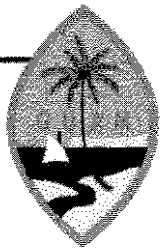

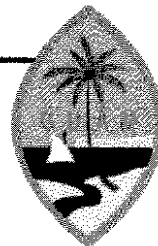

I. **OVERVIEW**

Bill No. 236-33 (LS) was introduced on January 19, 2016, by Senator V. Anthony Ada, Senator Frank B. Aguon Jr., Senator Frank F. Blas, and Senator Brant T. McCreadie, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary on January 19, 2016.

The Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary convened a public hearing on Bill No. 236-33 (COR) on a Wednesday, January, 27 2016 at 4:00PM in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Wednesday, January 20, 2015 (5-Day Notice), and again on Monday, January 25, 2016 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 4:00 PM.

II. **SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION**

Chairman Aguon:

This public hearing sponsored by the Committee on Guam, excuse me ladies and gentlemen in the audience we just started the public hearing. This public hearing sponsored by the Committee on Guam U.S. Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary is hereby convened and if I can ask everyone in the audience should you have your cellphones on to please ensure that they are either placed in the silent mode or they are turned off for the duration of this hearing and if you do need to take a phone call or make a phone call, please exit the public hearing room. I would like to first of all start off by stating that this particular public hearing will be. We will be discussing two particular legislations.

Chairman Aguon:

Bill No. 229-33 which is relative to the temporary employment of retired conservation officers within the Division of Aquatic and Wildlife Resources of the Department of Agriculture should a critical need arise due to military activation or long-term disability. Also the second bill that will be discussed is Bill No.236-33 (LS) relative to the possession of firearms by aliens and introduced by the Honorable Senator V.A. Ada who is to my immediate left. For purposes of public notification, the initial notification was disseminated to all the stakeholders as well as to our media partners on the 20th of January and then the secondary notice was distributed on the 25th of January in compliance with the open government notification act. I would like to also recognize Senator Tony Ada who has joined us this afternoon. Thank you very much Senator for joining us in this particular public hearing.

Ladies and Gentlemen we will be proceeding to the next legislation that's on the agenda and it is sponsored by Senator Tony Ada and it's an act relative to possession of fire arms by aliens. Bill No. 236-33. Before I recognize the good Senator to provide his description of the legislation, I would like to invite the following individuals to join us up-front please. Joni Kerr, David Anderson, Albert Silos, and Scott Wade. Once again if by any chance you would like to join us and provide testimony I would like to invite the following individuals, Joni Kerr, Daniel Anderson, Albert Silos, and Scott Wade to join us up front. Senator Ada.

Senator Tony Ada:

Thank you Mr. Chairman. Mr. Chairman, what Bill 236-33 does is actually it removes the restriction on firearm id's for permanent resident aliens. It was introduced to make Guam firearms possession laws constitutional. As you know many state and local federal courts have struck down laws that deny permanent resident aliens second amendment rights and as you know permanent residency is that final step into an individual actually becomes a naturalized citizen. Just to simply put it, those with green cards will be eligible for a firearms id. Thank you Mr. Chair.

Chairman Aguon:

Thank you very much Senator Ada. We'll start off with Mr. Albert Silos. Please identify yourself for the record and proceed.

Mr. Albert Silos:

My name is Albert Silos. I've been a resident of Guam for over 40 years. I am a citizen of the United States and I've been issued a firearms id concealed since 1982. I would like to testify in favor of this bill. We are facing two issues on this bill. One is that issuance of ids to representatives of foreign government and the second is the issuance of permits to and license to permanent aliens and green card holders. First I would like to touch on the representatives of foreign government. Several years ago, I got a call from the Consul General of the Philippines telling me that he went to the Guam Police Department and he was told by the people at the department that he had to undergo some. He had to submit to some requirements. One of them was like their finger printing and all those checks. So I called one the majors from the police department and I asked why was this requirement made?

Mr. Albert Silos:

Generally, officials of foreign government that are assigned to the United States, go through a background check by the United States State Department before they can assume their new positions. So the major told me I think there was some misunderstanding with the people down stairs so the major asked me to send the, have the Consul General go and meet him and then issue him a license. So I don't want a case like that to happen again because if these people are cleared by the U.S State Department, who are we to question the capacity of the state department in checking the background of these people? So I am in favor of this one okay. The next one is the issuance of firearm ids to permanent resident aliens or green card holders. As far as I know, there is no law in Guam, which mandates the issuance of fire arm license only to the citizens of the United States. Years ago I don't know how it got into the books; it was a requirement by applicants to be a U.S. citizen. That requirement was challenged in court ... and it was then ruled as unconstitutional by Judge Abbate. After the ruling of Judge Abbate, that requirement was taken out of the application form for the police. Later on, when Earl Aguigui became Chief of Police, he put that requirement back not to law, but by general orders of the police. From my understanding the general order for the police department only affects members of the police department not the general public. There was no public hearing, there was no triple a, no nothing at all. It was mandated only by the Chief of Police okay. So a lot of people, who were green card holders that were issued firearm ids during that interval from the ruling of Judge Abbate to the assumption of Earl Aguigui as Chief of Police, got their ids through legal means. After the ruling came back and some of them tried to renew their firearm ids because of the general order of Chief Aguigui they were told they cannot renew their license anymore. They got their license in good faith. No what happened was the general order of Aguigui made them become a felon because they were in possession of fire arms which were legally acquired through their license during that period but later on they were being denied renewal. So from a misdemeanor now they became felons. So what these people had to do, they had to give their firearms to the legally license individuals for safe keeping while they are in limbo. So I am now in favor, testifying in favor of this bill to give these green card holders the right to get their firearm ids again. In the United States, most of the states especially like Arizona, Nevada. Arizona does not even require fire arm id. You just go to the store. Pay for your firearm, show your drivers license, you walk out of the store with a firearm, but that is only for long rifles, okay. Rifles or shotguns and pistols, they have the waiting period of a seven day waiting period. So I would like this bill to go through so those people that are in limbo right now, who acquired their firearms legally will now be given the chance to come in and renew their license. So there are two issues, the consular officials, and the permanent resident alien, okay. Thank you very much for allowing me to testify on this.

