COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 180-33 (COR) was introduced on September 16, 2015 by Senator Thomas C. Ada and was subsequently referred on September 17, 2015 by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on September 24, 2015 at 1:30 pm in *I Liheslaturan's* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 180-33 (COR).

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on September 17, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on September 21, 2015 (48-Hour Notice). Notice was also posted on the Legislative television channel.

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The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 1:30pm.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada called the Public Hearing to order and, as sponsor, gives an introduction of the bill.

Chairperson Ada: He began to explain that many years ago, the lot in Bill No. 180-33 was under the administrative jurisdiction of the Department of Vocational Rehabilitation. It was then leased to a non-profit entity and was to be used as a car wash facility to provide employment to persons with disabilities. The stipulation was that the property would come back to the government when the lease expires, which was a term of twenty years, or when the department no longer had a need for it. The lease on this property has expired so Bill 180 wants to formally ensure that the ownership and title is in the name of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission and is in its land inventory. He added that the bill further authorizes the commercial leasing of this property. He concluded by saying that the size of the property is three quarters of an acre and is valued at around 800,000 dollars.

Ben Servino, *Director, Department of Integrated Services for Individuals with Disabilities:* He reads his testimony in opposition of the bill (see attached written testimony).

Chairperson Ada: Chairman Ada, using a video monitor, displayed pictures taken yesterday at the lot. A committee staff member gave a brief description of the pictures shown. Based on the pictures, the lot is littered with solid waste including a forklift, metallic waste, trash, and acid lead batteries. He then asked Mr. Servino when the demolition for the building would take place.

Mr. Servino: He replied by saying that the notice to proceed has already been issued.

Chairperson Ada: Was that bid out through a procurement process?

Mr. Servino: Yes, and it was through the Department of Public Works. He explained that after the lease expired, there were people living in the buildings for a number of years. Consequently, Land Management issued an eviction notice and so they moved out.

Chairperson Ada ends the public hearing for Bill No. 180-33 (COR).

III. Findings and Recommendations

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement, hereby reports out **Bill 180-33 (COR) as introduced,** with the recommendation <u>TO POPASS</u>.

I 4 Liheslaturan Guåhan furthermore recognizes that Lot No. 5138-2-R3 NEW-1-1, 5 Ipao-Tumon, Municipality of Dededo is not suitable for Chamorro Land Trust 6 Commission agricultural or residential development, but rather more efficiently 7 used "commercially" because of its prime frontage location in a prime 8 predominantly commercial area. 9 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that Lot 5138-2-R3 NEW -1-1, Ipao-10

Tumon, Municipality of Dededo came under the jurisdiction of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission by operation of law, an expired or cancelled lease and by Section 75104 (a) and Section 75105 (a) of Chapter 75 Title 21.



I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to grant a certificate of title for Lot No. 5138 2-R3 NEW-1-1, Ipao-Tumon, Municipality of Dededo to the Chamorro Land Trust
 Commission. This lot is intended for commercial leasing to be managed by the
 Guam Economic Development Authority as a more productive and profitable asset
 for the Beneficiaries of the Trust.

Section 2. Issuance of Certificate of Title. The Department of Land
Management is hereby directed to issue a certificate of title for Lot No. 5138-2-R3
NEW-1-1, Ipao-Tumon, Municipality of Dededo containing an area of 2,868±
square meters as shown on Department of Land Management Map No. 314-FY 89
attached as Exhibit A to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission. This lot is to be
added into the Chamorro Land Trust Commission Lands Inventory for commercial
leasing.

Section 3. Exemption. Pursuant to § 2107 of Title 2, Guam Code 13 Annotated, and the Standing Rules of I Mina' Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan 14 *Guåhan* relative to the appraisals of land *shall not* apply to this Act. 15 Section 4. Effective Date. This act *shall* take effect upon enactment. 16 Section 5. If any provision of this law or its application to any person or 17 circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not 18 affect other provisions or applications of this law, which can be given effect <u>_</u> without the invalid provisions or application and to this end the provisions of this 20 act are severable. 21

AN ACT TO TITLE LOT 5138-2-R3 NEW-1-1, *IPAO-TUMON*, MUNICIPALITY OF *DEDEDO* IN THE NAME OF THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION AND TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMERCIAL LEASING OF SAID LOT.

Buenas yan Hafa Adai Senator Ada and Members of the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affair, and Procurement

For the record, my name is Ben S. Servino, and I serve as the Director for the Department of Integrated Services for Individuals with Disabilities (DISID).

After being off-island for over 10 years and returning back to be appointed to my position in 2011, I had wondered why the property across from JFK had been left abandoned for so many years.

