## COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### I. OVERVIEW

Bill 137-33 (COR) was introduced on July 2, 2015 by Senator Thomas C. Ada and was subsequently referred on July 2, 2015 to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on July 13, 2015 at 2:00 pm in *I Liheslaturan Guahan* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 137-33 (COR).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 2:00pm.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada: As sponsor, he begins the public hearing and starts with Bill No. 137-33, an act to amend the land transfer for George Toves as authorized by Pubic Law 28-68 to be an area for area not to include land used by military utility easement. He goes on to say that this bill recognizes the fact that the property that Mr. Toves was given in exchange for his private property was a lot less smaller because there was an easement that went right down the middle. He [Mr. Toves] is now asking for additional land to be provided to compensate for that easement that runs through the property that is useless to him.

Chairperson Ada continues by calling those who have signed up to give a testimony.

**Michael Borja**, *Director*, *Department of Land Management*: He explains that Mr. George Toves had a piece of property that was up along Route 3 and the Ukudu High School area and they needed that property to have access to Ukudu High School. His property was a clean set of property and it had no easement on it at all. When they re-drew all the lines in his area to

specify where the access routes and the rights of way were going to be, they re-drew the different lots as well. The lot that was exchanged for his had this military utility easement.

He goes on to say that Mr. Toves has been going on this for quite a long time trying have an understanding with the military to move the easement or have it deleted completely. The military wants to hold on to this easement because it runs parallel to the oil pipeline. It may be an inactive communications line easement but it's still required by the military. He says that the department has been successful in getting the military to move the easement to the edge of the lot so that it's not dissecting down the middle of the length of his lot. We're asking that the area-to-area transfer not include the amount of area that the utility easement takes up so that it is a true area to area transfer because he can't do anything at all on this easement. He also asks that the land that is going to be taken to compensate for this is part of a property adjacent to it, which is also Chamorro Land Trust. The Legislature is being asked to allow the area-to-area transfer to exclude this military utility easement.

Chairperson Ada ends the public hearing for Bill No. 137-33.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that Public Law 28-68 authorized the area for area land transfer to Mr. George Toves for land needed to access the new Ukudu High School. The lot transferred to Mr. Toves, Lot No. 10120-21NEW-9, Dededo, includes a military utility easement, MU-T-10, which dissects the property and consists of approximately ±766 (seven hundred sixty-six) square meters. The military utility easement on Lot No. 10120-21NEW-9 has reduced the land available, which should be eight thousand three hundred seventy-three (8,373) square meters.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds the adjacent lot, Lot No. 10120-21NEW-8, Dededo, is an unused lot assigned to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission, and is land that could be used to compensate the land transfer to ensure a net of eight thousand three hundred seventy-three (8,373) square meters is exchanged. Therefore, approximately ±766 (seven hundred sixty-six) square meters of land from Lot No. 10120-21NEW-8, Dededo, not to include land assigned to MU-T-10 will be transferred to Mr. Toves and incorporated into Lot No. 10120-21NEW-9, Dededo.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that this land exchange served a legitimate public necessity and that the transfer of government land for private land serves as due compensation.

**Section 2.** Public Law 28-68, Section 104 is hereby amended to read:

"Section 104. Land Exchange for Mr. George Toves to provide public access to Ukudu High School site:



I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 3 that Section 104 of Chapter IV of Public Law 28-68 authorized an area for area land exchange to Mr. George Toves for land needed to access the new *Ukudu* High 4 5 School. The lot transferred to Mr. Toves, Lot No. 10120-21NEW-9, Dededo, includes a military utility easement, MU-T-10, which dissects the property and 6 7 consists of approximately seven hundred sixty-six (766) ± square meters. The military utility easement on Lot No. 10120-21NEW-9 has reduced the land 8 available, which should be eight thousand three hundred seventy-three (8,373) 9 10 square meters. 11 I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the adjacent lot, Lot No. 10120-21NEW-8, 12 Dededo, is an unused lot assigned to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission, and is 13 land that could be used to compensate the land transfer to ensure that a net of eight 14 thousand three hundred seventy-three (8,373) square meters is exchanged.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that this land exchange served a legitimate public necessity and that the transfer of government land for private land serves as due compensation.

It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* that approximately seven hundred sixty-six (766)  $\pm$  square meters of land from Lot No. 10120-21NEW-8, *Dededo*, not to include the land assigned to MU-T-10, will be transferred to Mr. Toves and incorporated into Lot No. 10120-21NEW-9, *Dededo*.

