

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 284-33 (COR) was introduced on March 21, 2016 by Senator Thomas C. Ada and was subsequently referred on March 22, 2016 by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on April 14, 2016 at 9:00 am in *I Liheslaturan's* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 284-33 (COR).

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on April 7, 2016 (5-Day Notice) and again on April 13, 2016 (48-Hour Notice). Notice was also posted on the Legislature television channel.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada turns the floor over to the sponsor, Senator Rory J. Respicio, of Bill No. 284-33 (COR), to give an introduction of the bill.

Senator Respicio: reads his introduction. (see attached)

With there being no testimony, Chairperson Ada ends the public hearing for Bill No. 284-33 (COR).

III. Findings and Recommendations

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement finds that Bill No. 284-33 (COR) is to make a technical amendment in the public hearing notice of §3219(c) of Chapter 3 of Title 16 of the Guam Code Annotated. The technical amendment requires tire dealers to post an out of date and misleading notice as to what is the maximum age allowable by law for the sale of old tires. Thus brining the language in accordance with the new statutory requirement.

After considering the findings and testimonies given at the public hearing, the Committee hereby reports out **Bill No. 284-33 (COR)**, with the recommendation TO DO PASS.

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslatura Guahan* finds
3 that Public Law 32-214 updated the standards for sale of used tires. In order to
4 further clarify the notice requirements for the statutory mandated standards, *I*
5 *Liheslatura* finds that the notice language should be revised to reflect the changes
6 in the standards approved by Public Law 32-214.

7 **Section 2.** Section 3219 (c) of Chapter 3, Title 16 of the Guam Code
8 Annotated is amended to read:

9 “(c) Each retailer, wholesaler and distributor of tires on Guam shall, at the place of
10 sale, post in a conspicuous location, in letters at least two (2) inches tall, a
11 statement that indicates the dangers of aged tires. The statement shall be printed as

13 WARNING – AGED TIRES CAN FAIL IN USE, CAUSING LOSS OF

16 ~~(6)~~ TEN 10 YEARS MAY NOT BE SOLD OR MOUNTED FOR USE ON

Sponsor Statement on Bill No. 284-33 (COR)- "An act to amend Section 3219 (c) of Chapter 3 of Title 16 of the Guam Code Annotated to amend the notice requirement for the sale of used tires," by **Senator Rory J. Respicio**.

Bill No. 284-33 concerns a recent change in the law related to the sale of used tires. Public Law 32-214 revised the maximum age for used tires for sale setting it at ten years. However, the public notice requirement in another section of the code setting out the language of the notice was not changed to bring it into accord with the new statutory requirement. So as it stands now, tire dealers are required to post an out of date and misleading notice as to what is the maximum age allowable by law for the sale of old tires. This would be corrected by Bill No. 284-33, which provides for the technical change necessary. I therefore thank the Committee for hearing this measure so promptly and I seek your approval of this legislation.
