I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 101-33 (COR) was introduced by Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D. on May 20, 2015, and subsequently referred to the **Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication** on the same day.

The Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication convened a public hearing on Friday, June 12, 2015, beginning at 1:30PM in the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. The hearing for Bill No. 101-33 (COR) began at 1:43PM and ended at 1:54PM.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Benjamin J.F. Cruz announced Bill No. 101-33 (COR), and allowed the sponsor of the legislation to give a few remarks.

Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D. thanked Chairman Cruz and proceeded to provide her sponsor statement:

"In a letter from the Director of the [Department of] Public Health [and Social Services] (DPHSS) dated March, 31 2015, and addressed to myself, the Public Health Director [James W. Gillan] requested recruitment of a Program Coordinator IV (PC IV) from [the Bureau of Budget and Management Research] (BBMR); however, the recruitment document was returned by BBMR due to reference made to Public Law 28-187 and the Department of Administration's (DOA) Organizational Circular No. 07-023, which allows for the recruitment of competitive limited-term appointment positions only through federal grants or program resources. For this reason, the DPHSS appropriation of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) for a PC IV continues to be on hold.

"While DPHSS's Bureau of Social Services Administration (BOSSA) is the child welfare agency that receives funding through Title 20 through federal grant hiring, the PC IV position does not fall within the Title 20 statement and goals budget. So DPHSS has acknowledged that [it has] been participating in the monthly meetings with [Guam Department of Education] (GDOE) on the Early Childhood Education Planning Committee to address the phasing in of the [pilot school program in four (4) schools] and they recommended that the money be shifted to GDOE to supplement funds for the Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K) Program.

"However, [given] what we have done [since the passage of Vice Speaker Cruz's Bill No. 66-33 (COR)] appropriated basically One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) of the reserve of the [Territorial Educational Facilities Fund] (TEFF) to the same program, was that there was a request by GDOE for two (2) things: 1) To complete the printing of *Chamoru* Studies textbooks for *Chamoru* teachers at Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000); and 2) the remaining Fifteen [Thousand Dollars] (\$15,000) for them to carry out the [Memorandum of Understanding] (MOU) between GDOE [and The Ayuda Foundation] for Service Learning to service the school children."

Chairman Cruz recognized the sole individual present to testify, Former Senator Carlotta A. Leon Guerrero, and gestured for her to proceed.

Senator Carlotta A. Leon Guerrero thanked Chairman Cruz and proceeded to provide testimony in support of the legislation in her capacity as Executive Director of The Ayuda Foundation:

"It is always an honor to be here, and it is an honor to testify in support of Speaker Won Pat's support of the Service Learning MOU that we have created with GDOE. We have been involved with Service Learning since about [School Year] (SY) 2011, 2012—it went into effect during that [school] year. Although [Bill No. 154-30 (COR)] was passed in 2009, the Legislature gave a startup date of

[SY] 2011-2012, [which] is when we got involved.

"We wrote several grants, working with [the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration] (NOAA) to start up a website [and] to participate in the Service Learning Coordinating Council to begin figuring out [how to implement Public Law 30-53] that became the mandate. We began to work very closely with GDOE, and we came up with an MOU assigning we are going to do this, and they are going to do this.

"And so what we have right now, the situation we have is that fourteen thousand (14,000) school children have to perform twenty (20) hours of service learning a year for ninth (9th), tenth (10th) and eleventh (11th) [grade], and fifteen (15) hours for their senior year—a total of seventy-five (75) hours. They cannot graduate and they cannot go on to the next year until they have performed [the] sufficient [number] of Service Learning hours [for the grade level that they are trying to complete].

"The idea behind [the Service Learning requirement] is to make the students realize that they can make a difference in their community now, using what they know and what they have learned in school now.

"So just to give you an idea of the value [of] Service Learning, I just took the fourteen thousand (14,000) number [of school children], multiplied it by twenty (20), and that is two hundred eighty thousand (280,000) hours a year of volunteer hours [provided by] healthy people [who] have to go out into the community and do good deeds. If you multiply that [number of volunteer hours] by a round figure of Eight Dollars (\$8.00)—that comes up to [approximately] Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,200,000) of what this law has the opportunity to translate into projects that would benefit our community.

"So what has happened since we got started, we've been putting our website together. We haven't launched it yet because we have a lot of training and every time we get close to launching it, we have another training with teachers, principals and students—they ask to fine tune it. They want more: they add another section to it; they want to make sure that the teachers have a role in making the projects; [they need] the students to get registered.

"The sort of degree of technical ability this website has is at the request of everybody. If there is a young man from Simon [A.] Sanchez [High School] (SSHS) is down at the [Manell-Geus] watershed (in Merizo) on a Saturday for three (3) hours, and he has an iPhone or whatever the device is, that will show up [on the website]. It will show up and show him tracking the watershed from this time to this time to verify [his activity] for his teachers or [to alert] anyone [from whom] he is seeking support [with a message] saying, 'Hey, come support me in the Malesso watershed.'

"The website designer that we have been working with is GuamWEBZ. They do websites for the University of Guam (UOG) for [its] registration process and for the Department of Revenue and Taxation, so they are used to [creating websites that handle heavy traffic].

