



I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 105-33 (LS), “An act to *amend* § 5204(d) of Article 2, Chapter 5, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, relative to supporting the development of safe and healthy youth and community activities through a dedicated funding source,” was introduced by Senators Thomas A. Morrison, Tina Rose Muña Barnes, V. Anthony Ada, Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr., and Rory J. Respicio on May 28, 2015, and subsequently referred to the **Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication** on the same day.

The **Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication** convened a public hearing on **Friday, June 12, 2015**, beginning at 3:30PM in the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. The hearing for **Bill No. 105-33 (LS)** began at **5:16PM** and ended at **5:18PM**.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Benjamin J.F. Cruz announced Bill No. 105-33 (LS), and allowed the main sponsor of the legislation to give a few remarks.

Senator Thomas A. Morrison thanked Chairman Cruz for the opportunity to speak on the bill; thanked his colleagues Senators Tina Rose Muña Barnes, V. Anthony Ada, Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr., and Rory J. Respicio for their co-sponsorship of the bill; and read his sponsor statement (*appended to this report*).

Chairman Cruz stated that Department of Parks and Recreation Director Mr. Raymond F.Y. Blas was present and provided written testimony (*appended to this report*) but had left before the hearing of Bill No. 105-33 (COR) commenced. He added that the Committee has also received written testimony from the Bureau of Budget and Management Research (*appended to this report*), and that Sinajaña Mayor Robert R.C. Hoffman was present earlier but due to a notification error had attended the earlier session of the day's public hearing. On account that there were no individuals present to testify, the Chairman considered Bill No. 105-33 (LS) heard.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

On the recommendation of legislative counsel, minor formatting and style changes were made to the version as introduced, particularly the short title of the bill. These changes are reflected in the substitute version proffered by the Committee. No other changes were made.

June 12, 2015 Public Hearing

- *Håfa adai* everyone and thank you, Vice-Speaker Cruz, and committee members for scheduling a public hearing on Bill No. 105-33 (LS) – thank you to my fellow colleagues for co-sponsoring this legislation
- As the committee may be aware, P.L. 32-060 was enacted in July 2013. One of the provisions in the law sets aside a portion of the Limited Gaming Fund to assist Guam's mayors, the Superintendent of Education, and the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation in their efforts to repair and/or replace various school and community recreational facilities
- It was the intent of the members of the 32nd Guam Legislature to allow for a continuous appropriation of funds that are specifically set aside to help improve the conditions in these facilities
- However, my office was recently informed by Mayor Robert Hoffman that he was advised by budget officials that such funding may not be available to him and other mayors – absent a direct appropriation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
- Bill No. 105-33 (LS), if enacted, would ensure that funds are made available, on a continuous basis, to support improvements to our school and community recreational facilities, as well for other programs and activities authorized by law
- The passage of this legislation is critical to the development and expansion of safe and healthy community activities for Guam's youth and families
- I look forward to receiving input and recommendations from members of the public concerning Bill No. 105-33 (LS), and look forward to working closely with this committee to ensure that this legislation is improved, as necessary, and that it moves forward through the legislative process.

Comments on Bill No. 105-33 (LS)

BILL NO. 105-33 (LS) IS AN ACT TO *AMEND* §5204(d) OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 5, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTED, RELATIVE TO SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF SAFE AND HEALTHY YOUTH AND COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES THROUGH A DEDICATED FUNDING SOURCE.

Pursuant to Public Law 32-060, the Limited Gaming Fund was signed into law July 9, 2013. In accordance with §5204(d) which was added to 11 GCA, Chapter 5, by this law, moneys remaining in the Fund, after maintaining required reserves for administrative expenses, *shall* be appropriated in the following manner in each fiscal year:

- Up to one third (1/3) / 33% to the Mayors Council of Guam
- Up to one third (1/3) / 33% to the Department of Parks and Recreation
- Up to one third (1/3) / 33% to the Department of Education

The subject legislation proposes to amend §5204(d) whereby “moneys remaining in the Fund, after maintaining the stated reserves for administrative expenses of this Act, are hereby appropriated, and *shall* continue to be deemed appropriated, annually, in the following manner each fiscal year.”

It should be noted that approximately \$783,236.48 and \$969,639.96 for FY2013 and FY2014 collections respectively have since been appropriated per P.L. 32-148. Should the subject Bill become law, FY2015 collections, which currently totals \$779,210.39, and all future collections to the Fund would be deemed to be appropriated on a continuing basis.

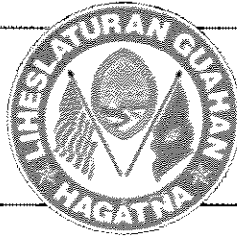
