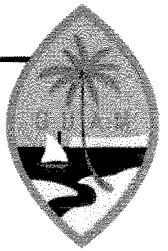

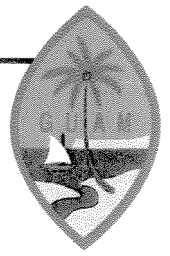

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 378-33 (COR) was introduced on July 11, 2016, by Senator Rory J. Respicio, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary on July 11, 2016.

The Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Public Safety and Judiciary convened a public hearing on Bill No. 378-33 (COR) on Monday, October 10, 2016 at 3:00PM in I *Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room.

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 3:00 PM.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Aguon:

We will now proceed to Bill No. 378-33 which is relative to the definition and inclusion of interfering with the reporting of family violence in Guam's assault and family violence statute sponsored by Vice Speaker B.J. Cruz. Vice Speaker at this point we do not have anyone signed in, but if you would like to comment on your proposal please?

Vice Speaker Cruz:

Yes again, thank you very much, this bill again is not something that I dreamt up on my own, I have to give due credit to where credit is due. At that saying domestic violence conference that I attended. The speaker talked about the fact that there is a growing trend throughout the country to have a

separate crime for interfering with the reporting. It can happen in various ways, in the old days when I was handling family court it was threatening the person to not report. In the old days it was pulling the telephone out of her hand and pulling the landline out of the wall and throwing it across the room, now you read some of the magistrate reports you'll see many instances where the magistrate reports state that the perpetrator grabbed the cellphone out of the victims hand, threw it across the room or took it and smashed it on the ground. What bill three seven eight (378) intends on doing is making it a separate defense besides committing the offense of family violence if you do something to intentionally knowingly, or recklessly attempt or prevent to attempt the victim or witness to a family violence from calling nine-one-one emergency communication or getting medical assistance that this is also a separate crime because it is happening, I'm embarrassed to admit that during the ten years I've handled family violence I didn't think about that as a separate offense until these presenters said you know that, that is a completely different thing. Unfortunately we all hear too often of people grabbing cell phones out of another person's hand and smashing it, and so this is intended to make sure that that is a separate offense, again punishable by a third degree felony in addition to the violent act and assault that was committed on the victim. Thank you again Mr. Chairman for conducting this hearing.

Chairman Aguon:

Thank you very much Mr. Vice Speaker, Senators? Any questions for the primary sponsor? If not, once again Bill 378-33 has received the public hearing and the committee will continue to receive written testimony for the ten subsequent days from this particular date, and a committee will recess until four pm (4:00pm) where by it will conduct the appointment or the confirmation hearing, on the appointment of Ms. Elyze McDonald Iriarte attorney at law as a superior court of Guam judge at four pm (4:00pm) this afternoon. This confirmation hearing will be continued at four pm. Thank you Senators.

The Public Hearing Adjourned at 3:18 PM.

2 Section 1. A new Subsection § 30.300 is added to Chapter 30, Title 9, Guam

5 (a) Any person commits the crime of interfering with the reporting of family

Comments

The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) provided its comments on Bill 378-33. The OAG noted the bill will create a new criminal offense under the Family Violence law. The proposed bill may affect OAG's Prosecution & Juvenile Divisions and may also affect its Victim Service Center. The fiscal impact will be minimal as they already handle these types of cases. The fiscal impact may be with the Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund (CICF) if victims or witnesses are injured by the defendant and claim compensation from the CICF via the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission. Public Law 20-55 created the CICF. The source of funds for the CICF are from prosecuted criminals (offenders) and Government Appropriations. However, based on feedback from the OAG, the impact may be minimal at best.

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

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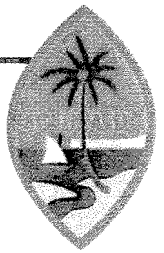

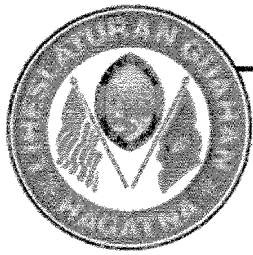
