I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 373-33 (COR) was introduced on July 11, 2016, by Senator Rory J. Respicio, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary on July 11, 2016.

The Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary convened a public hearing on Bill No. 373-33 (COR) on Monday, October 10, 2016 at 3:00PM in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Aguon:

We will proceed ladies and gentlemen to the next item on the agenda which is bill number 373-33 relative the definition and inclusion of strangulation in Guam's assault and family violence statues sponsored by Vice Speaker B.J. F. Cruz, I want to recognize Senator Mary Camacho, thank you very much for, Torres, for joining us this afternoon, and Vice Speaker Cruz?

Vice Speaker Cruz:

Thank you very much Mr. Chairman and thank you very much for expediting the hearing on this bill, as you may know October is domestic violence awareness month and unfortunately we really don't need much awareness because this morning in palm springs two police officers

responding to a domestic violence call were gunned down and died and so though people may think that this is not a problem or that there it's a simple crime, it is not. It is probably, you have talked to most police officers, it is probably the most dangerous crime they have to respond to, and so that it's imperative that we do all that we can to assist in one making the awareness and two trying to clarify some of our statutes. In an effort to try to address the domestic violence the Chief Justice Torres had a pacific judicial conference two weeks ago, three weeks ago, and I was very fortunate to have been invited, I also needed to attend, update my continuing legal education credits and so I was able to attend. They had two excellent presenters, and while they're presenting, it was real interesting because I did not realize the semantic difference between choking and strangulation. Choking is internal, you choke on a piece of meat when you swallow it the wrong way, and you choke on a marble if you swallow it. But you don't strangle, strangle is exterior, and he was saying that was the problem throughout most of the states, throughout the country and that slowly a number of us have been catching up and realizing that one day a real bright young attorney is going to say there is a difference, I didn't choke my wife or my husband, I strangled that person and the indictment will be incorrectly worded, and so he suggested that one thing we might do is to amend the statute locally, to have a separate crime recognizing that strangulation is a form of domestic violence and the other statistic this presenter gave which I thought was most alarming was the fact that I dint realize how sensitive ones neck area is, and also the fact that a domestic violence victim who has suffered an attempted strangulation is a victim who hasn't eighth hundred, eighth hundred percent chance, greater chance of being killed in a domestic violence offense. Because not that I am trying to down play it, when you punch or hit somebody it is just that. But when you cut off their breathing and attempt to break their neck or something in a strangulation it's, that person really means harm. We've seen that recently in some of the fights that have resulted in deaths, you just though he was holding him and the next thing we knew there was someone expired from the strangulation, and so Bill 373 is simply that, to provide strangulation as a recognized domestic violence act and a separate assault with a penalty of a third degree felony, should it have been committed. So again thank you and I'm surprised no one came to testify everybody was excited at the conference and there was almost two hundred of them and there's nobody here, but oh well. Maybe they'll submit written testimonies I'll get on the phone and get everybody.

Senator Aguon:

Thank you very much Mr. Vice Speaker, and similarly to the previous legislation Bill No. 373-33 we'll continue to receive written testimony for the subsequent ten days from this public hearing date.

The Public Hearing was adjourned at 3:18 PM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Subsection §19.80 is *added* to Chapter 19, Title 9, Guam
3 Code Annotated, to read:

4 **“§ 19.80. Strangulation: Defined & Punished.**

5 (a) A person is guilty of strangulation if he knowingly or intentionally,
6 against the will of another, impedes the normal breathing or circulation of the
7 blood of another by applying pressure to the throat or neck or by blocking the nose
8 or mouth of another.

9 (b) Strangulation is a felony of the third degree; provided that any person
10 convicted of strangulation shall not be eligible for work release or educational
11 programs outside the confines of prison.”

12 Section 2. A new Subection (a)(3) is *added* to § 30.10 of Chapter 30, Title 9,
13 Guam Code Annotated to read:

14 **“§ 30.10. Definitions.**

15 As used in this Chapter:

1 (a) Family violence means the occurrence of one (1) or more of the
2 following acts by a family or household member, but does not include acts of self-
3 defense or defense of others:

4 (1) Attempting to cause or causing bodily injury to another family or
5 household member;

6 (2) Placing a family or household member in fear of bodily injury;

7 (3) Knowingly or intentionally, against the will of another, impeding
8 the normal breathing or circulation of the blood of a family or household
9 member by applying pressure to the throat or neck or by blocking the nose
10 or mouth of a family or household member.

