### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 320-33 (COR) was introduced on May 17, 2016 by Senator Thomas C. Ada and was subsequently referred on May 18, 2016 by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on June 08, 2016 at 9:00 am in *I Liheslaturan's* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 320-33 (COR).

### Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media outlets and published in the Guam Daily Post on May 31, 2016 (5-Day Notice) and again on June 06, 2016 (48-Hour Notice).

### **Senators Present**

Senator Thomas C. Ada

Committee Chairperson

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:00am.

### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada gives an orientation of the Lot 480, *Santa Ana, Agat* and explains that Chamorro Land Trust leases have been issued in the area. He goes on to say that the area has water but there is no infrastructure for power. He stated the area being addressed in the bill, is in a pocket with surrounding areas having power. Chairperson Ada said Guam Power Authority has estimated that it would cost \$30,000 to bring in the power lines to service the area.

Chairperson Ada then called those who have signed up to provide testimony.

**Angela Tenorio,** *Resident of Santa Ana:* Stated that she is in support of Bill No. 320 and the house shown in the orientation of the lot was her and her mother's resident. She continued by saying she has been diagnosed with cancer and her mother just had open heart surgery. Therefore, a generator is needed for days when the weather is unbearable. They have tried all other avenues to get power into their location but have only hit dead ends. She then thanks Chairperson Ada and his staff for visiting the resident to see the situation. Her mother has paid the application fee at GPA and a work order has been issued but nothing can be done because there are no poles for the power.

**Julia Gumataotao**, *Resident of Santa Ana*: She started by saying she is in support of Bill 320. She has gone through all measures possible and was assessed by GPA that the cost for poles would be about \$20,000. The problem has been ongoing since Monty Mafnas was alive. She

then explains that she was thankful that the Chairperson had gone down to assess her situation. Ms. Gumataotao then says that CLTC leases should be aware if the property they are given has infrastructure.

**Michael Borja**, *Administrative Director*, *Chamorro Land Trust Commission*: Mr. Borja reads his testimony. (see attached)

Mr. Borja continued to say that GPA provides a service to people, from which they generate a revenue. These poles are not being put on private property but on rights-of-way easements, which is the intention of the easement. He went on to say that these types of money should come from infrastructure processing. There is a plight for Ms. Tenorio and Ms. Gumataotao and a compassion as well, however there are many others in the same situation with no means to address their situation. Mr. Borja mentioned that the CLTC has thought about allowing the revenue to generate to a higher number and from that get a loan to allow for these types of situations. This is most especially important for lands that are over the aquifer. He found it hard to believe that GPA could not erect 4 power poles to obtain more paying customers, that should be there role and function as a power provider.

Chairperson Ada: He stated that is where they differ. He made the reference of there being an elephant in the room and it comes to question as to how to eat the elephant. It could be eaten with one big bite or rather eaten one bite at a time. His preference would be one bite at a time. He goes on to say that the roads are paved, the water is there and in the case of Ms. Gumataotao, the home has been built with a power pedestal waiting for GPA. However, CLTC is the developer and should have been the one to bring in the power. He stated that the points brought up by the Director are valid points. The vision is there for the long term and the understanding that this will open Pandora's box, with only a little here and there. The fact still remains that about \$100,000 is sitting in that account. He went on to say the GPA has looked at this situation from all views and quoted the poles as cheaply as they could. Therefore, once those poles are in, the other CLTC leases could go in and move forward with development.

Chairperson Ada stated that when he went down to Ms. Gumataotao, he also saw several CLTC lease owners clearing property and slowing building with the hope that GPA will finally have made its way to their location. As far as opening Pandora's Box, Chairperson Ada stated that he should be the one to worry about that.

**Ted Nelson,** *Public Citizen:* He stated that he disagrees with Director Borja. He created an infrastructure for fund for Land for the Landless but is unsure about what happen to the money. He gave the recommendation that an audit be done on the Land for Landless subdivisions that were sold. The money is there to take care of situations like this, it is money that the commission can use to take care of situations like the current one in *Santa Ana*.

