

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesia Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Thursday, January 21, 2016 at 2:00 P.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Bill No. 200-33 (COR) - "AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 79601.3. TO TITLE 21 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE THE PACIFIC RADIATION SURVIVORS MONUMENT,"** by Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr., Senator Mary Camacho Torres, Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr., Senator Frank F. Blas, Jr., Senator Brant T. McCreddie, Senator Nerissa B. Underwood, Ph.D., Senator James V. Espaldon and Senator Tommy Morrison.

Chairman Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing on Bill No. 200-33 (COR) to order at 2:00 P.M. and asked Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., the main sponsor of the bill to provide remarks. *(Please see attached for Sponsor Statement.)*

Ms. Rosita Taitano Birdwell

I am a victim of cancer. My brother C.L. Taitano died at a very young age, he had pancreas cancer. He suffered a whole lot. I spent a month with him at the military hospital. I saw other victims over there and I watched when my brother struggled. I know that he worked very hard for the island of Guam. He was involved with the education for the island of Guam. He suffered a lot during World War II including the camp in Manenggon. He is like our father and mother. My mother died during the war. My father worked very hard. We were very fortunate that we had many uncles and aunts who became our parents. But I am very proud of those backing this particular bill and it would be nice to have something. Guam has a higher rate of cancer than the United States. I have contacted cancer in 1983 and then in 2008. I am very fortunate and very blessed that it was caught early enough that I don't have to have chemo but I did get radiation. Believe me, it is not fun to go through cancer. I have to think of all the people. I have aunts and uncles and parents that died of cancer. We should recognize how big this problem is to Guam and its people. I am also diabetic, please excuse me. I am not use speaking in public but I will be glad to speak to anybody to back up this resolution and it would be nice to recognize for all those friends, Annie Rosenberger, who died of cancer and there are still those that have cancer. I belong to a prayer group to a Church and there are 12 ladies that get together and we visit St. Dominic's or people at home and when we get together and talk about our problems, we are all older people, we talk about cancer but we worry about it. We continue and laugh at it. These are strong people. The people of Guam are very strong. I am 79 years old and I live by myself. I lived in the states for 45 years and worked and I came back to Guam. My husband and I both retired. We decided that this was the biggest gift my husband gave me to return to the island of Guam. We took our saving, we have a piece of property that we bought and we built our own home. I am living home alone in Yona that my husband and I built and got everything that was approved by FEMA. Thank God and I've been blessed because the house is still standing, even with Pongsonga. We did loose partial roofing. God has been good to Guam and the people. I was listening to the first hearing, especially when Chairman Respicio asked why they don't bring the problems to the Board. We need the people to be aware of what any department in the Government is doing and you cannot do anything. If we have some people who think the people of Guam are so ignorant. The Board has to be part of it. You guys are responsible on passing this on to the public. We voted for you, we trust you and want you to do your job. I want to commend what you guys are doing. I know its very hard and I know its expensive. The prices are going up and the income not so much. I live on my social security. I have a roof over my head, I have clothing and that was the most important things growing up, as long as you have shelter and food, you will survive. When we came back here and built our farm and there is a reason God wants me the

brain and mouth are still working. Thank you for all you are doing and thank you for supporting this monument for Pacific Association for Radiation Survivors (PARS).

Robert Celestial

I am the current President of PARS. I want to thank each and every one of you. We commend you, we thank you for supporting the monument. On the drive here, I said it's a monument to remember those who passed away and there's a lot of people that were affected by it. A hidden agenda in the 40's, 50's and 60's that have affected a lot of our people. I smile because I look at the area which is awarded to us which is great but in the future we are going to need an extension. I say that with all honesty because there were a lot of people who were affected. But mainly that this bill is a really good beginning. We started back in 2000 when I went to Washington, D.C. to prove this issue, there were a lot of doubt and uncertainty. It was the National Academy of Science that said the residents of Guam are eligible receive compensation for being an affected from the nuclear fallout here on Guam. By that statement, it helped and comforted a lot of people on the understanding of what is happening to them today. With this monument, we can honor the ones that have passed who had no clue that they were affected by the nuclear fallout. Your support shows us that you do care for our people on Guam because this is a very serious issue and I thank you for asking the EPA for being more aware just because these were classified information kept secret from the people of Guam and we don't want the same thing happening to our dumps here. I'm glad and happy to know you want to help the people of Guam and this monument is going to mean a lot of good things even when we are gone.

John Farnum

Thank you for having us here. I speak on behalf of people who cannot speak anymore. Our lives have changed a lot. Living on this beautiful island paradise Guam, back then, my Dad came out here in 1947. He helped build up the military installation and met my Mom in Inarajan. Of course, they aren't here anymore. They passed away from cancer. My Mom in 1992 and my Dad in 2003, and I am a cancer survivor from September 2010. I just lost my oldest brother's wife in October last year and my youngest brother at the age of 49 with cancer. So I am in great support of this monument. It means a lot for all of us, something to dedicate that the losses are not forgotten. The calamities we go through in life is not easy. I got 3 sons and a daughter and 19 grandkids and 11 great grandkids, so I'm blessed. We all need to work together. Find a strong solution for all of us on this island so it will be positive.

Chairman Respicio

Thank you for your testimonies. Also, thank you for Speaker Won Pat for her comments on the bill. Skinners Plaza might not be the most appropriate place to put the monument. This was a discussion that came up with the *Hagatna* Redevelopment and Restoration Authority. And if they were to follow through with all their current mandates of the number of monuments allowed in that spot and it will look like headstones and I just don't think as the Speaker had pointed out that is our objective. Our objective is to provide some kind of monument that celebrates the life and legacy of all these individuals and if we are to put all these monuments into small and compact space, we are going to cheat that glory that we are all looking for. There are two options: 1) There is a monument commission, local government, that is tasked to look at all the monuments in the *Hagatna*. This bill was referred to me because of my jurisdiction over the Capitol District and that is why we are working with the Speaker to see either we let the monument commission decide the best placement or 2) wait until you guys come up with a suitable site or prefer, communicate that to the Speaker and we can probably pre-clear that site with the monument commission and we spell it out in legislation so that we don't leave it to them to do or what not to do exactly what the Speaker is intending to do by way of Bill No. 200. I will be guided by the Speaker as the main sponsor of this bill and she will let me know what you prefer.

Chairman Respicio thanked the panel for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Chairman Respicio then declared that Bill No. 200-33 (COR) was duly heard.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 79601.3. of Title 21 Guam Code Annotated is hereby added to read as follows:

“§ 79601.3. **Pacific Radiation Survivors Monument.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Pacific Association of Radiation Survivors (PARS) is hereby authorized to erect a “Guam Nuclear Down winders Memorial Monument” in the Skinner Plaza, Hagatna, in honor of the ultimate sacrifices of the men and women of Guam who, according to the U.S. National of Academy of Science, were unknowingly exposed to nuclear radiation fallout which travelled downwind from the U.S. nuclear weapons testing and detonation of 62 nuclear bombs in the Marshall Islands from 1946 to 1962, and who suffered cancer and other illness

1 associated with radiation exposure. The Pacific Association of Radiation
2 Survivors in the preparation and construction of the Monument shall comply with
3 the following provisions:

4 (a) occupy a land space not to exceed more than twenty feet (20') in length and
5 twenty feet (20') in width within the northern segment of Skinner Plaza;

6 (b) submit to I Liheslaturan Guahan the plan and design of the monument for
7 legislative approval by statute or resolution. The monument shall include, at
8 a minimum and as provided for in this Chapter, the names of Guam's men
