COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 208-33 (LS) was introduced on November 16, 2015, by Speaker Judith Won Pat. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on November 16, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on November 25, 2015, in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill No. 208-33 (LS). The hearing convened at 2:06 p.m. and was adjourned at 2:40 p.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Vice Chairwoman Mary Torres read the title of Bill No. 208-33 (LS) and yielded the floor to Speaker Judith Won Pat, the bill's primary sponsor, for an opening statement.

Speaker Won Pat explained the intent of Bill No. 208-33. She stated that the bill would amend recently passed legislation in which the provisions inadvertently prohibited refinancing of education certificates to potential investors because interest rates may be greater or less than the rate specified in the law. Speaker Won Pat mentioned that representatives of the Guam Education Financing Foundation recommended removing that provision because interest rates have a tendency to fluctuate during the duration of the projects and the current language would prevent refunding from taking place. The Foundation stated that there is another provision in the law that would already ensure a minimal level of savings for the government of Guam.

Vice Chairwoman Torres stated that the Committee did receive written testimony in support of the
egislation. With the absence of any individuals present to testify, Vice Chairwoman Torres adjourned the

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 58104 of Chapter 58, Division 5, Title 5, Guam Code 3 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"§ 58104. Authorization to Enter into Long-Term Leases.

For the purpose of facilitating the refinancing of the design, construction and maintenance of an existing Education Facility or existing Education Facilities encompassed by this Act, the government of Guam or an Education Agency, as the case may be, is authorized to lease under

existing contracts and/or existing amendments thereto, if required, to the Contractor, subject to legislative approval, sufficient government of Guam real property, to include, but *not* be limited to, Chamorro Land Trust Commission property and Guam Ancestral Lands Commission property, on which to construct, convert or rehabilitate an Education Facility; provided, such property is in the inventory of the Education Agency. The location of the property may be at the site of an existing Education Facility under the control of an Education Agency, which may be converted, rehabilitated or demolished and rebuilt under the provisions of this Act.

Any lease of property pursuant to this Act will be for a period mutually agreed upon between the Education Agency and the Contractor as may be reasonably necessary to amortize over the Lease-Back period of the Contract, the costs associated with the financing, design, construction and maintenance of the Education Facility, and in no event shall such period exceed thirty (30) years from the date of commencement of the Lease-Back period; and provided further, that with respect to leases of property for the sole purpose of refinancing the prior design, construction and maintenance of an existing Education Facility or existing Education Facilities: (1) any leases and/or amendments to such leases entered into for such purposes shall not extend the original Lease-Back period relating to such prior design, construction and maintenance of an existing Education Facility or existing Education Facilities of any original leases applied to finance such prior design, construction and maintenance of an existing Education Facility or existing Education Facilities; (2) with respect to any existing leases and/or existing amendments to leases that have the effect of refinancing the government's obligations with respect to the Guam Education Financing Foundation Certificates of Participation Series 2006 and 2008 (2006 and

2008 Certificates), all obligations of the government to pay debt service with respect to the 2006 and 2008 Certificates being refinanced shall be discharged concurrently with the execution of the leases and/or amendments to leases entered into for such refinancing purpose, and thereafter any remaining debt service on the refunded 2006 and 2008 Certificates shall be payable solely from and secured solely by a refunding escrow established for such purpose; (3) the present value in the aggregate of debt service with respect to the government's obligations with respect to such new leases or amendments to leases shall be at least two percent (2%) less than the present value in the aggregate of debt service on the refunded 2006 and 2008 Certificates, using the yield on the refunding bonds as the discount rate; and (4) no increase in the amount of outstanding "public indebtedness" as that term is used in 48 USC 1423a (§11 of the Organic Act of Guam) shall result from the execution of any such existing leases and/or existing amendments to leases.; and (5) any refinancing of such Certificates of Participation shall bear interest at such rates and be sold for such price or prices as shall result in a yield to the certificate holders that does not exceed three percent (3%) per annum.

The Contractor *shall* lease back to the Education Agency the property for the Lease-Back period. Upon the expiration of the Lease and the Lease-Back periods and the fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the Lease-Back by the Education Agency, the property and the existing Education Facility or existing Education Facilities *shall* become the property of the Education Agency, and the Contractor *shall* have no further right, title or interest in the property or the existing Education Facility or existing Education Facilities."

Dear Madam Speaker:

Thank you for your time to meet and discuss the recently passed Bill No. 174-33. This bill authorizes the refunding of the Series 2006 and Series 2008 Guam Education Financing Foundation Certificates of Participation provided a minimum of 2% or approximately \$1,000,000 of present value savings can be schieved as a result of the refinancing.

I am writing to you for your consideration in making one revision to the Bill as passed. Specifically, item (5) of the third paragraph of Section 38104 should be removed because as written this language prohibits the certificates from being marketed to investors. In the current interest rate environment some of the certificates will carry a yield to certificate holders less than 3% and some longer maturities will carry a yield in excess of 3%. This provision prevents any maturity from carrying a yield in excess of 3% which effectively means that in the current market the refunding can not proceed. If the intent was to ensure a minimal level of savings to the Government of Guam then I believe item (3) of that same section provides this assurance.

It can take four to six weeks in order to prepare all of the financing documents necessary to market the certificates to investors. Therefore, in order to provide GEDA and the underwriter with the maximum flexibility to access the market early next year I Lehislaturan Guahan's consideration of the above revision in either the November or December legislative session is requested. The bond market is very sensitive to the Federal Reserve's interest rate policy changes so being in a position to take advantage of a favorable market early next year is recommended.

According to information received from the Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA), the amendment in Bill 208-33 will allow the refinancing to move forward. The refinancing will result in the Certification of Participation's (COP's) having an average interest rate of 3%. The 3% cap in Public Law 33-94 (formerly Bill 174-33 COR) will not allow for a successful sale as the longer term 5-10 year bonds will more than likely be a little more than 3%. The GEDA notes that the cap of 3% was added to the bill by the legislative Committee. When Bill 174-33 (COR) had its public hearing, it did not have the 3% cap.
