

I. OVERVIEW: The Committee on Health, Economic Development, Homeland Security and Senior Citizens conducted a public hearing on December 10, 2015. The hearing convened at 1:30pm in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill 190-33(COR) - AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9(e) OF PUBLIC LAW 32-054, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THAT THE NATIONAL CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR EXAM IS THE SOLE REQUISITE EXAM FOR LICENSURE FOR LICENSED MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR; AND TO AMEND SECTIONS 1, 2, 8, 9 AND 16 OF P.L. 32-054 FOR PURPOSES OF ESTABLISHING A LICENSED INTERN DESIGNATION DURING THE THREE THOUSAND (3,000) HOUR POST-GRADUATE CLINICAL EXPERIENCE PERIOD REQUIRED FOR MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE.; Sponsored by Senator Dennis G. AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9(c) OF PUBLIC LAW 32-054, RELATIVE THAT TO REQUIRING THE NATIONAL CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELOR EXAM IS THE SOLE REQUISITE EXAM FOR LICENSURE FOR LICENSED HEALTH COUNSELOR; MENTAL AND TO SECTIONS 1, 2, 8, 9 AND 16 OF P.L. 32-054 FOR PURPOSES OF ESTABLISHING A LICENSED INTERN DESIGNATION DURING THE THREE THOUSAND (3,000) HOUR POST-GRADUATE CLINICAL EXPERIENCE PERIOD REQUIRED FOR MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Finding and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 2 that the requisite examination for licensure as a Licensed Mental Health Counselor 3 (LMHC) may be appropriately accomplished with the National Clinical Mental Health Counselor Exam (NCMHCE) which is the "specialty license" for those 5 specializing in mental health counseling. Further, that the National Counselor 6 Examination (NCE) is a basic entry examination for the generalist license into the 7 profession of Licensed Professional Counselor (LCE). According to the National 8 Board of Certified Counselors (NBCC) the taking of both exams is usually not 9 required in most states, unless the applicant is seeking national certification and 10 licensure which would be 'portable' to most states, but still subject to any additional 11 12 requirement(s) a state may mandate.

The Association of the Individual, Marriage and Family Therapists of Guam is requesting that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* amend the requirement for both exams for

Licensed Mental Health Counselor, and that only the NCMHCE be required, but not the NCE.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that there is an appropriate need to establish an Intern license designation for a qualified person pursuing an education and career as an Individual, Marriage and Family Therapist (IMFT), Certified Professional Counselor (CPC), Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Licensed Mental Health Counselor (LMHC), Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), or Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT). This limited license designation as a mental healthcare intern would only be applicable during the post-graduate period and the accumulation of the requisite three thousand (3,000) hours of clinical experience, and would allow for billable hours for services rendered during this period.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that notwithstanding the passage and enactment of P.L. 32-054 (July 05, 2013), that the existing provisions pursuant to Article 13 Individual, Marriage and Family Therapy (P.L. 24-329 – Aug. 14, 1998) were not repealed. This has created a dilemma for the Compiler of Laws who has not, to date, codified the provisions of P.L. 32-054. It is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to rectify this situation by repealing §§ 121301 et seq. 121305 of Article 13, and reenact Article 13 with P.L. 32-054, as amended pursuant to this Act.

Section 2. Subsection 9(c) of Public Law 32-054, is amended to read:

"(c) Individuals who hold a current, valid license in a state of the United States, its territories or a foreign country approved by the Board on a case-by-case basis as a Licensed Clinical Counselor of Mental Health, Licensed Clinical Mental Health Counselor, Licensed Mental Health Counselor, Licensed Mental Health Practitioner, Licensed Professional Counselor of Mental Health, or other license

- deemed by the Board to be substantially equivalent to the Guam License for
- 2 Licensed Mental Health Counselor, and who has passed both the NCE and the
- 3 National Clinical Mental Health Counselor Exam (NCMHCE) in a manner
- 4 approved by the National Board for Certified Counselors (NBCC) shall be eligible
- 5 for the Guam license for a Licensed Mental Health Counselor."
- Section 3. A new Subsection (j) is hereby added to Section 1 of P.L. 32-7 054, to read:
- "(j) A Licensed Mental Health Intern designation shall mean a person who 8 is seeking licensure and is acquiring the three thousand (3,000) hours of post-9 graduate clinical experience in accordance with this Article for purposes of 10 acquiring and ultimately meeting the requisite requirements for full licensure as an 11 Individual, Marriage and Family Therapist (IMFT), Certified Professional 12 Counselor (CPC), Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Licensed Mental 13 Health Counselor (LMHC), Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), Marriage and 14 15 Family Therapist (MFT), or other Mental Health Professional, as a Licensed Mental Health Professional. To be legible for the intern license, the applicant shall 16 have completed all of the other criteria required for qualification for his or her 17 respective field for licensure pursuant to (a)(1) of Section 2, Section 8, Section 9 or 18 Section 16, respectively, of this Article." 19

"(j) A *Mental Health Intern License* designation shall mean a person who is seeking licensure and is acquiring the three thousand (3,000) hours of post-graduate clinical experience in accordance with this Article for purposes of acquiring and ultimately meeting the requisite requirements for full licensure as an Individual, Marriage and Family Therapist (IMFT), Certified Professional Counselor (CPC), Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Licensed Mental Health Counselor (LMHC), Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT), or other license deemed by the Board to be substantially equivalent to these professions, who is licensed and authorized to provide such supervision in the United States, its territories or a foreign country determined to be acceptable on a case by case basis by the Board. To be legible for the intern license, the applicant shall have completed all of the other criteria required for

- qualification for his or her respective field for licensure pursuant to (a)(1) of
- 2 Section 2, Section 8, Section 9 or Section 16, respectively, of this Article."
- Section 4. A new Subsection (d) is hereby added to Section 2 of P.L. 32-4 054, to read:
- "(d) The Board *shall* issue a 'Professional Counselor Intern License' and number to an applicant who has satisfied all of the applicable requisite provisions of qualifications for licensure pursuant to (a)(1) of this Section, and who is acquiring the three thousand (3,000) hours of post-graduate clinical experience required for licensure, as provided pursuant to (a)(2) of this Section.
- 10 (1) The Board shall provide the application form to be completed by 11 an applicant for a Mental Health Intern License."