**Section 2.** Section 104 of Chapter IV of Public Law 28-68 is hereby *amended* to read:

# "Section 104. Land Exchange for Mr. George Toves to Provide Public Access to *Ukudu* High School Site:

- (a) Land Exchange. I Maga'lahen Guåhan and the Chamorro Land Trust Commission shall cause and execute a consolidation and land exchange involving Basic Lot 5311-REM Dededo privately owned by George Toves and a portion of Basic Lot 10120-R20 known as Tract 11406 owned by the government of Guam to provide for access for the Ukudu High School site and usable lots. The land exchange shall be on an area for area basis and *shall not* include the area utilized by the military utility easement known as MU-T-10, as depicted in Exhibit A. The provisions of this section shall be applicable to the Municipal Lease program for the Ukudu school as provided for in Part I of Chapter II of this Act.
- **(b) Transfer of Property.** An area approximately seven hundred sixty-six (766) ± square meters of Lot No. 10120-21NEW-8, *Dededo*, owned by the *Chamorro* Land Trust Commission, not to include land assigned to the area designated by the military utility easement, MU-T-10, *shall* be transferred to Lot No. 10120-21NEW-9, *Dededo*, to compensate for the area of land used by the military utility easement, known as MU-T-10, in Lot No.



Mr. George Toves previously owned land adjacent to Route 3 and the Ukudo High School. His land was needed to permit access to the Ukudo High School and P.L. 28-68, a comprehensive bill which permitted the use of land for several schools to include the Ukudo High School, authorized the original area-for-area land transfer. Mr. Toves' previously owned land did not include any easements transiting through his property, however, the land he received in exchange included a military utility easement that dissected the length of the property. This military utility easement has been in existence for a very long period of time and the use of the land atop it is restricted, thereby not allowing Mr. Toves quiet enjoyment of his property.

In an effort to properly satisfy the area-for-area land exchange for property taken for the use of the public welfare, this bill would exclude the area of land designated as the military utility easement, known as MU-T-10, from the calculations of the total area of land to be transferred. The additional area of land to supplement the original land transfer would come from the adjacent property managed by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC), as noted in the bill. Since the Legislature initiated this original land transfer without CLTC involvement, the CLTC and its Board of Commissioners remain silent on this transaction.

The Department of Land Management supports Bill No. 137-33 to rectify a previously authorized land transfer. We, therefore, ask that Bill No. 137-33 be favorably reported out of committee and passed by this Legislature.

# Written Testimony on Bill 137 By Mr. George Toves

Committee Chairman Senator Tom Ada and Senators, Thank you for the opportunity to testify on Bill 137. And a special thank you to Senator Tom Ada and to Director Mike Borja of the Department of Land Management for introducing this bill.

The bill is very simple; it seeks to correct an unfair land exchange by prior law PL 28-68. It seeks to provide fairness and fair treatment to a private citizen who willingly agreed to a land exchange that gave greater benefit to the People of Guam than to the private landowner.

Years ago when the Government of Guam was going to build Ukudu High School, it did not have unfettered access to the lot on which the school was to be built. The Government of Guam did not have a road to the proposed school site.

I was approached to see if I was willing to do a land exchange of my private property for Government property so that a road could be built to provide access to the proposed school site from Route 3. The road was for the Children of Guam.

The land exchange involved giving up 8,373 square meters of my land that had no exceptions to title, that had no easements running through it, it was a net amount of 8373 square meters, all 8373 square meters of my property were usable developable land. In return the Government of Guam exchanged also 8,373 square meters. But the Government land that I got had a military easement on it, approximately 766 square meters that I could not use, that I could not develop. It was not a "fair" trade.

During the last several years, through my own efforts, all the way up to the Admiral, all the way up to Congresswoman Madeleine Bordallo, I somehow convinced the United States Military to agree to relocate that easement. As you may know, one of the hardest things to do is to get the U.S. Military and the Government of Guam to agree on a "land issue". But I did.

But any land disposition has to be agreed to and sanctioned by the Guam Legislature. So here we are today with Bill 137.

I am appealing to you Senators, to the Guam Legislature, for fair treatment in this land exchange. I agreed to the original land exchange for the greater benefit of the Children of Guam, the Government of Guam and the People of Guam. I only ask that I receive the same net usable square meters (minus the military easement) that I gave up for the benefit of Guam's educational system, the Children of Guam, the Government of Guam and the People of Guam.

Furthermore, the Government of Guam Dept. of Land Management must ensure and complete all the requirements for the relocation of the MU-T-10 easement in addition to the new revised map and to submit to the NAVFAC ASSET MANAGEMENT OFFICE, DEPT. OF THE NAVY, GUAM a copy of the new revised map for review and approval by the Navy, prior to the final approval and recordation by the Dept. of Land Management, Government of Guam.

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this bill and thank you for the introduction of this bill.

The proposed legislation is intended to exclude the area of Lot No. 10120-21NEW-9 that is being utilized by the military utility easement known as MU-T-10 as part of the initial land transfer, which is approximately 766± square meters. To compensate for the decrease in transferrable land authorized in P.L. 28-68, the proposed legislation will designate approximately 766± square meters from an unused adjacent lot assigned to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission known as Lot No. 10120-21NEW-8.

Section 3 of the proposed legislation stipulates that the properties will be exchanged on a value-forvalue basis. There is no component of the Bill that requires an act to make any changes to the properties' existing infrastructure.

The intent of the Bill poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.


