#### I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 138-33 (COR) was introduced on July 2, 2015 by Senator Thomas C. Ada and was subsequently referred on July 2, 2015 by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on July 13, 2015 at 2:00 pm in *I Liheslaturan's* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 138-33 (COR).

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada called the Public Hearing to order and, as sponsor, gives an introduction of the bill.

**Michael Borja**, *Director*, *DLM*: Mr. Borja reads his written testimony in favor of the bill (see written testimony attached)

In addition to reading his written testimony, he goes on to say that it was the first time the Land Use Commission had experienced this situation in which an individual purchased property that was returned to original landowners. He purchased the land from the original landowner and then was trying to change his land zoning in accordance with the section in the law. The definition of the landowner was in question because is it the one that currently owns the land or only the people that originally owned the land? It listed a whole list of activities that the landowner had to do in order to get the zone change and these activities were functions that the planning division of land management usually performs. All we're asking is that the law revert back to its original design when that bill was first introduced; it was only

one or two sentences long. Take federal excess lands and make it Agricultural (A) Zone and instruct the landowner to go through the process of zone change that is already established and set in concrete.

Chairperson Ada: He started saying that the bill does two things. One, the existing law limits the zone designation that is allowed. If the area is zoned R2, and a landowner wants to rezone that property to build a small strip mall, he wouldn't be able to do that. This bill removes that restriction and allows for the application for a higher zone designation by applying at Land Management under the normal process. It takes away the dual application re-zoning process: certain process for returned excess lands and the process for all other lands. So now it's just one process.

**Michael Borja: He answers that** it still holds that any land returned as federal excess will be zoned Agricultural upon return.

Chairperson Ada: Correct.

Chairperson Ada ends the public hearing for Bill No. 138-33 (COR).

Title 21. Guam Code Annotate (GCA), Chapter 61, Section 61217 was originally crafted to provide a zone designation of Agricultural (A) Zone to federal excess land returned to the government of Guam because these lands were not zoned under the federal control. However, the bill had amendments added prior to its passage and these amendments, while well intentioned, were vague on its execution.

During a recent Guam Land Use Commission meeting, a landowner asked to elevate the zoning his property under the conditions established in 21GCA, §61217. Unfortunately, the commissioners could not entertain this landowner because of the lack of clarity in the law. First, the definition of the landowner was unclear. Secondly, the Land Management action required for documents the landowner was instructed to provide was absent.

This bill reverts the language of this law to only apply Agricultural (A) Zone to returned federal excess lands and to instruct landowners that an increase in the zone should be done using established zone change procedures. The passage of this bill will establish clarity in the law for both the landowner, the Planning Division of the Department of Land Management, and the Guam Land Use Commission.

Bill No. 138-33 (COR) is an Act to amend Title 21 GCA, Chapter 61, Section 61217, Federal Excess Land Zoning to provide clarity and maintain uniformity on all zone change processes.

Title 21 GCA, Chapter 61, Section 61217 currently contains language that allows any landowner of federal excess land returned by the Government of Guam to apply for higher zoning designations. However, this language has various requirements that make changing returned federal excess land significantly more complicated than applications for zone changes of all other properties.

Section 2 of the proposed legislation includes the amendment to make approval for zone changes for returned federal excess lands be processed through the Department of Land Management's existing rules, regulations, procedures, and policies.



#### "Senator Tom Ada wants to clarify the rezoning process for Returned Federal Excess Lands"

On Thursday, July 2, 2015 Senator Tom Ada introduced Bill 138-33. The Senator stated: "The bill is an effort to clarify the rezoning process for returned Federal Excess Lands." Bill 138-33 clarifies that subsequent landowners, and not just the original landowner, can apply for a zone change on returned federal excess land. Additionally, Bill 138-33 also removes the restriction that limits the higher zone application "up to a zone designation consistent with that of the majority of land contiguous to the returned land as of the date of the return by the government of Guam".

Bill 138-33 standardizes the rezoning application process by requiring that zone changes for returned Ancestral lands be governed, in the same way for all other zoning requests, by existing rules, regulations, procedures, and policies of the Department of Land Management and the Guam Land Use Commission."
