# **COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST**

### I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 106-33 (LS) was introduced on May 28, 2015, by Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on May 29, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on July 17, 2015, in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill No. 106-33 (LS). The hearing convened at 2:00 p.m. and was adjourned at 3:30 p.m.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on July 10, 2015, and again on July 14, 2015. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura*'s website beginning on July 10, 2015.

### II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas read the title of Bill No. 106-33 (LS) and yielded the floor to Senator Frank Aguon for his opening statement.

Senator Frank Aguon explained the intent of the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Professional Scholarship. He conceded that there were valid concerns raised by legislative counsel with regards to the bill and stated that his office is

working on addressing those concerns. Senator Aguon stated that Bill No. 106-33 (LS) would provide preferential credit to government of Guam employees who completed their post-secondary or post-graduate education using the Doc Sanchez Scholarship.

Chairman San Nicolas acknowledged Senator Aguon's comments and, upon seeing that no individuals were present to provide testimony, concluded the hearing for Bill No. 106-33 (LS).

### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Concerns about Bill No. 106-33 (LS) were brought to the attention of the primary sponsor by legislative counsel. As a result, a substitute version was provided to the Committee for consideration (please see attached). The provisions of the bill that provided for preferential credit to recipients of the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Professional Scholarship, which in Bill No. 106-33 as introduced was placed in Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated, have in the substitute version been inserted into Title 17 under the provisions of the Doc Sanchez Program.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development hereby reports out Bill No. 106-33 (LS), as substituted by the Committee, with the recommendation TO REPORT OUT ONLY.

AN ACT TO AMEND § 4104 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 4, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE PREFERENTIAL **PROVIDING** CREDIT CAREER EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM WHO HAVE COMPLETED THEIR POST SECONDARY OR POST GRADUATE EDUCATION WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE PEDRO "DOC" SANCHEZ PROFESSIONAL SCHOLARSHIP; WHO APPLY FOR SUPERVISORY OR MANAGERIAL WITHIN **POSITIONS** THE AGENCIES DEPARTMENTS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Professional Scholarship seeks to promote the development and retention of the workforce of the government by establishing a government-wide scholarship program accessible to all classified government employees belonging to the career service of the Government of Guam. The Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Scholarship provides aid to employees who desire enrollment in public administration, other undergraduate degree programs offered at the School of Business and Public Administration, University of Guam, and the graduate Masters of Public Administration and Masters of Business Administration programs offered at the School of Business and Public Administration, University of Guam.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the intent for the establishment of the scholarship was to develop and retain a competent workforce specifically in the supervisory and managerial ranks of public service.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide preferential credit to career employees of the government of Guam who have completed their post secondary or post graduate education with the assistance of the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Professional Scholarship; and who seek employment in managerial or supervisory positions in their respective agency or department within the Government of Guam.

**Section 2.** §4104 of Article 1, Chapter 4, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

# "§ 4104. Preferences.

(a) No preference *shall* be given in the government service, except that residents of Guam who are physically or mentally impaired, but are physically and mentally able to perform efficiently and safely the duties of the job being applied for as certified by the Director of Public Health and Social Services, or who are veterans of the Armed Forces of the United States, or who are former members of the Guam Police Combat Patrol, as certified by the Chief of Police, or graduates of the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission Academy operated pursuant to 17 GCA § 32201, as enacted by Public Law Number 24-331, with respect to employment in those positions identified in 17 GCA § 32301(b), as enacted by Public Law Number 24-331, or career employees of the government of Guam who have completed their post secondary or post graduate education with the assistance of the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Professional Scholarship; and who apply for supervisory or managerial positions within the

government, shall receive a preferential credit of five (5) points, which shall be added to their competitive examination score, and such veterans or former members who are disabled as a result of their service in the Armed Forces or Combat Patrol, shall receive a preferential credit of ten (10) points which shall be added to their passing score. In addition, if two (2) applicants for government service are equally qualified for the position to be filled, and one (1) is a beneficiary of a preference pursuant to this Subsection, while the other is not, the former shall be given the first offer of position."

**Section 2.** A new § 15913 is hereby *added* to Article 9, Chapter 15, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

# "§ 15913. Doc Sanchez Credit

- (a) Career employees of the government of Guam who have qualified for the scholarship operated under this Article; and who have completed their post-secondary or post graduate education with the assistance of the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Professional Scholarship; and who apply for supervisory or managerial positions within the government of Guam, shall receive a credit of five (5) points, which shall be added to their competitive examination score.
- (b) Career employees of the government of Guam qualified for credit pursuant to this Article shall only be permitted to avail themselves of one type of credit provided either under this Article or 4 GCA § 4104.
