COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 140-33 (COR) was introduced on July 2, 2015 by Thomas C. Ada and was subsequently referred on July 2, 2015 by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on July 13, 2015 at 2:00 pm in *I Liheslaturan's* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 140-33 (COR).

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on July 6, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on July 9, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 2:00pm.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada called the Public Hearing to order and, as the sponsor, gives an introduction of the bill.

Chairperson Ada: He stated that the reason why Bill No. 140-33 was introduced was because the majority of leases issued are either residential or agricultural. The commonality between these two types of leases is the size of the lands. For subsistence agriculture leases, it's between a half-acre and an acre. For residential leases, it's between a quarter of an acre to a half-acre. Right now, the law allows for the Land Trust to approve residential leases without coming to the Legislature for approval. And so now, we want to expand that to also apply to subsistence agriculture and aquaculture leases. That's to be distinguished from regular agricultural leases, which can be up to twenty acres for commercial purposes.

Chairperson Ada continues by calling those who have signed up to give testimony.

Michael Borja, *Director*, *DLM (written testimony):* Mr. Borja reads his testimony in favor of the bill. (Please see attached written testimony.)

In addition to reading his written testimony, he goes on to say that the agency rarely gives out the larger sets of leases, but there are many leases in existence that are at the twenty acre size for agricultural leases. In the three years that I've been onboard, we have not done those very large leases and we follow what the rules and regulations stipulated. If anyone wanted something of size, they had to come in with a farm plan and show us what they could do with five acres before we could move them on into anything larger. There are successful subsistence agricultural leases where they're up to three acres. There's two ways to use agricultural leases: to farm the land actively or plant trees and the law specifically says how many trees they must plant over the course of five years. We need to more cognizant of our enforcement and compliance in those areas. In this case, we're asking that subsistence agricultural leases be exempted then we just ask that the size be increased from the maximum of half an acre to five acres.

Chairperson Ada ends the public hearing for Bill No. 140-33 (COR).

III. Findings and Recommendations

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement, hereby reports out **Bill 140-33 (COR) as introduced**, with the recommendation to **to report DUA**.

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 2 3 that §60112 of Chapter 60 Title 21, Guam Code Annotated omits Chamorro Land Trust Commission Agricultural leases from requiring legislative approval specified 4 5 in this section.

Section 2. §60112 of Chapter 60, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated is 6 hereby amended to read as follows: 7

" §60112. Legislative Approval Required. 8

9 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, government-owned real property shall not be sold, leased, sub-leased, exchanged or otherwise transferred 10without the prior approval of *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) by duly enacted 11 legislation, which specifically authorizes a particular sale, lease, exchange or 12 13 transfer and includes the real property description of the government-owned real property with particularity and a Department of Land Management recorded map]4 showing the alienated parcel and the remaining parcel of the original lot. This 15 section shall not apply to Land Use Permits, the Land for the Landless Program, or 16 17 residential, subsistence agricultural leases, and subsistence aquaculture leases by 18 the Chamorro Land Trust Commission pursuant to its rules and regulations, but 19 shall apply to any transfer to the federal government or any agent of the federal government of land owned in the name of the government of Guam, including, but 20

not limited to, its autonomous agencies, public corporations, the Chamorro Land
 Trust Commission and the Ancestral Lands Commission."

Section 3. Severability. *If* any of the provisions of this law or its
application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law,
such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law which can
be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
provisions of this law are severable."



Buenas yan Hafa Adai!

The primary purpose for Bill No. 140-33 was to correct an omission in the Guam Code Annotated (GCA) which excluded Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) agricultural leases from the language. The original basis of this section of law derived from Public Law 30-21 which dealt primarily with the possibility for leasing land to the federal government in anticipation of the military build-up.

Because the agricultural and residential leases issued by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) are already governed by 21GCA, Chapter 75, and its associated rules and regulations, this bill need only include agricultural and aquaculture leases as excluded from required legislative approval. Specifying "subsistence agricultural leases, and subsistence aquaculture leases" in this bill submits that legislative approval is required for commercial leases for agricultural or aquaculture use. The Chamorro Land Trust Commission asks that this bill allow for all agricultural and aquaculture leases be exempt from needing further legislative approval since they already are administered in accordance with 21GCA, Chapter 75, and the CLTC rules and regulations. Furthermore, based on four types of CLTC leases and licenses listed in 21GCA, Chapter 75, §75107, CLTC also requests that grazing leases be exempt from legislative approval since it also follows the guidelines established in the law and in the rules.

However, should this bill only exempt subsistence agricultural and subsistence aquaculture leases from legislative approval, then CLTC requests the size definition of the respective agricultural lots in 21GCA, Chapter 75, §75107 be changed to:

a. Subsistence Agricultural and Subsistence Aquaculture Leases: not less than one quarter (0.25) acre, nor more than five (5) acres.

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 140-33 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 140-33 (COR) is an Act to amend §60112 of Chapter 60, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated relative to Legislative approval for agricultural land use.

§60112 of Chapter 60, Title 21, GCA currently contains language that excludes Land Use Permits, the Land for the Landless Program, or residential leases by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission from requiring Legislative approval. The amendment stipulated in the proposed legislation includes subsistence agricultural leases and subsistence aquaculture leases as part of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission leases that are not required to have Legislative approval prior to completion of handing out the lease.

The intent of the Bill poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.

"Senator Tom Ada Wants to Streamline Approval Process For Agricultural Leases ."

Hagåtña, Guam: On July 2, 2015, In an effort to expedite the approval process to lease Chamorro Land Trust properties for subsistence agriculture, Senator Tom Ada has introduced Bill 140-33. "Current Guam law exempts only residential leases of Chamorro Land Trust properties from requiring Legislative review and approval. Bill 140-33 would similarly exempt agricultural leases for subsistence farming from having to undergo Legislative approval. This authority would be given to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission", said Senator Ada. Also, "the commonality between residential and agricultural leases for subsistence farming is that allowable lots are small; less than one (1) acre for residential Lots and one-half acre for lots to be leased for subsistence farming," Senator Ada said.

Although passage of Bill 140-33 will help in expediting the issuance of agricultural leases, available lands must still be surveyed and registered before they can be leased. "*The completion of land surveys remain to be a significant challenge because of limited financial resources and availability of licensed survey professionals*", Ada said. The sale, sub-lease, exchange or otherwise transfer of government-owned property, the Chamorro Land Trust, and Ancestral Lands properties remain subject to legislative approval.