11 (b) Family or household members include:

12 (1) Adults or minors who are current or former spouses;

13 (2) Adults or minors who live together or who have lived together;

14 (3) Adults or minors who are dating or who have dated;

15 (4) Adults or minors who are engaged in or who have engaged in a
16 sexual relationship;

17 (5) Adults or minors who are related by blood or adoption to the
18 fourth degree of affinity;

19 (6) Adults or minors who are related or formerly related by marriage;

20 (7) Persons who have a child in common; and

21 (8) Minor children of a person in a relationship described in
22 paragraphs (1) through (7) above.

23 (c) Bodily injury as used in this Chapter, has the same meaning as
24 that provided in subsection (b) of § 16.10 of this title;

25 (d) Attempt as used in this Chapter, has the same meaning as that
26 provided in § 13.10 of this title;

27 (e) Peace officer means any person so defined in 8 GCA § 5.55;

1 (f) Victim means any natural person against whom a crime, as defined
2 under the laws of Guam, has been committed or attempted to be committed;

3 (g) Witness means any natural person,

4 (1) having knowledge of the existence or nonexistence of facts
5 relating to any crime, or

6 (2) whose declaration under oath is received or has been received as
7 evidence for any purpose, or

8 (3) who has reported any crime to any peace officer, or

9 (4) who has been served with a subpoena issued under the authority of
10 any court in Guam, or

11 (5) who would be believed by any reasonable person to be an
12 individual described in subparagraphs (1) through (4), above, inclusive;

13 (h) Prosecuting attorney as used in this Chapter means the Attorney
14 General of Guam and those persons employed by the Attorney General's
15 office specifically designated by the Attorney General.”

16 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

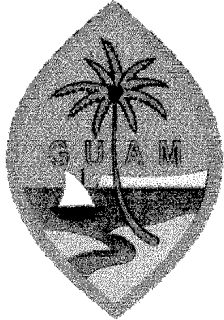

Comments

Per the Office of the Attorney General (OAG), the fiscal impact will be minimal as they handle these types of cases. The legislation would include a new chargeable offense under the family violence statute. The fiscal impact may be basically with the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission Fund since the victims of this new chargeable offense would be qualified to apply for compensation. Also, the Attorney General has noted there may be a fiscal impact with the Restitution Court with OAG's attorneys if an issue of restitution is involved.

Cruz bill to recognize strangulation as standalone crime

HAGÁTÑA, Guam—Recognizing that victims of domestic violence who experience strangulation as part of their abuse are 800 percent more likely to die at the hands of their attacker, vice speaker Benjamin J.F. Cruz has introduced Bill No. 373-33 (COR) to make strangulation a third degree felony under Guam law.

The vice speaker, who is presently attending the 2016 Domestic Violence Conference hosted by the Pacific Judicial Council, recently participated in a discussion led by the vice president of the National Institute of Crime Prevention, Rodney Reder. During Reder's presentation, Cruz learned that non-fatal strangulation, though a strong indicator of increased homicide, is often ignored in domestic violence cases.


"I was shocked to learn that, in spite of the staggering statistics, there is currently no specific statutory provision on strangulation under Guam law," said Cruz, who introduced the measure this morning. "If our laws don't recognize strangulation as a separate criminal offense, how can we expect our police officers and first responders to?"

Under local law, choking—the internal obstruction of the airway—is considered physical abuse. However, Cruz notes that, while strangulation and choking are similar, they are not statutorily the same. As a result, Cruz's measure adds language to specifically define strangulation as "knowingly or intentionally impeding the normal breathing or circulation of the blood by applying pressure to the throat or neck or by blocking the nose or mouth."

Under Bill No. 373-33 (COR), any person who commits strangulation may face up to five years' imprisonment.

Moreover, Cruz's measure updates Guam's family violence statutes by adding strangulation as an act of violence against family or household members, ensuring that the form of domestic violence is given the serious treatment its statistics demand.

According to the National Family Justice Center Alliance, nearly 40 percent of victims report loss of consciousness within seconds of strangulation. Though visible evidence of injury is not common, strangulation often leaves devastating consequences, such as internal bleeding, artery damage, amnesia, loss of memory, and the risk of blood clots in the brain.

"Thirty-eight states across the country have recognized that 20th century laws must be updated to address 21st century evidence. That is what this bill does," said Cruz. "If you are a victim of domestic violence, if your partner or spouse has strangled you in the past, please reach out for help. Your life is in danger, and I introduced Bill No. 373 to recognize that fact."

Absent the passage of Bill No. 373-33 (COR), acts of strangulation will continue be treated as a violation of Guam's family violence and assault laws, carrying no additional penalty or consequence.
