Section 2. Section 6235 (d) of Chapter 6 of Title 4, Guam Code Annotated is hereby repealed and reenacted to read:

- (d) Certification Pay Differential, Established.
 - (1) All Government of Guam line employees, the Office of Public Accountability, the University of Guam, and the Guam Department of Education employees who have obtained a nationally recognized certification as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA), or a Certified Government Financial Manager (CGFM), or a Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE), or a Certified Internal Auditor (CIA), *shall* be entitled to receive a single certification pay differential.
 - (2) The Pay differential *shall* be applicable *only* to Single certification accomplished by the employee, whichever is higher, and will be

processed based on *only one* of the following, depending on the *highest certification* accomplished:

- (a) A Guam licensed CPA *shall* be eligible to receive a fifteen percent (15%) increase; or,
- (b) The CGFM, CFE, and CIA, which are nationally recognized but *not* required to be Guam licensed, *shall* be eligible to receive a ten percent (10%) increase; or,
- (c) If the employee has a Guam licensed CPA *prior* to the enactment of this Act, section (2)(a) of this Subsection shall be applicable *only*.
- (3) The pay differential *shall* apply and is limited to a single certification, and *shall not* be used in any calculation of the rate of pay with respect to overtime, and shall not be considered pay or compensation in any calculation of enhanced compensation otherwise provided by law.
- (4) The employee salary *must* commensurate with the currently approved Government of Guam pay/wage scale. Any deviation from the currently approved Government of Guam pay plan *shall not* qualify for the differential in this act.
- (5) The Director of Administration and the President of the University of Guam shall implement a single certification pay differential for all the CPA, CGFM, CFE, and CIA, who are active in their area of certification. Accounting, Auditing, Budgeting and Management

professionals who have a national or Guam Board certification, *shall* be entitled to the certification pay differential provided in Item (1) of this Subsection, calculated at the rates above, added to the base pay to rectify an inequity in certification pay.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

- (3) The pay differential *shall* apply and is *limited* to a single certification, and *shall not* be used in any calculation of the rate of pay with respect to overtime, and *shall not* be considered pay or compensation in any calculation of enhanced compensation otherwise provided by law.
- (4) The employee salary must be commensurate with the currently approved government of Guam pay/wage scale. Any deviation from the currently approved government of Guam pay plan *shall not* qualify for the differential in this Act.
- (5) The Director of Administration and the President of the University of Guam *shall* implement a single certification pay differential for all the CPA, CGFM, CFE and CIA who are active in their area of certification. Dear Senator Rodriguez:

This is to again express appreciation for the passage of Bill 46-33 now P.L. 33-18, that provides for certification pay adjustment to individuals who have earned the status as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA), Certified Government Financial Manager (CGFM), Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE) and /or other nationally recognized certifications. Four from my office including myself were adjusted accordingly. Now we have three staff studying for the CPA, CGFM or CFE exams.

Bill 299-33 attempts to clarify that only one certification pay may be given. We understand the limitation and support it. At OPA we have three individuals including me that could have qualified for multiple certification pay adjustments, 15% for the CPA and 10% for the CGFM. We chose not to implement the double certification pay although the Attorney General's opinion seems to authorize it.

Again thank you for recognizing these hard working individuals with these unique qualifications by providing the certification pay.

The Bureau requests that Bill No(s). 299-33 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

The intent of the proposed legislation is to repeal and reenact Section §6235 (d) of Article 2 of Chapter 6, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, relative to clarifying the number of allowed certification pay incentive to Government of Guam line employees who have obtained Certified Public Accountant, Certified Government Financial Management, Certified Fraud Examiner, and Certified Internal Auditor Certification. Section §6235 was added by P.L. 33-18 which lapsed into law on April 14, 2015.

As currently written in Chapter 6, Title 4 GCA §6235 (d) all Government of Guam line agencies, Office of the Public Accountability, the University of Guam, and the Guam Department of Education employees who have obtained a nationally recognized certification as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA), Certified Government Financial Management (CGFM), Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE) or Certified Internal Auditor (CIA) shall be entitled to receive a one-time certification pay differential. However, the language in this section is vague and may result in pay adjustments in excess of what was intended by law.

The bill as written clarifies the total number of certification pay an employee is allowed to receive. Should an employee received more than one certification, the pay differential shall apply to a single certification, whichever is higher, and processed based on one of the certifications.

In its current form, the subject legislation does not pose a fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
