I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 161-33 (COR) was introduced on August 14, 2015 by Senator Brant T. McCreadie, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Historic Preservation on August 17, 2015.

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Historic Preservation convened a public hearing on Bill No. 161-33 (COR) on Tuesday, November 10, 2015 at 9:00 AM in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room.

Chairperson: I yield to the author of Bill No. 161-33 (COR), Senator Brant McCreadie.

Senator Brant McCreadie: Thank you Madam Chair. Bill No. 161-33 (COR) is an act to repeal and reenact § 1026 of Chaper 10, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated; relative to establishing the Guam Liberation Fishing events. Now, basically what we did Madam Chair was we asked GVB and the Fisherman's Co-Op would get together and authorize us \$35,000 for the cost of promoting and operating the Guam Liberation Fishing Events and promote fishing not just as a hobby but a way of life on Guam. We want to make this a part of the Liberation Day Festivities as well. Thank you Madam Chair, that's Bill No. 161-33 (COR) and I look forward to further discussion on this bill.

<u>Chairperson:</u> Si Yu's Ma'ase Senator McCreadie. Here to speak on Bill No. 161-33 (COR) I have Carl DelaCruz, Michael Duenas, John Taitano and Jon Camacho. Would you all like to speak or are you just here in support of this bill? These individuals are all in support of this bill. Do any of my colleagues have any questions or comments?

<u>Speaker Won Pat:</u> Yes, Madam Chair I have a question to all four of your who say you are here to support. Why do you support changing it from Marianas to Guam Liberation Derby when you participated in going to the Marianas or CNMI..can someone answer that question?

Manny Duenas: My name is Manny Duenas and I'm President of the Guam Fisherman's Cooperative Association. Regarding the question, it was one way of ensuring we had funding. GVB has been very generous by giving us that \$25,000 up to 20 years ago and over the years we have progressed with our derby. We want to maintain the name for that event but we have 3 organizations that are doing tournaments for our local people. The largest event is the Guam Marianas International Fishing Derby, where our friends from the Marianas come down and visit us and the

amount of money and time and effort has long been overdue. I have no intentions of the name but we will change the activity as a whole to reflect the Guam Liberation. We also mentioned to the Senator and I thank Senator McCreadie for this. It's very hectic down in Agana on Liberation day so these are the things that need to be worked out.

<u>Speaker</u>: I want to thank you Mr. Duenas for explaining this and the gist of this was to get the funding source that you need rather than just change the name. For me, it's like a step backwards when you get the other islands involved and you change the name when the goal has always been to get them together. For me right now, I support it whole heartedly to get the funding source, but I surely don't support to change the name. I'd like to keep the Marianas, we are the Marianas.

<u>Senator McCreadie:</u> If I may, in the effort of working together, I agree with the Speaker and as the author of this bill, I can change the name back to Marianas.

Manny Duenas: Well, the whole thing here is that it's for Liberation, but...

<u>Senator McCreadie:</u> We can keep the Liberation in there, and maybe add in the Marianas.

<u>Manny Duenas:</u> The other thing we thought of also was "Gupot Peskadot"..it's mainly for all of our artists, to include the carvers. We all have a great time. We don't charge anything and that's the great thing about this. We've been criticized but we want to keep the tradition. It's for the betterment of our community...that's what the Co-op stands for..it's the Cooperation. We need to put more emphasis on our local farmers that's includes the fishermen. At the end of the day, I thank the good Senator and this Legislature. We have to develop this for our community. Thank you!

<u>Chairperson:</u> There is a Lani Salas that signed up as well, are you here? Would you like to come up and testify or are you here just for support? Ok, just for support. Thank you! With that said, I duly call Bill No. 161-33 (COR) publicly heard. Thank you!

The public hearing was adjourned at 2:00 P.M.

AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT § 1026 OF CHAPTER 10, TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE GUAM LIBERATION FISHING EVENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1.1 GCA §1026 is repealed and reenacted to read:

"§ 1026. Marianas Guam Liberation Fishing Derby Events.

- (a) There shall be a Marianas Guam Liberation Fishing Derby Events held annually, which events shall be Liberation Day festivities and shall be promoted as a tourist attraction for visitors to Guam and as an outdoor recreational activity for the people of Guam. The Guam Liberation Fishing Events may include spearfishing and shoreline challenges. The Governor shall appoint a Marianas Guam Liberation Fishing Derby Events Committee composed of fishermen and other interested individuals, which Committee shall choose annually a period for such derby events and shall plan, organize and promote it the events in coordination with the Guam Visitors Bureau. The Governor, following selection of the dates by the Committee, shall issue a proclamation calling upon the sports fishermen of Guam and of the Pacific to take part in this event.
- (b) The Marianas-Guam Liberation Fishing Derby-Events Fund is created to be expended for the purposes of promoting and operating the derby events. The fund

Shall be expended upon authorization by the Marianas—Guam Liberation Fishing Derby—Events Committee. The Marianas—Guam Liberation Fishing Derby—Events
Committee is authorized to accept donations and grants which shall be deposited in the Fund. The sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) is hereby authorized from the Tourist Attraction Fund to the Guam Liberation Fishing Events Fund for the costs of promoting and operating the Guam Liberation Fishing Events. The Committee shall report to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on the expenditure of all funds for the events. The report shall contain detailed information on each expenditure, including the date of expenditure, the amount and the purpose, and shall be submitted to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* no later than November 31 of each year.

(c) Clerical, technical and logistic support for the Guam Liberation Fishing

Events shall be provided for by the Guam Visitors Bureau."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective immediately upon enactment.

Comments on Bill No. 161-33 (COR)

Bill No. 161-33 proposes to repeal and reenact 1 GCA, Section 1026 to rename the Marianas Fishing Derby to the Guam Liberation Fishing Event and creates the Guam Liberation Fishing Events Committee. The bill authorizes an amount of \$35,000 to the Guam Liberation Fishing Event Fund from the Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF). The bill authorizes but does not appropriate funds. To note, FY2016 Budget Bill, (Bill No. 37-33 (COR)), show TAF Adopted Revenues and Total Appropriations at \$38,623,119. Also, FY2015 TAF Revenues have been fully appropriated.

The Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) notes it has been very supportive in its grant/sponsorship of the Marianas Fishing Derby. Funds are given to the Marianas Fishing Derby Committee out of their operational budget for planned events. The bill also proposes GVB provide clerical, technical and logistic support for the event. However, pursuant to 1 GCA, Chapter 10 Section 1011, Governor's Executive Order 2011-04 designated that all festivities relating to the Guam Liberation celebrations be overseen by the Mayors' Council of Guam. With this year's 71st Liberation Day celebrations, the Mayors' Council of Guam continues to take overall responsibilities of planning, coordinating and executing the Liberation festivities which should also include the Guam Liberation Fishing Events.
