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#### **COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST**

Bill No. 26-33 (COR)

I. OVERVIEW: The Committee on Health, Economic Development, Homeland Security and Senior Citizens conducted a public hearing on April 8, 2015. The hearing convened at 9AM in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill 26-33 (COR)- An act to amend § 4301(b) of 4 GCA, Relative to the Calculation of Government of Guam Group Health Insurance Plan Employee Contributions; Sponsored by Tina Rose Muna Barnes.

The public hearing on agenda item Bill No. 26-33(COR) was called to order at 9:10AM.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION.

Chairman Rodriguez invited Senator Muna Barnes, author of Bill 26-33 (COR) to provide a brief synopsis of the proposed legislation.

#### **Senator Tina Muna Barnes:**

Si Yu'os Ma'ase', Mr. Chair. Bill 26-33 COR is an act to add a new section 10315 to Chapter 10 Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated relative to the online and public disclosure of medical licenses issued by the Guam Board of Medical Examiners. This legislation would require that the Guam Board of Medical Examiners publish on their website the list of licenses that they issue right now for the members who are licensed to do work here on Guam through the Guam Board of Medical Examiners.

We note that the Guam Medical Association and the Guam Medical Society have lists of their members but no complete of list of all the doctors who actively practice here on Guam are listed so



that our community can look online and look for the different professions. I will note Mr. Chair that for record purpose that I did just receive this just this morning. It was a letter from the Department of Public Health addressed to you in reference to their concerns and the issues regarding this.

One of the proposals was to look at requiring full transparency and making sure that the bill include all the health care and allied health professionals licensed on Guam including the Cosmetology Board Licenses and then they list about almost 15-20 different disciplines that we should be able to look at so there are other concerns and issues that they brought up regarding fees and finances and not being able to have the ability because they don't have a webmaster or someone in the IT department that could do this but I do know that based on their concerns for other statutes that are put in place today that require them to do portions of what they're concerns have been brought up so, I'll continue to work with the committee on health to look at this and make the proper amendments so that we can have this positive bill moving forward so our community could know all of the disciplines of the health professions that are here on Guam and make sure that the people have, can have access to that and hopefully the committee will vote on this measure so that we can move it on the agenda and the people have that fair opportunity to look for all the medical professions that are listed in and they can utilize if at the touch of their hands to go through the internet to see that they're on board.

There being no other testimony, or comments by Senators, Chairman Rodriguez declared the bill as having been heard, and concluded the public hearing on Bill No.26-33(COR).

## I MINA' TRENTAL TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2015 (FIRST) Regular Session

Bill No. 26 -33 (COR)

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 10315 TO CHAPTER 10, TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO THE ONLINE AND PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF MEDICAL LICENCES ISSUED BY THE GUAM BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 10315 is hereby *added* to 5 GCA Chapter 10 to read as follows:

## "§ 10315. Special Requirement for Medical Licenses.

Within six (6) calendar months of the enactment hereof, the Guam Board of Medical Examiners shall publish and update on a quarterly basis on its website a listing of licenses issued pursuant to Chapter 12, Article2, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated Physicians Practice Act), including the license holder's name, primary work address, phone number, specialty, initial date of licensure, license status, and board certifications."

Section 2. Enactment. This Act is effective upon enactment.

Dear Senator Rodriguez,

On behalf of the Health Professional Licensing Office (HPLO), Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), I have the following testimony to submit in regards to Bill No. 26-33 "Online Disclosure and Public Disclosure of Medical Licenses":