**Chairperson Ada:** He stated that he will use the Directors testimony to temper the movement of Bill No. 320.

There being no further testimony Chairperson Ada adjourns the Public Hearing for Bill No. 320-33 (COR).

### III. Findings and Recommendation

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement finds the following comments by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission:

- The Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund has received revenue in this calendar year primarily form Land for the Landless default account payments.
- Of the 391 Land for the Landless default accounts, only 39 responded to notices and paid their accounts in full and 41 others responded with an appeal request. The land lots of the remaining 311 default accounts will be transferred to the CLTC with no further revenue collection expected.
- There are currently no major land sale authorizations in the legislative docket where payments will be deposited into the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund.
- Majority of Chamorro Land Trust Lands lack any form of infrastructure and have not been surveyed into lots to be leased to waiting applicants.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement hereby reports out **Bill No. 320-33 (COR)**, with the recommendation to **TO do pass**.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the entire subdivision of Basic Lot 480, Santa Ana, Municipality of Agat, as shown in 3 the Department of Land Management Map Drawing No. 2213-11-14 recorded under 4 Document No. 880921(Exhibit A) and further outlined in Satellite Overlay Map 5 (Exhibit B), belongs to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC). Although the 6 7 Guam Power Authority (GPA) had previously installed power lines into the area, approximately 10% of the area remains to be serviced. Currently, there are fifty-three 8 (53) surveyed lots in the subdivision. There are lessees residing in the area without 9 GPA electricity; they generate electrical power by gasoline generators. Numerous 10 1 CLTC lessees in the area have come forward requesting for assistance in obtaining power and for their respective lots. The Santa Ana, Agat area seems to have high 12 13 resident potential with a minimal investment of system development charges. 1.4 Preliminary system development planning has already been done by GPA.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that there has been a total of approximately


- One Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$123,000) collected in FY2016
- 2 pursuant to Public Law 33-104 and Public Law 33-90. Public Law 33-104 authorized
- 3 the extension for payment of expired Land for the Landless contracts and the transfer
- 4 of Land for the Landless lots into the Chamorro Land Trust land inventory. Public Law
- 5 33-90 authorized the sales of bull cart trails and land remnants. All proceeds from both
- 6 public laws are to be deposited into the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and
- 7 Infrastructure Fund identified as Department of Administration Revenue Account
- 8 Number 3669-57001, CLT-Sale of Government Land.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to use part of these funds for the installation of power infrastructure in Basic Lot 480, Santa Ana, Municipality of Agat, to provide the basic necessities of life for the CLTC lessees within the subdivision.

### Section 2. Authorization to Expend.

- a. The Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) is hereby authorized to expend up to Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) from the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund identified as Department of Administration Revenue Account Number 3669-57001, CLT-Sale of Government Land, for the design and installation of power infrastructure in Basic Lot 480, Santa Ana, Municipality of Agat as shown in GPA Systems Overlay Map (Exhibit C). Upon completion of the design and installation of power infrastructure, unexpended amounts shall be returned to the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund and made available for subsequent appropriations.
- b. The CLTC shall coordinate with the Guam Power Authority (GPA) for the design and installation of power infrastructure within 30 days of this enactment.
- **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such

### Buenas Yan Hafa Adai!

The Chamorro Land Trust Commission and the Department of Land Management have reviewed Bill No. 320-33 and provides the following comments on the bill:

- a. The Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund has received revenue in this calendar year primarily from Land for the Landless default account payments.
- b. Of the 391 Land for the Landless default accounts, only 39 responded to our notices and paid their accounts in full and 41 others responded with an appeal request. The land lots of the remaining 311 default accounts will be transferred to the CLTC with no further revenue collection expected.
- c. There are currently no major land sale authorizations in the legislative docket where the payment will be deposited into the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund.
- d. The vast majority of Chamorro Land Trust Lands lack any form of infrastructure and have not been surveyed into lots to be leased to waiting applicants.