- 6 (1) The Board shall provide the application form to be completed 7 by an applicant for a Mental Health Intern License."
- Section 7. The following §§ 121301 et seq. 121305 of Article 13, Chapter 12, Part 2, Division 1 of 10 GCA, as provided pursuant to P.L. 24-329:6 (Aug. 14, 1998), are hereby repealed.
- Section 8. The Compiler of Laws shall appropriately codify P.L. 32-054, as amended pursuant to this Act, under Article 13 of Chapter 12, Part 2, Division I of 10 GCA.
 - **Section 9.** Section 14 of Public Law 32-054 is *amended*, to read:

"Section 14. Grandfather Provision.

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All licensees who hold a current, valid, license as an Individual, Marriage, and Family Therapist issued by the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners or as a Licensed Professional Counselor issued by a Guam Board, within eighteen (18) months of at the time this aArticle is enacted into law, or by August 31, 2017, whichever is later, shall be eligible to apply for a license as a Licensed Mental Health Counselor. They may be granted a license as a Licensed Mental Health Counselor if:

- 1 (1) They can pass the NCMHCE developed by the NBCC (they shall be deemed eligible by the board to take the test), or
- 3 (2) They can document one thousand hours of post Masters clinical work 4 which requires diagnosis and treatment planning, or
- 5 (3) They have held a license as an Individual, Marriage and Family 6 Therapist in Guam, a Licensed Professional Counselor in Guam, or any 7 combination of the two for a minimum of six years."
- **Section 10.** Section 21 of Public Law 32-54 is *amended*, to read:

9 "Section 21. Grandfather Provision.

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- All licensees who hold a current, valid license as an Individual, Marriage, and Family Therapist issued by the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners, or as a Licensed Professional Counselor issued by a Guam Board, within eighteen (18) months of at the time this Article becomes law, or by August 31, 2017, whichever is later, shall be eligible to apply for a license as a Marriage and Family Therapist. They may be granted a license as a Marriage and Family Therapist if:
- 16 (a) they can pass the Marital and Family Therapy examination developed by 17 the Association of Marital and Family Therapy Regulatory Boards (AMFTRB) 18 (they shall be deemed eligible to take the test by the Board); or
- (b) they can document one thousand hours of post Masters clinical workwith couples and families; or

(c) they have held a license as an Individual, Marriage and Family Therapist on Guam, a Licensed Professional Counselor on Guam, or any combination of the two for a minimum of six years."

Section 11. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

Hafa Adai Chairperson Rodriguez,

I am in support of the proposed changes made by Bill No. 190-33. There are however a few corrections that need to be made to the document as written.

Page 1: Line 8: (LCE) should be (LPC).

Page2: Lines 5 and 6: Individual, Marriage and Family Therapist (IMFT) is no longer a license available on Guam, so no Intern license designation is needed. It should be removed.

Certified Professional Counselor is not a current license available on Guam and is not contemplated as a license, so no Intern license designation is needed. It should be removed.

Licensed Clinical Social Worker is a license under the Social Work Board and not under the Allied Board, so an Intern license designation under the Allied Board is inappropriate. It should be removed.

Page 3: Lines 12 and 13 repeat the problems noted from page 2. As such, Individual, Marriage and Family Therapist, Certified Professional Counselor, and Licensed Clinical Social Worker should be removed.

Page 3: Line 15 and 16: The words "or other Mental Health Professional, as a Licensed Mental Health Professional " are problematic. There is no current or proposed license of Licensed Mental Health Professional and no current or proposed license for "other Mental Health Professional". Both should be removed.

Page 3: Line 16: The word "legible" should be "eligible".

Page 4: Lines 5 through 14: Section 5. Section 5 refers to a portion of the existing law that consists of definitions and is not an appropriate placement for this section and should be removed in its entirety.

Page 4: "Mental Health Intern License" should be "Mental Health Counselor Intern License".

Those are all of the corrections suggested for Bill No. 190-33.

There are however two (2) additions requested.

1) Public Law No. 32-054 Section 22 contains two (2) typographical errors. Section 22 creates two (2)

new positions on the Allied Board which would in context be for a Licensed Mental Health Counselor (LMHC) and a Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT). Instead already created positions, one (1) for Respiratory Therapist, and one (1) for Nutritionist/Clinical Dietician are named. The request is to replace the words "Respiratory Therapist" with "Licensed Mental Health Counselor" and "Nutritionist/Clinical Dietician" with "Marriage and Family Therapist".

2) Sections 14 and 21, the Grandfather provisions contained in the law have no sunset provision. It has been requested that such a provision be added. It is therefore requested that the words "Licensees deemed eligible under this provision have eighteen (18) months from the time this article is enacted into law to apply as a Licensed Mental Health Counselor" and "Licensees deemed eligible under this provision have eighteen (18) months from the time this article is enacted into law to apply as a Marriage and Family Therapist".
