COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 100-33 (COR) was introduced on May 20, 2015, by Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., Vice Speaker Benjamin Cruz, and Senator Tina Muna Barnes. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on May 20, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on June 3, 2015, in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill No. 100-33 (COR). The hearing convened at 2:00 p.m. and was adjourned at 2:43 p.m.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on May 27, 2015, and again on June 1, 2015. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura*'s website beginning on May 27, 2015.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas read the title of Bill No. 100-33 (COR) and yielded the floor to the bill's main author, Speaker Judith Won Pat, for her opening statement.

Speaker Judith Won Pat thanked Mr. Manny Duenas for his attendance and his efforts in managing fisheries in Guam's local waters. She stated the importance of improving and upgrading the fishermen's co-op facilities. Speaker Won Pat stressed the importance of extending the current deadline to use grant money for that purpose.

Mr. Manny Duenas stated that he is the lead person for the Guam Fishermen's Co-op project. He explained the project timeline and cost. He further explained that the Co-op Association has been reaching out for additional funding from other entities. Although he feels that December 31, 2015, is a reasonable deadline date, Mr. Duenas suggested that it be pushed back to a deadline date of March 31, 2016. He explained some of the financial and infrastructural challenges and restrictions the association has been facing with regards to construction. Mr. Duenas stated that any extension in the deadline would be welcomed.

Senator San Nicolas asked if the Co-op Association would prefer to extend the deadline even further than what is being proposed.

Mr. Duenas answered that a later deadline date would allow the association to handle any unforeseen factors with regards to the comingling of funds. He stated that he is hopeful that construction will commence in the coming months.

Senator San Nicolas stated that he will work with Speaker Won Pat to ensure that the bill's language be changed to accommodate the association's request. He thanked Mr. Duenas for his attendance and adjourned the hearing for Bill No. 100-33 (COR).

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Bill No. 100-33 (COR) was amended to reflect the recommendation of the Guam Fishermen's Cooperative Association to extend the deadline of the expenditure or encumbrance of the grant proceeds for the construction, repair, and improvement of the Guam Fishermen's Cooperative Association facility to March 31, 2016. That amended is reflected in both the title and body (page 2) of Bill No. 100-33 (COR).
