COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. <u>350-33</u> (COR) was introduced on July 11, 2016, by Senator Rory J. Respicio, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary on July 11, 2016.

The Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary convened a public hearing on Bill No. <u>350-33</u> (COR) on Monday, October 10, 2016 at 3:00PM in I *Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Monday, October 3, 2016 (5-Day Notice), and again on Thursday, October 6, 2016 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 3:00 PM.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Aguon:

Circulated to our stake holders to our media partners on the third of October, Monday. The second notification went out to our stake holders and to the community on the sixth of October. I would like to, as chair, thank our media partners for circulating and disseminating our situation and insuring that the public is aware of the public hearing of these two pieces of legislation. As we proceed with Bill No. 350-33 (COR) and before I recognize the primary sponsor of that piece of legislation I would like to thank Vice-Speaker Cruz, thank you Mr. Vice Speaker for joining us this afternoon and also Senator Tony Ada and the Majority Leader Senator Rory Respicio, thank you very much senators for joining us this afternoon. First item Bill No. 350-33 (COR) Senator Respicio? As a primary sponsor would you like to state comments?

Senator Rory J. Respicio:

Yes thank you very much Mr. Chairman for hearing this bill, I do have a written sponsor statement which I would submit to your committee for your consideration. I just want to give a quick overview that this bill builds upon the ongoing work between the department of labor and the department of corrections to get inmates who are eligible for the work release program, to get them trained, get them very important and necessary skill sets. When they are in this work release program, the current law provides that the directive corrections set the hourly salary. But what we want to do here is that we want to make their salary set and pursue into the prevailing wage. What this would mean is that if someone is certified to be a carpenter for example, and the hourly wage for that salary is twenty one dollars and hour, then that is what the that inmate will receive. This is part of building all the necessary infrastructure for this individual, so that when they are released into this community they have the where with all to survive within the community, but in the meantime while they're in this work release program, a portion of their salary goes to restitution for the victims, and then a portion goes to the government for any fees, and then a portion goes the inmate and their family. I don't see any downfall to this Bill and I want to recognize Colonel Charfauros who is going to testify for his work in this area while he was at DOC, but I also want to say that this bill is a critical component to what is already happening to get those inmates trained. Thank you Mr. Chair, I do have this written sponsor statement I'll submit to you.

Senator Aguon:

Thank you very much Majority Leader Senator Respicio. Colonel Charfauros congratulations on your recent appointment and you may proceed with your testimony.

Colonel Charfauros:

Thank you sir, I am Colonel Mark C. Charfauros with the Guam police Department, I am here not representing the department, but at one time I was detailed to department of corrections and I was there for three years, and one of the projects I have worked on was the prison industries program. Before I begin I feel kind of awkward because the director isn't here, but I just got off the phone with him he has an injury which has prevented him from coming here, but he will be submitting testimony in favor of this bill. The only thing I can say is that this bill is a right bill. The biggest controversy about prison industry programs in the United States is the wages that is paid the prisoners. That averages anywhere from ninety cents to a dollar, ten cents an hour, which for many ACLU and other organizations has seen this as a form of slave labor, and private sector companies have seen this an unfair competition simply because they are competing with labor within the prison that is below the prevailing wages. My understanding what this bill does is that the prisoners at the department of corrections would be paid local prevailing wages, I'm assuming, not federal, because I believe there is a difference. So I believe it is local prevailing wages, and it make sense, if you're going to have prisoners work, let's just take everything away and say it's okay. You're going to have them work for ninety cents an hour, at ninety cents an hour according to our program, twenty five percent goes to the victims for victim compensation, and twenty five percent goes to the court for court fees or court fines. Twenty five percent goes back to the department of correction in a revolving fund and twenty five percent the prisoner can keep for spouse support or child support. At twenty five percent for ninety cents an hour is really an insult to victims that have been a victim of crime, whereas if you have prevailing wages then they're able to provide this. The other thing that I must point out is that at the department of correction there really is no rehabilitating program, at all. So we are dealing with over population, what we are looking at is a system where the inmates can get a trade so that when they are released from prison they become a contributing member to society. There have been work already done, in working with the trade's academy, and we are anticipating a shortage of local labor for the military buildup. Having this hearing today, and so that is my testimony Mr. Chairman I am in favor of this bill. This is a very good bill which is part of a complicated puzzle that as we move forward this legislation supports the overall goal of the department of corrections in establishing the a rehabilitative program, I believe the recidivism rate at the department of correction is over sixty percent, and that I believe is a result of not providing a rehabilitative program where that inmates once released can contribute to the tax base and support themselves and their family. I commend the sponsors of this legislation, I commend the chairman and member of the legislature for having this hearing today, and so that is my testimony Mr. Chairman, I am in favor of this bill.