Chairman Aguon:

Thank you very much Mr. Silos for your testimony this afternoon. Officer Wade?

Lieutenant Scott Wade:

Buenas yan Hafa Adai senators, members of the Committee of the US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary. Thank you for allowing us the opportunity to testify in support of Bill No. 236-33LS. I am Lieutenant Scott Wade of the Guam Police Department, Legal Affairs section. The Chief of Police regrets he can not attend today, as his presence is required at a previously scheduled event.

Lieutenant Scott Wade:

After review of the proposed Bill No. 236-33 (LS) an act to amend subsection 60108 B2 and 60109.1A1 of Chapter 60 title GCA relative to the possession of firearms by aliens. The Guam Police Department is in support of the proposed amendments which would include into the current statute and specifically define what category of classifications of aliens is permitted to apply for and obtain a Guam firearms and Guam concealed firearms identification card. This amendment follows federal statutes that similarly cover the issue of legal possession of a firearm by aliens. It better reflects the intent of the federal statute and we agree with the definition and language of the proposed amendments. This amendment would assist our department in vetting firearm applications and differentiating between permanent resident aliens and non-eligible aliens as defined by the immigration and nationality law act of 1965. Thank you for allowing our department to submit our testimony in support of Bill No. 236-33 (LS).

Chairman Aguon:

Thank you very much Lieutenant Wade and thank the Chief, please, for participating in this particular discussion providing the position of the department. Senator Ada.

Senator Tony Ada:

Yes, thank you Mr. Chair. I'd like to thank them both for coming here to testify and support of the Bill No. 236. It was just brought, you know, we do have a, one amendment that we will be making and that's the section, it will be 60109.1B, instead of A. So, just for clarification and ensure that, that correction will be made. Thank you Mr. Chair.

Chairman Aguon:

Okay, thank you. Senators, any questions or comments on the proposal? Senator Torres, you're recognized.

Senator Mary Torres:

Officer Wade, I was wondering, with regard to the National Instant Criminal Background Check System, the NICS system. Do you feel that this bill substantially satisfies that requirement, that federal requirement for id, and I think it's an iced issued id, or is there something more that you think needs to be addressed in this bill? Because it calls for a green card.

Lieutenant Scott Wade:

From my understanding of the bill and the current process for obtaining firearms id, individuals that apply will still be vetted to the practice that we do now, which is obtaining a finger print identification verification. They also run through the NCIC, National Criminal Information System Network to verify any arrest or issues in any of the states. So they would, from my understanding, the permanent resident aliens that apply would still be vetted through the same process as US citizens or anybody else applying for a firearm id on Guam.

Senator Mary Torres:

Okay, and then in your estimate, this pretty much is in conformance with the recent executive order by the, by Obama, right, with regard to background checks and that sort of thing. It will all, all things will fall into play with that?

Lieutenant Scott Wade:

Yes, ma'am.

Senator Mary Torres:

Okay.

Lieutenant Scott Wade:

The process would still be the same for permanent resident aliens and US citizens.

Senator Mary Torres:

Okay, thank you. No further questions.

Chairman Aguon:

Thank you very much Senator Torres and Lieutenant Wade and Mr. Silos thank you very much for your testimony this afternoon and thank you Senators for joining us. This concludes our discussion on the public hearing on Bill No. 229-33 and Bill No. 236-33. The committee will continue to accept written testimony for the subsequent ten days following this particular hearing and then the committee report will be provided and closed out for consideration by the entire legislature. Thank you very much folks. Have a good day.

Bill to clarify Guam's firearms law

Current Guam law, as written, may limit the Second Amendment right to bear arms to island residents who are U.S. citizens. One Guam lawmaker is attempting to fix the language of the law to bring the island in line with federal statutes.

Sen. Tony Ada recently introduced a bill that would ensure the island's firearms laws do not violate the Second Amendment.

Bill 236-33 would amend the language of Guam's firearms identification and concealed firearms license requirements to include permanent resident aliens.

Scheduled hearing

Ada introduced the bill on Jan. 19. A public hearing for the bill will be held at the Legislature at 4 p.m. Wednesday.

The bill is a clarification to get in line with federal immigration laws.

Ada said he's been working closely with the Guam Police Department on the topic of concealed carry.

This bill was a result of a process of reviewing Guam's firearms laws and updating sections that may be in question, he said.

Since being elected to the 30th Legislature, Ada has introduced more than 60 bills, including legislation related to concealed firearms licensing and castle law.

Ada said he plans to work on more legislation that deals with firearms in Guam.

Sens. Frank Aguon Jr., Frank Blas Jr., and Brant McCreadie are co-sponsoring the bill.

13 Section 2. Subsection 60109, (a)(1) of 10GCA is amended to read as follows:

14 "(1) is a resident of Guam and a citizen of the United States or permanent resident
15 alien. For purposes of this subsection, permanent resident alien is defined in
16 Subsection (2) of 60109(b) of this Chapter."
