

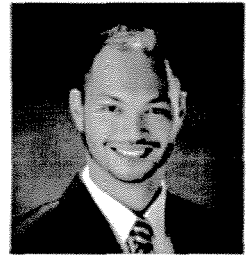

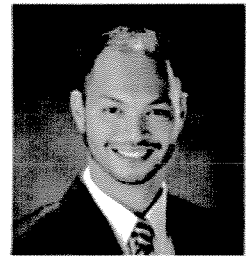

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 224-33 (COR) was introduced on December 30, 2015, by Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on January 4, 2016.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on February 10, 2016, in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill No. 224-33 (COR). The hearing convened at 10:00 a.m. and was adjourned at 11:23 a.m.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on February 3, 2016, and again on February 8, 2016. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura's* website beginning on February 3, 2016.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas yielded the floor to Senator Dennis Rodriguez to offer an opening statement on Bill No. 224-33.

Senator Dennis Rodriguez explained that the bill would extend the business privilege tax exemption for child care centers and child homes. He stated that the extension would continue to help with the provision of child care for our community.

Joseph Soriano provided written testimony in support of the bill (see attached). He explained that the exemption of centers from paying business privilege tax has helped cut potential costs toward providing care and development to the children of Guam. He stated that the exemption should be looked at as a social and economic investment in the success of the children in the future. He encouraged the Legislature to support the measure.

Gerard Huffer spoke in support of the bill. He explained that the initial exemption has helped to improve child care centers and services but other operational costs and additional regulations have resulted in the closure of one-third of the centers over the years. He stated that extending the exemption will help sustain business in spite of the rising costs and increased regulations. Mr. Huffer recommended that the exemption for care centers should be extended indefinitely and not have an end date.

Corazon San Nicolas spoke in support of the bill. She stated that the Guam Child Care and Development Association represents 44 different service providers and would like to see the business privilege tax exemption be extended, which will assist in the continuation of service.

Chairman San Nicolas asked if the care centers ever considered assuming not for profit tax status. He explained that this would help exempt their organizations from almost all taxes and not just the business privilege tax. He stated that he would discuss the idea with the bill's author and the Department of Revenue and Taxation. He further explained that the language of the bill would eliminate all exemptions beyond the proposed exemption date of December 31, 2021, and not allow future businesses to receive the five-year exemption.

Senator Frank Aguon stated his support for the bill. He also mentioned that he was inclined to support both the recommendation to extend the exemption indefinitely and also reconsidering the not for profit status for the care centers and providers. Senator Aguon explained that an investment in the care centers is helping to improve things for future generations.

Senator Nerissa Underwood thanked the providers for their service for the community. She stated the importance of their service to children and the assistance they provide for parents who work. She asked if child care centers are providing pre-school services to students that qualify.

Mr. Huffer stated that almost all centers serve pre-school aged children and that demographic allows them to make the more profit than with infants and toddlers. He indicated that the start of a universal pre-school program would have a detrimental effect on ability of child care centers to survive financially.

Senator Underwood stated that the economic effects of a pre-school program will be incorporated in a study that will be provided and the conclusion of the pilot program. She mentioned that the data will assist in determining whether or not the pre-school program gets expanded.

Mr. Soriano explained that the pre-school curriculum provided in the child care centers is comparable to other providers of the same services. He stated that they understand the need to provide stellar service to the community but need economic assistance to help child care centers continue to survive.

Ms. San Nicolas stated that child care centers offer services for children up to 12 years old which includes pre-school and pre-kindergarten children.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that the establishment of a charter school-model could be applied to the pre-kindergarten aged children with regards to the child care centers.

Mr. Huffer stated that the association looked into that process and encountered some obstacles in developing certain standards and regulations to follow.

Sabina Tamondong testified in favor of the bill. She stated that child care centers stay open longer than schools that offer the same services for children of the appropriate age. She mentioned that child care centers are the best equipped to focus on pre-school and pre-kindergarten children.

Senator Rodriguez acknowledged that many points were brought up during the hearing. He thanked the individuals who testified and asked that the Legislature work on getting the bill passed before the expiration of the November deadline.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that he will convene a roundtable with relevant stakeholders to find a solution to the issue. Without other individuals present to testify, Chairman San Nicolas concluded the hearing for Bill 224-33.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee is in receipt of an amended version of Bill No. 224-33 (COR) from the author of the legislation, which has been included in this report.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development hereby reports out Bill No. 224-33 (COR), as amended by the author, with the recommendation TO REPORT OUT ONLY.

We are writing in regards to Bill no. 141-31, which was signed into law on November 14, 2011 as Public Law 31-127 providing child care and development center Gross Receipt Tax exemptions for a period of five years. The GRT exemption law is expiring in November 2016.

Your help to extend the expiration date for another 5 years is being solicited to continue providing quality learning and development services to our children of Guam. The following is 2015 and 2011 statistical data with regards to estimated average GRT revenue from Guam Child Learning and Development Centers/Institutions and Home and Group Care.

Total number of centers reduced by 4 since 2011, from total of 47 to current total of 43. Of the 43 centers, 39 are licensed Child Learning and Development Centers and 4 are licensed Home and Group Child Care. Albeit tuition increased by 12%, cost of operating a child development center increased 15%, primarily due to wages, utilities and other increases. Certainly, exempting all centers from paying GRT for the last four years have helped towards providing quality care and development to our children of Guam.

Think of the GRT exemption as an investment for the success of our children and not a tax on providing quality care and development for children. This small investment in early childhood education for our children will certainly be a savings in future cost on delinquencies and other social issues facing our island. Think of it as a social economic investment or a social return on investment.

Your gracious assistance to allow another five (5) years extension of the GRT exemption under the aforementioned law, will certainly be appreciated by all, the children, including children with disabilities and their working parents, whom we serve.
