The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesian Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Monday, June 22, 2015 at 6:00 P.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Bill No. 104-33 (LS)-** "AN ACT TO REPEAL 19GCA CHAPTER 22; TO REPEAL 5GCA §3120 AND ADD A NEW ARTICLE 3 TO 22GCA DIVISION 1 CHAPTER 1 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR," by Senator Frank F. Blas, Jr. and Senator James V. Espaldon and history is as follows:

AN ACT TO REPEAL 19GCA CHAPTER 22; TO REPEAL 5GCA §3120 AND ADD A NEW ARTICLE 3 TO 22GCA DIVISION 1 CHAPTER 1 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Guam Department of Labor's purpose is to foster, promote and develop the welfare of wage earners on Guam, to improve their working and living conditions, and to advance their opportunities for occupational training and profitable employment. Further, the Agency for Human Resource Development (AHRD) is responsible for the coordination of manpower needs, assessment and employment programs funded under the provisions of local and federal statutes as well as to administer workforce development programs and to seek, apply and otherwise obtain federal, private and other funds for use in manpower and other programs. I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that responsibilities of the Department of Labor and of AHRD seem to overlap in areas related to employment assessment and training. In other jurisdictions and in the federal system, the Department of Labor tends to be the lead umbrella agency for all manpower development, employment assistance and work related regulatory enforcement. I Liheslaturan

1 Guåhan believes that a more cohesive and focused effect may be gained by manpower and 2 employment programs being administered under one department. The Governor, in Executive 3 Order 2015-01, has moved in this direction by placing AHRD under the administrative 4 supervision of the Department of Labor. It appears that previous legislatures envisioned the 5 need to change the nature of AHRD by including a provision in law which causes AHRD to 6 cease to exist if the agency... "is not selected or authorized to administer any federal or local 7 programs...". The transfer of administrative supervision of AHRD to the Department of Labor 8 may be construed by some as AHRD no longer being authorized to administer federal programs 9 on its own, thus ceasing to exist under statute. However, such programs still exist under the 10 administration of the Department of Labor so the resources possessed by AHRD may be needed by the Department to continue providing the services funded by those federal programs. To ensure that existing employees of AHRD are minimally impacted. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 13 that establishing a corresponding division within the Department of Labor is appropriate to receive such resources.

Section 2. 19GCA CHAPTER 22 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. 5GCA §3120 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. A new Article 3 is hereby added to 22GCA Division 1 Chapter 1 to read:

"Article 3. Division of Workforce Development and Training.

§1301. Agency. On the effective date of this Act, the Agency for Human Resources Development shall cease to exist as a Department of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam. The Agency shall be absorbed into the Government of Guam Department of Labor as a division of that department and is hereby renamed the Division of Workforce Development and Training.

§1302. Purpose. There is hereby established within the Department of Labor of the government of Guam what is known as the Division of Workforce Development and Training.

The Division of Workforce Development and Training will be responsible for the coordination of manpower needs, assessment and employment programs funded under the provisions of local statutes and of federal statutes. This responsibility shall not be construed to deny any other entity of the Government of Guam from carrying out its regularly assigned functions.

The Division of Workforce Development and Training is also authorized to seek, apply, and other sources obtain funds from the federal government and from private and other sources for use in manpower and other programs which fall within the purpose and functions of the Division as provided herein.

- **§1303. Definitions.** The following words and phrases, when used in this chapter shall have the following meaning:
 - (a) 'Division' means the Guam Department of Labor Division of Workforce Development and Training
 - (b) 'Director' means the Director of the Guam Department of Labor
 - (c) 'Employees' means employees of the Guam Department of Labor
- §1304. Rules and Regulations. Rules and Regulations. The director may develop and adopt rules and regulations to insure that the administration of federal and/or local programs comply with standards set by the federal and/or local government as a condition to receipt of federal and/or local funds, and local policies and laws, including the Administrative Adjudication Act. The Director, also pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Act, shall develop procedures, written policies and adopt rules with regard to planning, implementing, monitoring, evaluating and reporting the Division's programs.
- §1305. Employment. As a result of merger of departments, all classified employees shall retain their job title, pay grade and step at the time of transfer. The

Director may transfer persons in redundant or unnecessary positions to other divisions contingent on funding availability.

§ 1306. Personnel Rules. The Rules adopted by the Director of the Department of Administration subject to criteria established by Chapter 4 of Title 4 of GCA, governing the selection, promotion, performance evaluation, demotion, suspension, and other disciplinary action shall be applicable to employees of the Division.