Through my document research and discussions with Mrs. Rosanne Ada, the former DISID Director, I had found that the property across from JFK was officially identified as the Vocational Rehabilitation Center site (Lot 5138-2-R3) which comprised a total area of 24,073 square meters.

On August 22, 1988, an administrative transfer of Lot 5138-2-R3 was executed between the Government of Guam and the Department of Guam Rehabilitation and was recorded under Document No 402469. The lot description identified on Document No. 402469 was listed in error as 5136-2-R3 but was amended to correct the lot number as Lot 5138-2-R3 (please refer to Exhibit A: Document 743207).

The property was initially split into two parcels and identified as Parcel A, which was comprised of the front grassy area with an area of 13, 282 square meters and Parcel B which was comprised of the back structural areas which included the old Vocational Rehabilitation Center and Car Wash with an area of 10,791 square feet (Please refer to Exhibit B).

The property (Lot No. 5138-2-R3) was then subdivided and Parcel A was split into two lots: Lot No. 5138-2-R3 NEW-1-R2 which as comprised of the front grassy area, was reduced to an area of 11, 168 square meters and a 40" wide public access and utility easement was established and identified as Lot No. 5138-2-R3 NEW-1R/W with an area of 2,064 square meters.

Parcel B was also split up into two lots and identified as Lot 5138-2-R3 NEW-1-2 which comprised the Guam Vocational Rehabilitation Center structure with an area of 7,075 square meters and as Lot 5138-2-R3 NEW-1-1 which comprised the car wash structure with an area of 2,868 square meters and is the subject property referenced in this Bill 180-33.

With the enactment of Public Law 24-16, the Department of Guam Rehabilitation was placed as a Division under the Department of Integrated Services for Individuals with Disabilities and a request was submitted to the Governor on July 18, 2006 to approve the amendment to Document No. 402469 and transfer administrative jurisdiction of the property to DISID so that the Department could apply for and receive federal, local, and private grants and proceed in seeking funding to construct an "Inclusion for ALL" Public Facility on the property.

On August 22, 2006, Lot No 5138-2-R3NEW-1-2 and Lot No. 5138-2-R3NEW-1-R2 was administratively transferred to DISID. Lot No. 5138-2R3-NEW-1-1 was not included in the transfer because the Guam Rehabilitation and Workshop Center lease on the property was still in effect and would not to expire until May 31, 2013.

We fully agree that Lot No. 5138-2R3 NEW-1-1 is a prime commercial property as cited under Bill 180-33 (COR) however, we are concerned that since the property was initially transferred to the Department of Guam Rehabilitation (now DISID) back in 1988, we truly believe that more research should be done to confirm if the reversion to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission applies to this property.

As you are aware, DISID is currently pursuing Public/Private Partnership options to develop the property and as we move forward with our plans, we are willing to work out a possible MOU arrangement which would be mutually beneficial for both the Clients of our Department and the CLTC Trust.

On behalf of DISID, I thank you and the committee for allowing me this opportunity to provide some historic background on the property and to share our concern.

BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH COMMENTS ON BILL NO. <u>180-33 (COR)</u>

The intent of the proposed legislation is to issue the certificate of title for Lot No. 5138-2-R3 NEW-1-1, Ipao-Tumon, in the municipality of Dededo containing an area of 2,868± square meters to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission. The cited lot will be added to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission Land Inventory for the intended purpose of issuing a commercial lease for the property.

It should be noted that there is proposed legislation, specifically Bill No. 175-33 (COR), that addresses the rules and regulations for commercial leases. If Bill No. 175-33 (COR) is passed and becomes law, then the aforementioned property will be subject to the revenue generating provisions contained in the rules and regulations for commercial leases.

Revenue generating provisions from the proposed rules and regulations include imposing rent expenses for the commercial lease to be based upon the fair market value of the property as determined by the average of two appraisals pursuant to P.L. 31-44. A key provision in Bill 175-33 (COR) is that the rent expense shall be no less than nine percent (9%) of the original appraisal of fair market value and shall escalate at five year intervals based upon the established fair market value for the subject property. Another key provision is the CLTC's obligation to pay the Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA) in an amount no more than 3% of the annual lease payments collected during the first year of the public-public partnership between the CLTC and GEDA. An increase to the CLTC land inventory will also increase the base value from which the 3% payment will be derived from. However, absent feedback from the CLTC, it is uncertain on if they are amenable to this percentage and/or the arrangement with GEDA.

Transferring the certificate of title for Lot No. 5138-2-R3 NEW-1-1, Ipao-Tumon, in the municipality of Dededo will increase the CLTC's land inventory designated for commercial leases. Although the transfer provides an additional revenue generating source, the Bureau cannot determine an estimated amount of revenues to be received due to not having access to information regarding the fair market value based on two appraisals for the subject property and the estimated gross annual income from the use of the property through a commercial lease.
