I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesia Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Wednesday, October 5, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Bill No. 348-33 (COR)**- "AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 51303(C) TO ARTICLE 3 OF CHAPTER 51 OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO REPORT TO THE GUAM ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AUTHORITY THE CURRENT BALANCE AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE RECYCLING REVOLVING FUND AND TO FURTHER REQUIRE THIS INFORMATION TO BE POSTED ON THE GUAM ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AUTHORITY WEBSITE," by Senator Rory J. II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

1. Ms. Conchita Taitano, Guam Environmental Protection Agency (GEPA), provided oral testimony and did not state in sign-in sheet if she is in support or opposition of the bill.

Chairman Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing on Bill No. 348-33 (COR) to order at 9:00 A.M. and as the main sponsor of the bill, provided remarks.

Ms. Conchita Taitano from GEPA, stated that the GEPA Administrator was not able to make the meeting but will be submitting written testimony on the bill.

Chairman Respicio thanked Ms. Taitano for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Chairman Respicio then declared that Bill No. 348-33 (COR) was duly heard.