The Chamorro Land Trust Commission intention is to use the revenue deposited into the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund for the survey and land registration of the CLTC properties. Based on estimates from the Department of Land Management

Survey Division, the scope of work would be around one million dollars with contracted work to be performed over a three-year period. This fund was to supplement other CLTC revenue with the intention of having appropriation legislation introduced this summer.

By authorizing the expenditure of funds from the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund, it would reduce the fund by almost twenty-five percent. Furthermore, it would set a precedent of selectively assisting the infrastructure of single lessee despite the fact that a couple thousand others need the same assistance.

However, this bill highlights the plight that CLTC lessees face in having no infrastructure and the high costs involved in just obtaining water and electricity where it is not available. When CLTC eventually enters into the limited leasing of properties for commercial use and those payments are deposited into the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund, it is our hope that the fund could grow to a size where the funds could be used for a fully coordinated infrastructure plan for CLTC properties. Piecemeal expenditures of this fund will either prevent or significantly delay the execution of more cost efficient infrastructure development plans.

While we commend the need to assist a constituent in need, the long-term implications of this legislation could be detrimental to the intent of the fund. Accordingly, the Chamorro Land Trust Commission does not offer its support for Bill No. 320-33.

# BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 320-33 (COR)

The proposed legislation intends to authorize the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) to expend up to thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) from the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund (CLTSIF) for the purpose of providing electricity for CLTC lessees residing in the subdivision of Basic Lot 480, Santa Ana, in the municipality of Agat.

The CLTSIF was created by P.L. 33-90 and added to the Guam Code Annotated as §75124 of Chapter 75, Title 21. §75124(b) states that expenditures from the CLTSIF shall be made pursuant to a resolution by the CLTC and restricted to: 1) the subdivision, surveying, mapping and registration of tracts of residential and agricultural land in the CLTC property inventory; and 2) the construction of infrastructure, to include access roads, water, and power utilities, to service CLTC residential and agricultural tracts of land.

Per the Department of Land Management (DLM) revenue report as of April 2016, the CLTSIF has an aggregate balance of \$117,059.51. Per the AS400 financial system, the CLTSIF has an aggregate balance of \$137,627.40 as of May 25, 2016.

Based on the foregoing, funding is available to authorize the \$30,000 expenditure to provide electricity for CLTC lessees at the location identified.

## Senator Tom Ada Wants Power Infrastructure Installed in Chamorro Land Trust Properties.

Hagåtña, Guam: On Tuesday, May 17, 2016, Senator Tom Ada introduced Bill No. 320-33(COR), which appropriates \$30,000 from the recently established *Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund* for the installation of power infrastructure by GPA in the Santa Ana, Agat neighborhood. "*Although many years ago GPA had installed infrastructure for power utility services, 10% of the neighborhood remains without service,*" Sen. Ada said. An estimate from GPA revealed that for no more than \$30,000, services to the area can be completed. "The minimal investment will make available power utility services to fifty-three (53) Chamorro Land Trust recipients who have already received their properties," Sen. Tom Ada said.

The \$30,000 will come from the *Chamorro Land Trust Survey and*Infrastructure Fund (created by P.L. 33-90 and 33-104). There is currently
\$123,000 in the Fund. "This project is a classic 'low hanging fruit' that can benefit many families," Sen. Tom Ada said. "Instead of waiting to amass millions of dollars to address the infrastructure need in all the CLTC lands, let's use the funds available to begin addressing this challenge on an incremental basis to enable the CLTC recipients to begin enjoying a quality of life they deserve. Let's start with the "low hanging" fruits," he added.

Bill 320-33 requires the CLTC to begin coordination with GPA within 30-days of enactment.