"And since then we've started marching this out and doing the trainings, we've been having [requests from] the private schools, [Guam Community College] (GCC), and UOG to join. So [the website] just keeps getting bigger before we launch and more specifically, more people want to join so that's the situation that we have right now.

"So all the money that has been put in this [directory] to date has been from NOAA—grant writing to NOAA under the category of Marine Environmental Education, trying to get kids excited about going into marine and environmental projects. So this will be the first time that the government of Guam will be putting money into this Service Learning [-related] project, so I stand in full support of this appropriation."

Speaker Won Pat addressed Senator Leon Guerrero:

"I just wanted to thank you. Most of the time when people think of these Service Learning [projects], that it's just to do whatever kind of projects there are, but really you broke it down: it's fourteen thousand (14,000) school children and there's twenty (20) hours they will do in that year and of course you multiply the minimum wage by [the annual total of service learning hours] and that comes out to [approximately] Two Million Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,200,000). I just think that's phenomenal. I know there are places that can't afford to hire some individuals, and I think [the Service Learning requirement] gives our students a head start in terms of planning a career and giving back to the community. Thank you very much."

Chairman Cruz added:

"And over the [course of] last week, I had the honor and the pleasure of representing the Legislature at each of the [graduation ceremonies for GDOE high schools]; you really should attend [them]. I went to the George Washington High School (GWHS) graduation the other day, and out of the top ten (10) students, five (5) were [members of] Marine Mania. The [class valedictorian], a Marine Mania member, spoke about saving the Shark and said, 'If you have any questions, see me afterwards.'

"The valedictorian and salutatorian addresses [delivered during the GWHS graduation ceremony] were the best out of the three (3) high school [graduation ceremonies] I have attended so far [this year]; [they] have been phenomenal. You would be so impressed. [They have] brought me to tears at all three (3)

graduations because the character—the depth of character among these graduates is absolutely phenomenal. I know that there is limited space [at these events] but I have been lucky to get in since I'm giving [legislative] resolutions, but to listen to their speeches—we should all be very, very proud of our young graduates. I had thought I would give a plaque for the young students. This has been the best in the ten (10) years I've been attending commencements. I just wanted to put that on the record."

On account that there were no other individuals present to testify, **Chairman Cruz** considered Bill No. 101-33 (COR) heard.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

RE: Universal Preschool Program for 4-Year Old Children

Dear Madam Speaker:

In accordance with Public Law 32-181, we hereby present a report on the implementation of the phased-in Universal Preschool Program.

Public Law 32-181 allocated \$75,000 to the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) for the salary and benefits for a Competitive Limited Term Appointment Preschool Program Coordinator IV (PC IV) position. The PC IV position shall be assigned to the Bureau of Social Services Administration (BOSSA) of the DPHSS. The PC IV shall be responsible for collaborating with all community partners involved in early childhood education such as the Department of Education (DOE), DPHSS, Guam Early Learning Council (ELC), licensed child care centers, and others in order to plan, develop and sustain a Universal Preschool Program. Additionally, the PC IV shall conduct research and apply for federal grants and other funding to help sustain the program.

For the period October 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015, the following have been accomplished:

- 1. The DPHSS has collaborated with community partners such as the Guam DOE, Head Start Program, Special Education Program, and members of the Guam Early Learning Council (ELC) relative to the planning of the Universal Preschool Program.
- 2. The DPHSS has assigned BOSSA as the Lead Unit to facilitate the implementation of the phased-in Universal Preschool Program.
- 3. The DPHSS has requested recruitment of the PC IV from the Bureau of Budget and Management Research, (BBMR) however, the recruitment document was returned by BBMR due to reference made to Public Law 28-187 and Department of Administration's Organizational Circular No. 07-023 which allows for the recruitment of Competitive Limited

Term Appointment positions only through federal grant or program resources. For this reason, the DPHSS appropriation of \$75,000 for the PC IV position continues to be on hold.

While the BOSSA is the child welfare agency that receives its funding stream through the Title XX federal grant, hiring the PC IV position through this federal grant does not fall within the Title XX State Plan goals and budget.

- 4. The DPHSS has actively participated in monthly meetings with DOE's Early Childhood Education Planning Committee to address the phasing in of four pilot schools that will implement the Pre-kindergarten Program commencing school year 2015-2016.
- 5. The DPHSS has reviewed Early Childhood resources to address the importance of meeting the needs of young children.

The DPHSS kindly requests that the funds of \$75,000 that are on hold be used towards resources such as supplies and equipment that will be needed to supplement funds for the DOE Pre-kindergarten Program for the upcoming school year. As the DPHSS is unable to recruit for the PC IV, we request that the responsibility to recruit for this position be shifted to the DOE.

As the public child welfare agency, BOSSA has an important responsibility in the efforts to promote universal preschool. The BOSSA will begin to adopt policies and procedures to maximize the enrollment of foster children and children in emergency homeless shelters in preschool in order that there is increased access to early learning for this vulnerable population.

At this time, the DPHSS and BOSSA will continue to collaborate with DOE, Head Start Program, ELC, child care providers, and all other public and private early childhood education partners in order to effectively plan and ensure standards for high quality preschools on Guam.

I thank you for the opportunity to present this report.
