III. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION.

Public Hearing was called to order at 11:34 AM; (Heard after Bill 410-33 (COR)).

Senator Dennis G Rodriguez, Jr.: I will now move on to Bill 407-33 which was introduced by Speaker Won Pat. Mr. Pinaula you can please come up to the table. This bill is An act to amend § 86107 (a) of chapter 86 title 10 Guam code annotated; relative to the membership of the council on mental health and substance abuse.

Mr. Benny Pinaula: Good morning Mr. Chairman, Senator Mary Torres and Vice Speaker B.J. Cruz Guam Behavioral Health supports this bill we would like to see this amendment go through and amend the current law as is.

Senator Dennis G Rodriguez, Jr.: Ok thank you. Any questions?

Senator Mary C. Torres: What would be the direct advantage of having one (1) member who is a parent of a child who is a client of Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness?

Mr. Benny Pinaula: What Ted does is the individual serving on the council has direct experience and has background so they understand especially because of their intermit knowledge and experience in the case of their own child that they will be able to provide sound advice as an advisory role because of that experience.

Senator Mary C. Torres: In the composition of the members presently I don't have the law in front of me but would that then take away a specific type of member or class of member.

Mr. Benny Pinaula: No it doesn't it. Adds to.

Senator Mary C. Torres: It doesn't.

Mr. Benny Pinaula: so we are trying to add the background of the person who has direct experience with mental health for substance abuse.

Senator Mary C. Torres: I am just trying to understand in the realm of people who have good judgment or professional knowledge or competency in the area why they wouldn't be sufficient because you would also argue that while some may understand it's hard to judge the value of that person just because of an associating and that what I am going at a lot of times when we look at the composition board members there is something about their background experience training that truly adds value to the thought process in making with the body and I get were your coming from but I am just trying to reconcile with the normal composition why you would differ to one rather than the other that is in that mix already

Benny Pinaula: I understand and that is a great question Senator and I know that looking at its phase value one must as the question is this only applicable to Guam actually this is a trend coming out from SANSA and Health and Behavioral services so you are seeing these types of boards and councils popping up the United States as well in different areas so they are adding the single individual on to the council and for some of the areas they are seeing some good improvements because they are hearing direct affects and causes from those that are experiencing these type of Mental Health issues.

Senator Mary Camacho Torres: And I appreciate that you alerted me that it is in fact a trend it is something that I can look into further so thank you for that.

Mr. Benny Pinaula: Absolutely.

Senator Dennis G Rodriguez, Jr.: Thank you very much Vice Speaker anything on that Mr. Pinaula thank you very much we will conclude this public hearing on Bill 407-33.

AN ACT TO AMEND § 86107 (a) OF CHAPTER 86 TITLE 10 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COUNCIL ON MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 86107 (a) of Chapter 10, Title 10 Guam Code Annotated hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) There is within the Department an Advisory Council for Mental Health, Alcohol and Drug programs and services known as the Advisory Council. The Council shall consist of seven (7) members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Legislature. The members of the Council shall serve for three (3) years.; provided that of the members first appointed, two (2) shall serve for one (1) year, two (2) shall serve for two (2) years and three (3) shall serve for three (3) years. At least one (1) member shall be a parent whose child is a client of the Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center."
