#### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 134-33 (COR) was introduced on June 29, 2015 by Senator V. Anthony Ada and Senator Tina Rose Muña-Barnes and was subsequently referred on July 1, 2015 by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on September 18, 2015 at 9:00 am in *I Liheslaturan*'s Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 134-33 (COR).

#### **Public Notice Requirements**

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on September 10, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on September 16, 2015 (48-Hour Notice). Notice was also placed on the Legislative Channel.

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:00am.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada called those who signed up to give testimony.

Chairperson Ada yields to the sponsor to give an introduction of the bill.

**Senator Anthony Ada:** He begins by giving a brief synopsis of Bill No. 134-33. In the past, Public Law 297-31 allowed for the rezoning of certain lands in Sinajana from agricultural to commercial. This piece of property is now the site of a dialysis center called *The Village*. With the need for quality healthcare, the clinic owners acquired adjoining land to expand the facility. He says that this property is zoned agricultural, but will need to be rezoned for the expansion plan to proceed. This bill will rezone the subject lot to commercial.

**Michael Borja,** *Director, Department of Land Management:* He reads his testimony in favor of Bill No. 134-33 (see attached written testimony).

**Dr. Safabakhsh**, *Pacific Medical Group*: He explains that this small portion was anticipated before the clinic was built to expand the current medical facility and he believes it will be beneficial for the community. He says that there is an urgent need to expedite the rezoning process and start construction as soon as possible.

**Mark Mendiola:** He says that the medical facility allows access to healthcare for folks that desperately need it. In addition to the dialysis center, there's also a pharmacy and a clinic. He says that it's very convenient for his mother to get the medicine that she needs. He concludes by saying he is in full support of the bill.

Chairperson Ada ends the public hearing for Bill No. 134-33 (COR).

#### III. Findings and Recommendations

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that Saied Safabakhsh, property owner of Lot No. 3257-4-2 in the municipality of Sinajana, currently designated as Agricultural Zone (A), seeks to rezone the property to Commercial Zone (C) for the purpose of expanding a facility for medical services that was constructed on adjoining Lot No. 3257-4-R2 (which is zoned Commercial (C)).

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that because the lot is zoned (A), the owner is not allowed to use the property to its fullest potential. By rezoning the property, the owners will be able to increase the array of needed medical services that will benefit the community and surrounding areas.

Furthermore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that Lot No. 3257-4-2 fronts Route 4, and is consistent with the commercial activity of the surrounding area which is compatible with the uses allowed in the proposed zone change proposed herein.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to rezone Lot No. 3257-4-2, in the municipality of *Sinajana*, from (A) to (C).

Section 2. Lot Rezoning. Notwithstanding any provision of the law, Lot No. 3257-4-2, in the municipality of *Sinajana*, is hereby rezoned to Commercial Zone (C).



Buenas yan Hafa Adai!

In general, I will always ask that the process of rezoning be afforded the review of the Department of Land Management and the Guam Land Use Commission. The Department's review would also include the Application Review Committee whose purpose is to determine potential shortfalls the owner must overcome when the land is rezoned. This review is to assure the general welfare and safety of the community.

Since the owner of Lot No. 3254-4-2 is also the owner of the adjacent Lot No. 3254-4-R2 where a medical facility has been built and Lot No. 3254-4-R2 is already zoned Commercial (C), several options are available.

- a. Lot No. 3254-4-2 rezoning can be addressed through the normal application process for review and approval by the Guam Land Use Commission.
- b. Lot No. 3254-4-2 and Lot No. 3254-4-R2 can be consolidated into a single lot with the zone change request made using the "Split Zone Process" which would still require review and approval by the Guam Land Use Commission in accordance with Public Law 31-98.
- c. Obtain legislation to rezone.

This land owner also obtained legislation to rezone Lot No. 3254-4-R2 but the process of obtaining his building permit to construct his medical facility required the scrutiny of the same regulatory agencies who comprise the Application Review Committee. Since the zone change to Lot No. 3254-4-2 is for a proposed addition to the existing

medical facility, and since this is a real need and demand, then the criteria of PUBLIC NECESSITY, CONVENIENCE and GENERAL WELFARE is easily justified.

Additionally, the property abuts Route 4 and as such, the "C" Zone designation is appropriate. All infrastructure systems are in place and, notwithstanding any infrastructure capacity issues, the proposed use of the property can be readily serviced. The proposed use is compatible with surrounding uses, therefore, it is not expected to degrade the characteristics in the area nor is it expected to de-value properties.

For these reasons, the Department of Land Management does not oppose Bill No. 134-33, but continues to recommend land owners seek zone changes through the Department of Land Management as the primary means to change their zoning.

The majority of our patients come from the Southern and Central villages and neither they nor those who accompany them have any desire to engage the traffic in some of the other areas of our island that have become so congested. They have often expressed their appreciation in being able come to this facility as it keeps them out of the high traffic areas which only adds to the stress of going for treatment or a doctor's visit.

The Village is not only new and modern and tranquil but also convenient. So constructing another new, modern and tranquil medical facility, right here, in the same vicinity as "The Village" makes good sense to me. This new facility would provide much needed additional medical services, allowing our Southern and Central village patients the opportunity to take advantage of these services without having to travel further elsewhere, to do so.

To many of our patients, "The Village" is like a second home. Because of this, we would like to provide as many essential services as possible and help ease the burden of trying to obtain such

services in numerous different locations around the island, saving them not only time and energy, but the expenses that would occur if made to travel to those other locations.

We are all very committed the care and well being of our island patients. We also very much appreciate all of those family members and friends who help provide for the well being of these patients. Therefore anything we can do for them, like providing additional essential medical services in one convenient location, will remain one of our highest priorities.

I thank you for allowing me the opportunity to express my support for the rezoning of lot No. 3257-4-2, to a Commercial "C" Zone and do hope that you also see the benefits bill 134-33 provides for our island home.

## BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 134-33 (COR)

The intent of the proposed legislation is to rezone Lot No. 3257-4-2, Sinajana, Guam from an Agricultural Zone (A) to a Commercial Zone (C). Per the legislation, the property owners of the cited lot is seeking to rezone the property for the purpose of expanding a facility for medical services that was constructed on adjoining Lot No. 3257-4-R2.

Should this proposed legislation become law, Lot No. 3257-4-2 would have a higher appraisal value, which in effect raises the real property tax value of the property. Per the Department of Revenue & Taxation (DRT), the tax rate for buildings (0.35008%) and land (0.0875033%) applies to all properties regardless of the property's zone. However, because the appraisal value rises with the rezoning from Agricultural Zone to a Commercial Zone, the DRT can expect a slight increase in revenues received in the form of increased property tax.

The DRT uses a formula to calculate the appraisal value based on property location, size, and existing infrastructure. The language of the proposed legislation implies that the "expanding a facility for medical services" will require construction to move forward with the expansion. If construction is conducted, revenues in the form of building permits can be expected to be received by the Department of Public Works (DPW). Subsequently, the expansion will increase the appraisal value of the property due to the addition of new infrastructure.

The proposed legislation would rezone the subject property from an Agricultural Zone to a Commercial Zone. Although the rezoning would increase the property's appraised value, the increase of appraised value cannot be projected. However, the Bureau determines that revenues in the form of increased property taxes will be received by the Department of Revenue & Taxation while the anticipated expansion will result in revenues in the form of building permits to be received by the Department of Public Works.