§1307. Effective Date and Transfer. On the effective date of this Act, all working capital, accounts payable and receivable, all books, records, applications, assets, liabilities, agreements, privileges and employees of the Agency for Human Resources Development presently existing pursuant to Public Law 17-81 shall be transferred to the Guam Department of Labor, Division of Workforce Development and Training established under this article. The Guam Department of Labor will honor any existing Memoranda of Understanding or the similar agreements entered into with the Agency for Human Resource Development prior to the enactment of this Act.

Any person accepting employment under this section, excluding the Director, Deputy Director and Private Secretary will receive not less than the rate of compensation he was receiving immediately before the transfer. Any person accepting employment under this section will receive not less than the rate of compensation he was receiving immediately before the transfer date.

This Act shall become effective upon enactment.

§1308. Authorization to Administer Services. The Director of Labor is authorized to administer federal and local programs pursuant to the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and the newly authorized Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) signed into law on July 22, 2014 and provisions to take effect on July 1, 2015.

§1309. Guam Workforce Investment Board. The Guam Workforce Investment Board shall have the same authority and functions with respect to programs administered pursuant to this Article, as that provided in the Workforce Investment Act, Public Law Number 105-220 and the Workforce Innovations and Opportunity Act of 2014.

Dear Senator Respicio:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on Bill No. 104-33.

President Barack Obama signed the **Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)** into law on July 22, 2014. WIOA is designed to help job seekers access employment, education, training, and support services to succeed in the labor market and to match employers with the skilled workers they need to compete in the global economy. The enactment of WIOA provides opportunity for reforms to ensure the American Job Center system is job-driven—responding to the needs of employers and preparing workers for jobs that are available now and in the future. WIOA supersedes the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and amends the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act, the Wagner-Peyser Act, and the Rehabilitation Act Amendments of 1998.

Federally funded programs under Titles I, II, III, and IV administered by State recipients are encouraged to reform their workforce delivery and service designs that is in line with the intent and spirit of WIOA. Additionally, programs such as Housing, NAP/SNAP, and other workforce related funded programs all cater to the same population of individuals seeking to become self-sufficient are all considered and identified as part of the workforce ecosystem. The approach of a wrap-around and holistic service delivery is key to the success of individuals and employers alike. Programs working in "silo or stand-alone" are not recognized as practical nor aligned to the intents of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 now superseded by WIOA.

Bill No. 104-33 to merge AHRD with GDOL is aligned with the nation's call with the enactment of WIOA. Prior to WIOA, the CNMIs Workforce Investment Agency Program was merged under the CNMI Department of Labor through the CNMI Governor's Executive Order 2013-17. This merger achieves the very purpose and intent of a seamless workforce service delivery design by unifying subsidized employment and training programs with collaborated and leveraged employment services administered by State Department of Labor.

I fully support the approval of Bill No. 104-33 which is in the best interest of those that are being served, individuals and employers alike. A unified delivery of workforce development and employment services has been the intent and spirit of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and now similarly the same intent under the newly enacted Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act which becomes effective July 1, 2015 that will serve the needs of those in our respective islands but also our regional island communities.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2013-17

SUBJECT: DECLARATION OF EXECUTIVE REORGANIZATION OF THE WORKFORCE INVESTMENT AGENCY UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

AUTHORITY: "The Governor may make changes in the allocation of offices, agencies and instrumentalities and in their functions and duties that are necessary for efficient administration." CNMI Constitution, Article III, Section 15.

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Article III of the CNMI Constitution empowers the Governor to make changes to the allocation, functions, and duties of offices, agencies, and instrumentalities of the executive branch necessary for efficient administration; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Agency ("WIA") is currently under the Office of the Governor;

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor ("DOL") has a Division of Employment Services under its department wherein its mission is to increase its ability to encourage and locate private sector employment for Commonwealth residents;

WHEREAS, the purpose of WIA is to increase the employment, retention, and earnings of participants, and increase occupational skill attainment by the participants, and as a result, improve the quality of the workforce, reduce welfare dependency and enhance the productivity and competitiveness of the local workforce;

WHEREAS, the services and mission of WIA and the Division of Employment Services of DOL are similar and oftentimes overlap;

WHEREAS, transferring WIA to DOL reduces duplication of duties and decreases confusion by employment applicants as to where to seek guidance and assistance; and

WHEREAS, WIA must comply with applicable federal laws and regulations in order to receive funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eloy S. Inos, Governor of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Constitution of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, do hereby,

DECLARE that the efficient administration of employment services for the residents of the Commonwealth necessitates the transfer of WIA from the Office of the Governor to the Department of Labor.