Senator Aguon:

Thank you very much Colonel Charfauros for your testimony this afternoon. Senator Respicio, any questions or comments?

Senator Respicio:

Thank you, and thank you Colonel Charfauros, I just want to also stress Mr. Chair and colleagues by this bill were not going to take away any job, other than the job that is being imported by US and H2 worker. So it is not a US job that we are taking way, it is replacing a H2 worker job, and that is one of the things that we talked about early on to let the public know that these are inmates that are going to be released into the community anyways.

Colonel Charfauros:

You're right Senator because if you look at the department of labor they will tell you that we have a serious shortage of skill laborers in the construction phase, and right now the graduates of the local side is not meeting the demand and the only thing that this does is that it adds on to the work force is that it reduces the amount of H2 workers that we're going to have to import from Asia.

Senator Respicio:

And the ones that will be paying this prevailing wage are the construction companies that would avail for these public services and so.

Colonel Charfauros:

Yes that's how it would be done. The program that DOC is planning and designing is not to compete with the private sector but to argument the private sector. To provide a source for the private sector as opposed to competing with the private sector, that's what basically is what this program is designed to do.

Senator Respicio:

And then right now the Guam Trades Academy is inside the Department of Corrections training these inmates?

Colonel Charfauros:

Yes they're starting to do that, they're starting to work in that direction Senator, like I said there are many programs where this fits in and this particular bill fits right into the whole scheme of the prison industry program.

Senator Respicio:

I know that Director Lamorena had a couple of amendments so I will be submitting that to the Chair, he did have a knee injury he said, so he can't make it. But thank you Mr. Chair for hearing this Bill.

Senator Aguon:

Thank you very much Senator Respicio, and Colonel, and Senator Charfauros thank you very much for joining us this afternoon and providing your testimony on Bill three fifty. Lamorena V, Director for the Department of Corrections. I am appearing before you today to testify in favor of the intent of Bill 350-33(COR) "An act to amend (c) of § 90.90, article 4, chapter 90, title 9 of the Guam Code Annotated relative to inmate compensation for prison industries"

I applaud the author Senator Rory Respicio for having the foresight to introduce this needed legislation. Bill 350-33(COR) will provide equity to not only the participants of the program but to the private sector as well. By requiring that the participants be compensated the local prevailing wage ensures that they are properly paid for the work performed. The legislation will also not give us an unfair advantage when competing with the private sector for jobs. We want to be able to compete based on the quality of work provided.

I would also like to recommend that an amendment to the legislation be included to allow the Department of Corrections the choice to establish a not for profit organization to manage and operate the prison industry. By establishing a not for profit organization we will be able to apply for grants, receive contributions and most importantly ensure the continuity of the industry regardless of the Director. By having a board of directors with fiduciary responsibilities only strengthens the organization for growth into the future.

The establishment of the prison industry will serve as a conduit to provide the necessary training and experience by giving our clients another chance. It encourages those who are incarcerated a light at the end of the tunnel by providing them the tools to succeed in life. I encourage the Legislature to pass Bill 350-33(COR) and to add the recommended amendments.

Sponsor Statement on Bill No. 350-33 (COR) - "AN ACT TO AMEND (C) OF § 90.90, ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 90, TITLE 9 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO INMATE COMPENSATION FOR PRISON INDUSTRIES," by Senator Rory J. Respicio.

Bill No. 350-33 would set wages paid to Guam Department of Corrections inmates for prison labor to the federal prevailing wage for such labor. Bill No. 350-33 is intended to provide fairness in the wage practices, aiding in restorative justice for victims of crime and in meeting inmate obligations such as spouse and child support payment.

The bill is an important aspect of the on-going partnership between the Guam Department of Labor (DOL) and the Department of Corrections (DOC), in that DOL will utilize its workforce development funds to make the certification and eventual employment of DOC-eligible inmates possible. Such inmates with relevant skill-sets are known for excellent work that presently requires importation of foreign workers.

I thank the Committee for hearing this measure and I seek your approval of this legislation.