- In regards to "Publishing and updating on a quarterly basis on the website of the Guam Board of Medical Examiners a listing of licensees" please take note of the following information that can be provided as public information posting on the Website:
  - · Name of Licensee
  - Work Address
  - Specialty
  - Phone Number-This information is not for public information posting and is a privacy issue unless it is a work phone number.
  - Initial date of licensure-This information is not for public information posting and is a paid service as provided on a Verification of Licensure Payment of Record per Chapter 12, 10 G.C.A. Article 2, 12217. Verification of licensure costs \$25.00 per verification and is a formal notice from state Boards verifying the license of a healthcare professional and ensuring that licensee is actually licensed and in good standing in that state. Last quarter, the Health Professional Licensure Office averaged an issuance of @ 50 verifications-60% were for Physicians and the 40% remaining were for other health care professionals.
  - License Status information is available for public information posting but would be limited
    to the status of the license as either "Active" meaning currently licensed, or "Inactive" which
    means the licensed expired. If a license is encumbered, meaning board actions were placed on
    that license, then court documents may also be posted on the website for public information
    posting. However, police reports and arrests will not be available for public information
    posting.
- 2. This bill is requiring Website Procurement which the Guam Board of Medical Examiners currently does not have. A dedicated website will require additional funds to procure IT support and Internet Webpage development which, is dependent on justification of the use of HPLO revolving funds. In accordance to Chapter 12, 10 GCA. Subsection 12229 Revolving Fund

"There is created a Revolving Fund within the Health Professional Licensing Office, into which all money payable under the provisions of these Chapters XII, XIII, XIV, and Chapter V of Title XVII of the Government Code of Guam, shall be deposited. The revolving fund shall be used to defray the cost of obtaining standardized examination materials and services for the healing arts and cosmetology licensure and the cost of proctoring examination at the testing site; and for operational expenses necessary for testing and monitoring of examination. Tests for licensure of all the healing arts and cosmetology shall be given at least every six (6) months."

- Bill 26-33 requires transparency for physicians licensed on Guam only. This bill should include all healthcare and allied health professionals licensed on Guam, including cosmetology board licensees:
  - Registered Nurses, Nurse Practitioner, Licensed Practical Nurses, Certified Nurse Aides
  - Dentists, Dentist Assistant, Dental Auxiliary
  - Pharmacists, Pharmacy Assistants
  - Veterinarians
  - Chiropractics
  - Nutritionists, Dieticians
  - Respiratory Therapists, Physical Therapists, Speech Therapists, Occupational Therapists
  - Social Workers
  - Counselors, Individual, Marriage, and Family Therapists
  - Optometrists, Opthamologists
  - Cosmetologists and Barbers, Manieurists, Estheticians
  - Acupuncturists
  - Physician Assistants
  - Emergency Medical Technicians, Paramedics
  - Home Care Administrators
  - Podiatrists and Audiologists
- 4. It is highly recommended to amend Chapter 12 Subsection 12229 Revolving Fund to include defrayment of costs for website development and maintenance, and for the other administrative costs of the HPLO boards and commissions. Duties and responsibilities of the Boards include the following:
  - Verification and Issuance of licenses-active (over 6,000 licensees) and non active;
  - Ensure public protection of professional standards of practice for healthcare providers;
  - Administer examinations which are secure, standardized, and psychometrically sound;
  - Process complaints and conduct investigation of licensees, programs, establishments, equipment, and services; Network with law enforcement and Attorney General's Office.
  - Conduct meetings and hearings and process payment for board members, print advertisement, transcriptions, audio recordings;
  - Conduct board education trainings (Public Law 32-031);
  - Process travel authorizations for mandatory Board member/staff participation at National Association meetings and trainings-webinars, conferences, delegate assemblies, meetings, and forums;

- Develop policies and procedures consistent with rules and regulations, and local and federal statutes for the regulatory responsibilities and reporting requirements of licensed healthcare providers;
- Accept and process licensing fees based on established schedule of fees.
- 5. Most importantly, it is crucial at this time to increase the schedule of fees for the HPLO boards and approve an annual appropriation for the direct or contractual hiring of professional support staff-Nursing Administrator, secretaries, investigators and legal counsel. Current staffing of the HPLO includes 2 word processing secretaries (1 FTE and 1 Limited Term), and 1 administrative assistant (1 FTE). The HPLO Nursing Administrator position has been vacant since 1999 with the resignation of Mrs. Teofila Cruz, RN, MSN. Since then there have been various Acting Administrators serving the HPLO Office. Additional funds are direly needed for costs incurred for legal proceedings for board actions on licensees to include legal counsel fees, transcriptions, audio and video recordings, security guards, and other incurred costs.

In conclusion, I commend your efforts to improve transparency for the licensed physicians and healthcare providers on Guam; however, additional funds are needed to make this possible. For more information, you may email me at marlene carbullido@dphss.guam.gov or call 735-7412.
