COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 333-33 (COR) was introduced on June 08, 2016 by Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. and Senator Thomas C. Ada and was subsequently referred on June 09, 2016 by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on July 19, 2016 at 5:00 pm in *I Liheslaturan's* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill No. 333-33 (COR).

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all Senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on July 13, 2016 (5-Day Notice) and again on July 15, 2016 (48-Hour Notice). Publication was conducted in the July 13, 2016 issue and July 15, 2016 issue of the Guam Daily Post, a newspaper of general circulation, fulfilling the 5-Day Notice and 48-Hour Notice of the Open Government Law requirement.

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 5:00pm.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada calls the Public Hearing to order and announces those who are in favor of Bill No. 333-33 (COR). Chairperson Ada then yields to Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. the primary sponsor of Bill No. 333-33, for an introduction of the bill.

Senator Aguon: He starts by saying over the past couple of years there has been requests from Veterans' to apply the verbiage "VETERAN" on the driver's license or identification card. Bill No. 333-33 will provide that application and require a report to the Governor's Office and the Speaker of the Guam Legislature, in terms of how many veterans are taking advantage of this benefit. He then reads the verbiage from the bill, "every applicant for a certificate of identification for the Department of Revenue and Taxation, who is a veteran

shall at the applicant's request, have the word "VETERAN" affix on a section of the certificate of identification. The requirements of this section shall also apply to the renewal of the same. He ends by saying that is what the bill tries to do and is hopeful that the information can be passed to the Veterans' Affairs Office to assist in the registration process of the veterans.

Chairperson Ada adjourns the Public Hearing for Bill No. 333-33 (COR).

III. Findings and Recommendation

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 3101.4. is hereby *added* to Chapter 3, Article 1, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

"§ 3101.4. Veterans Designation for Driver's Licenses, Identification Cards, and Renewals of Same. Every applicant for a Guam driver's license or a Guam identification card who is a veteran, pursuant to § 7120.2(b) of Chapter 7, Title 16, *shall*, at the applicant's request, have the word 'Veteran' affixed on a section of the Guam driver's license or the Guam identification card. The requirements of this section *shall* also apply to the renewal of the same. "

Section 2. §57100 of Chapter 57, Division 3, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

"Certificate of Identification: Requirement and Fee.

Any person may obtain a certificate of identification from the Department of Revenue and Taxation. The Director of Revenue and Taxation is authorized to issue such certificate of identification without charge in a form prescribed by him.

Every applicant for a certificate of identification from the Department of Revenue and Taxation, who is a veteran, pursuant to § 7120.2(b) of Chapter 7, Title 16, *shall* at the applicant's request, have the word 'Veteran' affixed on a section of the certificate of identification The requirements of this section shall also apply to the renewal of the same."

Section 3. Reporting Requirement. The Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation *shall*, on the fifteenth (15th) day after the close of every fiscal quarter, transmit to *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* and the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, a report identifying the total number of veterans who possess a Guam Drivers license or a certificate of identification from the Department. The report *shall* include the number of veterans in each village, and the total number of veterans by gender, age, and branch of service.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act *shall* be effective October 01, 18 2016.
