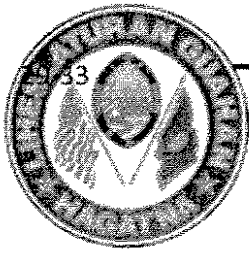

I. **OVERVIEW**

Bill No. 296-33 (COR) was introduced on April 13, 2016, by Senator V. Anthony Ada and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary on April 14, 2016.

The Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary convened a public hearing on Bill No. 296-33 (COR) on a Wednesday, May, 25, 2016 at 11:00AM in I *Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room.

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 11:00 AM.

II. **SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION**

**Chairman Aguon:**

Welcome to our people who are watching this particular session. This public hearing sponsored by the Committee on Guam, Public Safety, and Judiciary is hereby convened. In today's agenda we do have several items. The initial legislation or the bills that will be discussed are Bill No. 291-33 relative to custody and visitation of deployed military parents.

**Chairman Aguon:**

Bill No. 296-33, relative to training requirements for concealed carry licenses. Bill No. 309-33, which is relative to compensation or promotional opportunities for our law enforcement within the Guam Police Department and Bill No. 311-33 relative to unlawful distribution of images of persons depicted in a state of nudity or engaged in sexual activities otherwise known as revenge pornography. For the purposes of the discussion this morning, I am going to move the items around just slightly. We will entertain Bill No. 309-33 initially. We do have the Chief of Police and several individuals who would like to provide testimony and I know that the Chief of Police and his personnel are providing security for our off island delegations from Fest Pac, so we want to insure that they are given that opportunity to return and continue to carry out that particular mission. Aside from that we will go back to the sequence of the agenda. I would like to thank the Vice Chair Senator Tom Ada to my left. Thank you very much Mr. Vice Chair for joining us this morning. Senator Mary Torres. Thank you senator and Senator Brant McCreadie for joining us this morning. Thank you.

We will proceed to Bill No. 296, which is relative to training requirements for concealed carry licenses, and the sponsor is Senator Tony Ada. Senator Ada would you like to provide comments?

**Senator Tony Ada:**

Yes, thank you Mr. Chairman. Mr. Chairman, Bill No. 296-33 is an act to amend section 60109 1 (a)(\*) of chapter 60 of 10 gca and this is relative to the training requirements for the concealed carry licenses. Bill 296-33 clarifies the training requirements for those seeking to conceal carried firearms licenses. Mr. Chairman, subsequent to the enactment of Public Law 32-150, which made Guam's concealed carry firearms law constitutional. My office had several meetings with GPD personnel and various groups on several issues including the training requirements of the concealed carry law, and since the law was based on model legislation it included a provision that allowed training from the Guam Department of Agriculture to suffice for the law's training requirement and unlike other jurisdictions, Guam Department of Agriculture does not offer such training and secondly, GPD had informed me that a few applicants are attempting to use online videos to meet the training requirements and since there is no prohibition contained in the law our researched revealed that other states in practice allows the use of online firearm safety training to suffice for their training requirements and although GPD does not recognize online training, for concealed carry license, the enactment of this bill will close that potential loop hole that people may seek to gain their training requirements from. Thank you Mr. Chair.

**Chairman Aguon:**

Thank you very much Senator Tony. If I can invite Chief Joseph Cruz to provide testimony and I also have Andrew Quitugua signed in. If Mr. Quitugua you would like to also provide oral testimony, then you're welcome to join us up front. Chief Cruz. You're recognized.

**Chief Cruz:**

Good morning senator. I've introduced myself already so I'll get right into my testimony.

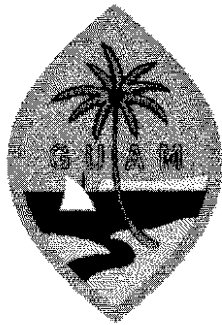

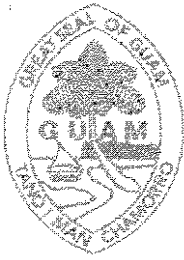

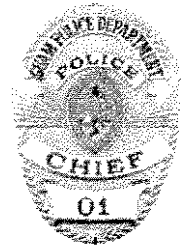

I am Joseph I. Cruz, Chief of Police for the Guam Police Department, and I thank you for the opportunity to appear before you today in my official capacity along with key members of the Guam Police Department to render testimony in support of Bill 296-33 (COR).

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Guam Police Department is in support of Bill 296-33, an act relative to the training requirements for concealed carry licenses. This Bill takes into consideration the components of Public Law 32-150 passed into law on May 21, 2014 with regard to the training needed to demonstrate competence with a firearm.

GPD is the authorized agency issuing licenses to carry concealed firearms by qualified persons pursuant to Title 10, Chapter 60 Firearms, §60109 and §60109.1 Concealed Firearms; Shall Issue License. GPD processes each application for a concealed Firearms Identification Card to ensure that applicants are eligible and meet the criterion required by Public Law 32-150 passed into law on May 21, 2014. Training requirements pursuant to the law allow for applicants to qualify for a concealed Firearms Identification Card by providing evidence of one (1) of the following:

- (A) Completion of any hunter education or hunter safety course approved by the Department of Agriculture (Fish and Wildlife Division) or a similar agency of another state;**
- (B) Completion of any National Rifle Association firearms safety or training course;**
- (C) Completion of any firearms safety or training course or class available to the general public offered by a law enforcement, junior college, college, or private or public institution or organization or firearms training school, utilizing instructors certified by the National Rifle Association, the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission, or the Guam Police Department;**
- (D) Completion of any law enforcement firearms safety or training course or class offered for security guards, investigators, special deputies, or any division or subdivision of law enforcement or security enforcement;**
- (E) Presents equivalent experience with a firearm as evidenced by United States Armed Forces training record, or DD214 with a notation of firearms training and honorable discharge; or**
- (F) Completion of any firearms training or safety course or class conducted by a Guam-certified or National Rifle Association certified firearms instructor;**

The Guam Police Department has seen a significant rise in the number of Concealed Firearms Identification Cards issued to qualified persons from 2013 to 2015. In 2013 GPD issued 102 Concealed Firearms Identification Cards, and more than in 2011 and 2012, when we issued 83 and 64 respectively. After the passage of PL 32-150 in 2014, there were five hundred and ninety seven (597) persons who qualified and were issued Concealed Firearms Identification cards that year (2014). In 2015 GPD issued eight hundred and seven (807) Concealed Firearms Identification Cards to qualifying persons. The Firearms Identification Card and Firearms Registration data for the five-year trend from 2011 to 2015 is provided in the chart in this:

The Guam Police Department acknowledges the current training criterion requires evidence that applicants are handling firearms during training, with the exception of; (A) Completion of any hunter education or hunter safety course...GPD is in support of Bill 296-33 to remove this training, and "Internet, online, self-study or correspondence courses..." that do not require the physical handling of a firearm, overseen by a qualified instructor as part of a training program. Competent firearms instructors provide the necessary fundamentals needed to safely handle a firearm.

Therefore, on behalf of the Guam Police Department we are in support of this Bill and respectfully request for the recommendation mentioned herewith, be considered and included in Bill 296-33.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank this committee for allowing me to provide this testimony in support of Bill ~~296-33~~<sup>309-33</sup> Mr. Chairman, this concludes my testimony, si Yu'os Ma' Ase para y tiempon miyu. At this point I am subject to any questions that you may have.
