## COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesia Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Wednesday, October 5, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Bill No. 347-33 (COR) As Introduced- "AN ACT TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT § 51302 OF ARTICLE 3 OF CHAPTER 51 OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO ESTABLISH THE RECYCLING REVOLVING FUND AS A SEPARATE ACCOUNT NOT TO BE COMMINGLED WITH THE GENERAL FUND,"** by Senator Rory J. Respicio.

- Introduced on July 1, 2016;
- Referral forwarded to this committee for public consideration on July 5, 2016.

### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

1. Ms. Conchita Taitano, Guam Environmental Protection Agency (GEPA), provided oral testimony and did not state in sign-in sheet if she is in support or opposition of the bill.

Chairman Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing on Bill No. 347-33 (COR) to order at 9:00 A.M. and as the main sponsor of the bill, provided remarks.

Ms. Conchita Taitano from GEPA, stated that the GEPA Administrator was not able to make the meeting but will be submitting written testimony on the bill.

Chairman Respicio thanked Ms. Taitano for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Chairman Respicio then declared that Bill No. 347-33 (COR) was duly heard.

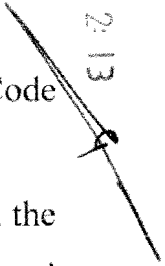

2 **Section 1.** § 51302 of Article 3 of Chapter 51 of Title 10, Guam Code

3 Annotated is *repealed* and *re-enacted* to read:

4 “§ 51302. **Recycling Revolving Fund.** There is hereby created the  
5 Recycling Revolving Fund (Fund), which shall be maintained separate and  
6 apart from any other funds, including the General Fund of the government of  
7 Guam, and independent records and accounts shall be maintained thereof.  
8 The Recycling Revolving Fund shall not be commingled with the General  
9 Fund and shall be kept in a separate bank account. All revenue generated  
10 from recycling fees collected pursuant to this Article, including interest  
11 earned, shall be deposited into the Recycling Revolving Fund and shall be  
12 expended exclusively for purposes authorized in Article 3 of Chapter 51 of