ORDER that, pursuant to my constitutional reorganization powers:

- 1. WIA shall be transferred from the Office of the Governor to DOL and shall be a new division under DOL.
- 2. All records and property (real or personal) of WIA and all the personnel used in the administration of WIA are hereby transferred to DOL and shall be accounted for and segregated in a manner that complies with applicable federal laws and regulation. All personnel transferred pursuant to this Executive Order shall maintain their current positions and status in the classified civil service or in the excepted service, if applicable and as the case may be. The Director of Personnel Management shall ensure an orderly transfer of personnel.
- 3. The unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, allotments, or other funds available for the use of WIA on the effective date of the transfer are transferred to DOL on the effective date of this transfer and shall be accounted for and segregated in a manner that complies with applicable federal laws and regulation. In the transfer of such funds, an amount may be included for the liquidation of obligations incurred prior to the transfer. Subsequent to the transfer, WIA's operations shall be reflected in the annual budget of DOL.
- 4. DOL shall ensure that WIA operates in a manner consistent with all applicable federal laws and regulations. Further, the State Workforce Investment Board shall remain intact and continue to carry out its enumerated functions and duties.

PROVIDE that all rules, orders, contracts and agreements relating to the assigned functions and governance of WIA lawfully adopted prior to the effective date of this Executive Order shall continue to be effective until revised, amended, repealed or terminated.

PROVIDE that if any provision of this Executive Order or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Executive Order or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

PROVIDE that in accordance with the Constitution, this plan shall become effective sixty days after submission to the Legislature, unless specifically modified or disapproved by a majority of the members of each house of the Legislature, provided,

that in case it shall appear to the Governor that the interest of economy or efficient management require that the transfer be delayed beyond the date this plan becomes effective, the Governor may, in his discretion, fix a later date therefore, and he may for like cause further defer such date from time to time.

Good Evening Senators. My name is Joann Waki Muna and I am the Society for Human Resources Management (SHRM) Pacific Council State Director (Guam and NMI). I am also a Past President for SHRM Guam. The Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) was founded in 1948, the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) is the world's largest Human Resource (HR) membership organization devoted to human resource management. Representing more than 275,000 members in over 160 countries, SHRM is the leading provider of resources to serve the needs of HR professionals and advance the professional practice of human resource management. SHRM has more than 575 affiliated chapters within the United States and the Pacific (Guam and NMI).

I am here today on behalf of the Society of Human Resources Management Guam Chapter to support Bill No: 104-33.

On July 22, 2014, President Barack Obama signed into law the "Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act". This transforms the public workforce system by improving the links between diverse talent and the nation's employers. The law streamlines the coordination of employment and training services, strengthens collaboration with state and local partners, and provides Americans with increased access to work-based learning, including on-the-job training.

The key is streamlining. Early this year, SHRM Guam reached out to the Department of Labor and the Agency for Human Resources Development to work towards strengthening our workforces for the island. We were happy to learn that although the department and agency were separated by an

COMMENTS TO BILL No. 104-33 (LS)

AN ACT TO REPEAL 19 GCA CHAPTER 22; TO REPEAL 5 GCA §3120 AND ADD A NEW ARTICLE 3 TO 22 GCA DIVISION 1 CHAPTER 1 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

The intent of the bill is to eliminate the Agency for Human Resources Development (AHRD) as a Department of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam by merging and renaming AHRD as the new Division of Workforce Development and Training under the Department of Labor (DOL). This proposed measure follows the Governor's Executive Order 2015-01 which places AHRD under the administrative supervision of DOL. Per information received from the Department of Labor/AHRD, the proposed bill "will help Guam to succeed in meeting the requirements of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) recently signed into law by the U.S. Department of Labor's on July 22, 2014. The WIOA requires states to strategically align workforce development programs, develop and submit a four-year strategy in the form of a single unified strategic plan for core programs-for preparing an educated and skilled workforce and meeting the needs of the employers..." In regards to a fiscal impact, it was mentioned that there will be no additional cost impact to DOL's operating expenses. However, a fiscal impact will result under AHRD's fiscal and administrative section. These staff are currently 100% federally funded but are expected to be cost allocated between AHRD federal funds and DOL local funds as a result of the proposed merge. All other DOL/AHRD employees payroll account will remain status quo.

Based on the above noted and absent additional information from DOL, the Bureau makes the assumption on four (4) positions (mentioned by AHRD to be impacted) who will be cost allocated at fifty percent (50%) Federal and Local funds. As such, the table below reflects the estimated additional <u>local</u> fund impact to Salaries and Benefits based on 5.8 pay periods remaining (ppr) for FY15 at \$22,234. Also, the total annual estimated <u>local</u> impact commencing FY16 at \$99,666 (FY17-FY19 on the Fiscal Note form reflects an annual increase of 3% for increments and any other benefit adjustments that may result). Based on the foregoing, the noted impact may have to be absorbed by the Department of Labor's current and future operating budgets.
