COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. <u>124-33</u> (COR) was introduced on June 8, 2015, by Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr., and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary on June 10, 2015.

The Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary convened a public hearing on Bill No. <u>124-33 (COR)</u> on Monday, June 22, 2015 at 9:00AM in I *Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Monday, June 15, 2015 (5-Day Notice), and again on Thursday, June 18, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:00 AM.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Aguon:

The public hearing held by the Committee on Guam U.S Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary is hereby convened. On the agenda today we do have several pieces of legislation. The first item is Bill No. 111-33(LS), which is relative to the assignment of police officers. Bill No. 123-33 relative to expanding the powers of the magistrate judge. Bill No. 124-33 relative to authorizing the expenditure of funds from the judicial client services fund to support language assistance services at the judiciary of Guam.

Chairman Aguon:

Bill No. 125-33, which is relative to advancing compliance with the peace officer standards and training commission by designating probation officers of the Superior Court of Guam as uniformed officers and by adding the Chief of Probation to the peace officers standards and training commission, and then finally we will conclude today's public hearing with Bill No.126-33 relative to authorizing Government of Guam employees to join the Volunteer Deputy Marshall Reserve Program. For the information of the public, the initial notices were disseminated electronically on Sunday, June 14th with the first notice of public hearing,

and then subsequently on Monday June 15th. The notices went out also to the senators as well as some additional stakeholders. The second notice of public hearing for this particular public hearing was disseminated to the community and to the stakeholders on Wednesday, June 17th and also on June 18th disseminated to all the Senators. I want to, on a personal note as Chairman of the Committee thank our media partners for assisting in this process and ensuring the community is aware of some of the pieces of legislation that will be entertained this morning so thank you very much to our media partners. As we proceed with the first item, I would like to recognize and thank the Senators who have joined us this morning thus far. The Senator to my immediate left is Senator Tina Muna-Barnes thank you very much Senator for joining us. To her immediate left is Senator Camacho Torres and to my right is Senator Tony Ada. Thank Senators for joining us in this public hearing this morning.

If not because you are all signed in for the additional legislation Bill No.124 we will now transition over into that piece of legislation and it's relative to authorizing the expenditure of funds to the Judicial Clients Services Fund to support language assisted services at the Judiciary of Guam.

Mr. Tenorio:

Thank you Chairman Aguon and members of the committee. Bill 124 is basically an opportunity for us to fund language-assisted services from the Judicial Client Services Fund, that's a fund that receives about of the fines and fees that come into the court and really it's been restricted to funding the gaps in the indigent defense and all of those services with detention. The reason why it is so important to add language assistant services is something that is happening throughout the country where basically the US Department of Justice has chosen the courts as the first government entity within the entire system to go after in compliance with is it, Title 6 of the Civil Rights Act. The state of Hawaii actually just came out from an investigation and made some changes. States of California, Arizona, New Mexico have been sued by the Federal Government, the court systems for not providing language assistance services and although we are in full compliance when it comes to the criminal docket, there are instances where our residents who have limited English proficiency coming into through courts on the civil side and currently you know we use whoever is in house to try and deal with the need but its really not been a sustainable thing. It is something that we need to provide and also protect the court and make sure we have another tool so that we comply with Title 6 of the Civil Rights Act and makes sure we provide the services to the residents who have limited English proficiency. So what this would do is that it would provide us with accessing a resource we already have, but to pay for this kind of service. Thank You.

Chairman Aguon:

Thank you very much Mr. Tenorio. Any questions in regards to this piece of legislation? Chief Justice Torres, any final comments? If not Bill No.124-33 has been public heard and like the previous legislation the committee will continue to receive written testimony for the subsequent ten days from this hearing date.

Chairman Aguon:

This concludes the committee's agenda this morning. As was mentioned a little earlier the committee will continue to receive written testimony for the subsequent ten days from this hearing date. And then the committee report will be closed there after so thank you very much again.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the United
- 3 States Department of Justice Federal Coordination and Compliance Section (FCS)
- 4 of the Civil Rights Division has been working with courts throughout the United
- 5 States to guarantee the provision of language services to Limited English Proficient
- 6 (LEP) individuals in state court proceedings and court operations to ensure
- 7 compliance of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
- 8 It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to authorize the Judiciary of Guam
- 9 to expend funds from the Judicial Client Services Fund as the dominant source of

- Section 2. Language Assistance Services. § 9602 of Chapter 9.6, Title 7,
- 12 Guam Code Annotated, is hereby amended, to read:



Thank you for providing me with the opportunity to submit public testimony regarding Bill No. 124-33 (COR), AN ACT TO AMEND § 9602 OF CHAPTER 9.6, TITLE 7, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FROM THE JUDICIAL CLIENT SERVICES FUND TO SUPPORT LANGUAGE ACCESS ASSISTANCE SERVICES AT THE JUDICIARY OF GUAM, which you introduced.

Bill No. 124-33 (COR) will ensure that individuals with limited English proficiency (LEP) have meaningful access to justice by authorizing the Judiciary of Guam to expend funds for language services from the Judicial Client Services Fund. The amendment contemplates that the Judicial Client Services Fund would be the dominant source of funding for court requested language assistance services.

As the population of Guam grows in diversity, there is a corresponding impact on the courts. Language assistance services necessary for LEP defendants in court proceedings, and for LEP patrons in the court matters, ranging from paying fines to attending counseling sessions. If passed, Bill No. 124-33 (COR) provides additional resources for the Judiciary of Guam to be compliant with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. The legislation is responsive to the needs of our diverse community.

The bill adds "Language Assistance Services" as part of the authorized activities the Superior Court of Guess may expend funds under its Judicial Client Services Fund (JCSF). Please note that the JCSF was created pursuant to P.L. 27-35 in which its funds are generated from increase in feet, fines or revenues approved by the Courts or the Judicial Council (ever and above) the fee schedules for the filling of documents or imposition of fines. Based on information from the Judiciary of Guess's PY2016 Budget Request, \$110,000 was budgeted for Court Interpreters from the Judicial Client Services Fund (Note: for PY17, PY18 and PY19 of the Fiscal Note form, the Bureau assumes the same amount of \$110,000). Also, based on the Judicial Statistics and Division Reports of the 2014 Judiciary of Guess Annual Report, \$96,409 was expended for Interpreter services. This amounts to an average of \$8,207 a month. Based on this monthly average, the Bureau ostimates \$24,621 for the remaining three (3) months of FY15.
