nominee's statement about the importance of technology and making the library family oriented. The Vice Chairperson wished the nominee the best of luck and she suggested the nominee should always ask questions, because every question counts. The Vice Chairperson closed by thanking Ms. Snively for her willingness to be a community leader.

- **Senator Duenas** asked the nominee her area of study at the University of Guam.

- **Ms. Snively** replied she is majoring in history.

- **Senator Duenas** brought forward the nominee's answers which are part of the appointment packet application. The Senator stated that he was quite impressed with her answer to the question what is your concept of success: "I am successful if I lived for today, loving God with all I am and loving my neighbor as myself." The Senator expressed certainty that the nominee will do a great job and she should be a very vocal as a member of the board.

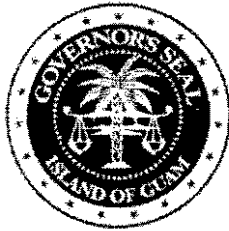
- **Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** asked Ms. Gogue to testify.
