COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 103-33 (LS) was introduced on May 26, 2015, by Senator Michael F.Q. San Nicolas. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on May 28, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on July 17, 2015, in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill No. 103-33 (LS). The hearing convened at 2:00 p.m. and was adjourned at 3:30 p.m.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on July 10, 2015, and again on July 14, 2015. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura*'s website beginning on July 10, 2015.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas read the title of Bill No. 103-33 (LS) and explained that the bill seeks to put before the voters during the next election the question of which public project, if any, the government of Guam should fund through borrowing. Chairman San Nicolas stated that there are various projects that are mentioned as priorities and he would like to give the voters the opportunity to decide which, if any, should be. The bill lists

the following as options: 1) repair of roads ineligible for federal funding, 2) new or repaired educational facilities, 3) a new adult correctional facility, 4) a new Guam Memorial Hospital facility, or 5) no additional public borrowing for any project. He stated that the people should be the ultimate decision makers with regards to government borrowing and how to spend the money. Chairman San Nicolas pointed out that existing law prohibits government borrowing in excess of \$25 million without first going before the people for a vote. He further stated that, since the enactment of that law, the government has gone to the bond market nine times which resulted in the borrowing of approximately \$1.2 billion without being voted on by the people. Chairman San Nicolas concluded the hearing by stating that he is open to including additional items on the "priority" list and ultimately wanted to ensure that the public has a say as to what the government prioritizes.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development hereby reports out Bill No. 103-33 (LS), with the recommendation TO REPORT Our ONLY.

I MINA'TRENTAITRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2015 (FIRST) Regular Session

Bill No. 103-33(LS)

Introduced by:

Michael F.Q. San Nicolas $(\mathcal{P}_{\mathcal{A}})$

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEGISLATIVE SUBMISSION OF A NON-BINDING OUESTION DURING THE 2016 GENERAL ELECTION TO DETERMINE PUBLIC SUPPORT FOR PUBLIC BORROWING ADDITIONAL FOR CAPITAL CATEGORIES OF **IMPROVEMENT** PROJECTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1.Short Title.This Act *shall* be cited as the "Responsible
3 Public Borrowing Choice Act."

Section 2.Legislative Findings and Intent. *LiheslaturanGuåhan* finds that the property re-valuation will increase the Government of Guam's debt ceiling by hundreds of millions of dollars. This presents an opportunity to enhance the quality of life for the people of Guam, provided that any additional borrowing is invested in needed capital improvement projects.

I Liheslatura finds that while the revaluation of properties presents an
 opportunity for the potential borrowing, the amount available with respect
 to our debt ceiling limits our ability to fund projects.

1 Liheslatura further finds that the Government of Guam has several 2 potential priorities to address, including the repair of roads ineligible for 3 federal funding, the construction or repair of educational facilities, the 4 construction of a new Adult Correctional Facility (ACF), and the 5 construction of a new Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) facility.

6 *I Liheslatura* further finds that while borrowing could be initiated by 7 the introduction of legislation by any Senator, the people should be given 8 the opportunity to express their opinion on what kind of capital 9 improvement project, if any, should be prioritized for funding by public 10 borrowing.

I Liheslatura further finds that, since July 29, 1998, Public Law 24-222 11 12 has disallowed the issuance of General Obligation Bonds in excess of 13 Twenty-Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000) without approval of the people 14 in an election. Since the enactment of this law, there have been nine (9) instances of bond borrowing with gross borrowing of one billion two 15 16 hundred thirteen million thirty-five thousand dollars (\$1,213,035,000), none 17 of which had received the approval of the people in an election required by 18Public Law 24-222.

19 It is therefore the intent of *I LiheslaturanGuåhan* to provide for a 20 Legislative Submission on the question of the capital improvement projects 21 that the voters of Guam believe should be funded by public borrowing, to 22 fully understand the will of the majority with respect to projects funded 23 with public borrowing.

1	Section 3.Question to be Put to the Voters. The Guam Election
2	Commission, subject to the provisions hereinafter set forth, shall put to the
3	voters the question described in Section 4 of this Act. The question <i>shall</i> be
4	submitted during the 2016 General Election.
5	Section 4.Public Borrowing Choice.(a) The question put to voters
6	shall be:
7	"Please vote for one (1) of the following list of projects which
8	you believe should be funded by public borrowing:
9	() 1. Repairof roads ineligible for federal funding.
10	() 2. New or repaired Educational Facilities (Schools).
11	() 3. A new Adult Correctional Facility (Prison).
12	() 4. A new Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) Facility.
13	() 5. Noadditional public borrowing for any project."
14	Section 5.Voter Information Pamphlet.Notwithstanding any
15	provision of law to the contrary, arguments shall be made pursuant to the
16	provision of this Section. For the purposes of the arguments required by 3
17	GCA §§ 16507 and 16508, one (1) Member of <i>I Liheslaturashall</i> be selected by
18	the Speaker to draft an argument in favor of each of the respective options
19	provided in §3 of this Act, but no argument against any option shall be
20	required or made. Each argument shall not exceed two hundred (200)
21	words in length. For the purposes of 3 GCA §§ 16503, 16504, 16505, 16506,
22	16507, and 16509(c), the references to arguments, whether in favor or

against,*shall* be construed to mean the arguments, pursuant to this Section,
 in favor of each of the respective optionsprovided in §3 of this Act.

3 Section 6.Transmittal of Results.The Guam Election Commission 4 *shall* transmit the total number of votes cast for each proposal and the 5 percentage of total votes cast for the proposals to *I Maga'lahenGuåhan* to 6 the Speaker of *I LiheslaturanGuåhan* within thirty (30) days of the conclusion 7 of the 2016 General Election.





Per information received from the Executive Director of the Guam Election Commission (GEC), the cost for printing of public notices, voter pamphiets, and the mailing of these notices to each registered voter is estimated at \$60,000. However, there is a larger potential fiscal impact due to the proposed legislation enabling the people of Guam to select a project to be funded by public borrowing. Public borrowing will result in debt service payments along with the obligation to cover the cost of corresponding interest rates. The Bureau is unable to determine the potential cost of the public borrowing at this time due to the cited projects in the proposed legislation being significantly different in terms of overall scope of project.


