#### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### I. OVERVIEW

Bill 192-33 (LS) was introduced on October 20, 2015 by Senator Thomas C. Ada and was subsequently referred on October 21, 2015 to the Committee on Transportation. Infrastructure, Lands. Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on October 29, 2015 at 1:30 pm in *I Liheslaturan Guahan* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 192-33 (LS).

#### **Public Notice Requirements**

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on October 22, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on October 26, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 1:30pm.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

**Chairperson Ada:** Gives a synopsis of Bill 192-33 and explains that he will have his staff assist in the orientation of the Lots that are involved in the bills.

Joe Borja, Staff Member: Mr. Borja explains the Lot in question is Lot No. 10122-R18 and starts to give an explanation of what surrounds the Lot, i.e. the GovGuam Coral Pit, Ysengsong road, Swamp Road, Ypaopao estates, and the Golf Course to name a few.

**Chairperson Ada:** Asks Mr. Borja if the entire shaded area on the map is the whole 35 acres.

Joe Borja: He explains the shaded area of the Lot consist of about 424 acres and under Public Law 22-18 the Department of Education was reserved 35 acres within the 424 acres, but in no specific sector. The Department of Education has yet to cut out their portion. Additionally, in this particular area there is preexisting land use permits and the law prohibits the eviction of anyone who has permits or was there at least 6 months prior to December 1995. Mr. Borja explains that 35 acres was reserved for the Astumbo Elementary School. He explains further

that Astumbo Elementary School was built in Astumbo in 1997, in an area north (and outside) of Lot 10122-R18.

Chairperson Ada: Asks Mr. Borja is there specific quadrant to where the 35 acres is located.

**Joe Borja**: Replies no there is not and references Public Law 22-18. He says DOE may have a problem trying to find a contiguous 35 acres of vacant land.

Chairperson Ada: The bill basically aims to put back 35 acres into the CLTC inventory.

Senator Anthony Ada: Asks if DOE was notified of this public hearing.

Chairperson Ada: Explains they were notified. Also, a meeting was held at Senator Ada's office with DOE representatives (Taling Taitano and their CIP officer) to discuss the rationale for the bill.

Senator Anthony Ada: Asks if they were ok with it.

Chairperson Ada: The superintendent texted his position the next day and objected to the bill because DOE wanted to "save the property as a bargaining chip" for land in the future for the construction of new schools. Chairperson Ada does not agree with the idea of holding onto 35-acres of land merely as a "bargaining chip". When DOE needed property to build Astumbo Elementary, the Government of Guam provided the land needed. He did explain that land will be found and made available for DOE when needed in the future.

**Senator Anthony Ada**: Expressed his disappointment in DOE for not attending the public hearing.

**Senator Underwood**: Explains that she received a text from the DOE that they will be submitting written testimony for each of the bills. (NOTE: as of the date of this report, written testimony from GDOE had not been received)

**Senator Anthony Ada**: He believes that DOE does not think it is important to attend this public hearing especially when it deals with land for future schools.

Chairperson Ada: declares that Bill 192-33 to have been duly heard.

#### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee finds that the reason for reserving 35-acres within Lot 10122-R18 pursuant to Public Law 22-18 for the construction of the Astumbo Elementary School is now moot. Astumbo Elementary School has been built (in 2009) on GovGuam land in an area north of Lot 10122-R18. GDOE's reason, as conveyed via text message by the Superintendent, for objecting and wanting to hold onto 35-acres within Lot 10122-R18 as a "bargaining chip" is weak at best, especially when GDOE has yet to do a Master Plan on where new schools should be constructed, if needed, in the future.

The committee also finds that utility easements exists on Lot 10122-R18 and shall remain reserved for GWA and GPA as designated in there attached testimony and recommends adding language into bill 192-33 preserving all existing easements for GPA and GWA.

Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement hereby reports out **Bill 192-33 (LS) as amended,** with the recommendation TO BE PASS.

#### BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 192-33 (LS)

The proposed legislation amends P.L. 22-18, which reserved several tracts of government properties for future intended uses. P.L. 22-18 initially reserved thirty-five (35) acres of Lot No. 10122-R18 to construct Astumbo Elementary School, but the school was constructed on a different tract of property (Block 26-NEW-1, Tract 240). Because Lot No. 10122-R-18 is not being utilized for its intended purpose, the proposed legislation aims provide an alternative use of this lot by transferring it into the Chamorro Land Trust Commission's land inventory designated for residential and agricultural leasing.

Although the proposed legislation will transfer to and authorize the CLTC to utilize the 35 acres for residential/agricultural leases, it does not specifically state which type of lease will be utilized. §75107(a) of Chapter 75, Title 21 Guam Code Annotated delineates the minimum and maximum amount of acres authorized for different types of agriculture/residential leases (substinence agricultural or aquaculture farming; commercial agricultural or aquaculture use; grazing use; and residential lots). Subsequently, because the proposed legislation doesn't specify which type of lease the property will be utilized as, the amount of leases that can be awarded on the property cannot be determined.

§75108(b) states that each lessee shall pay a rental of one dollar (\$1.00) per year for the term of ninety-nine (99) years. For example, if one commercial agricultural lease (maximum 20 acres per lessee) and one grazing lease (maximum 20 acres per lessee) is awarded on the subject property, anticipated revenue to be received by the end of the lease terms will amount to \$198. However, if one commercial agricultural lease and fifteen (15) residential leases (maximum once acre per lessee) are awarded, the anticipated revenue to be received by the end of the lease term will amount to \$1,584.

Subsequently, §75107(f) specifies that the lessee shall pay any taxes assessed upon the improvements made on the property during the duration of their lease period. Increased tax assessments are correlated with improved infrastructure on the property.

It should be noted that the proposed legislation does provide for revenue generating opportunities for the Government of Guam. However, due to not having sufficient information on the specific type of leases to be awarded on the subject property, the Bureau cannot determine the estimated revenues to be received.



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



# SENATOR TOM ADA SEEKS TO ADD 225 ACRES OF LAND TO THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST INVENTORY.

Hagåtña, Guam: On October 20, 2015, Senator Tom Ada introduced Bills 192,193,194 and 195, which will add 225 acres of land to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission's Available Lands Inventory. "The lands will be put into the Commission's available lands inventory for residential and agricultural leasing", said Sen. Tom Ada.

The 225 acres of lands were originally reserved in 1993 by Public Law 22-18 for use by various GovGuam agencies. In its review, the Legislative Committee on Lands found that the land reservations were for projects to build schools and health facilities. Two of the lot portions had been reserved to construct the As-Tumbo Middle School and the As-Tumbo Elementary School. Constructions of these schools were completed in 2007 and 2008, but at different locations. In another case, property was reserved to build a foster home; but a different site was instead chosen for the construction. "Land is a precious resource. If it is not going to be used for its original intended purpose, then it needs to be accounted for and added to the Chamorro Land Trust land inventory for residential or agricultural use" said Sen. Tom Ada.

The two other lots, Lot 3463 Agana Heights and Lot 3470 Chalan Pago, have significant development issues. Lot 3463 in the Municipality of Agana Heights is unsuitable for the construction of a central high school due to location, topography, lack of infrastructure, numerous easements for pipelines and high power electrical lines and a lack of adequate access. Lot 3470 in the Municipality of Chalan Pago is unsuitable for the construction of public facilities due to location, topography, lack of infrastructure and a lack of adequate access.

The 225 total acres are located in different areas: seventy (70) acres in Dededo, thirty-eight (38) acres in Agana Heights and one hundred seventeen (117) acres in Chalan Pago. "The

acreage to be added will offset acreage that may otherwise be used by the CLTC for commercial leasing," said Sen. Ada.
