I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 49-33 (COR) was introduced by Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. on March 3, 2015, and subsequently referred to the **Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication** on March 4, 2015.

The **Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication** convened a public hearing on **Monday**, **March 23**, **2015**, beginning at 4:00PM and reconvening at 5:30PM in the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. The hearing for **Bill No. 49-33 (COR)** began at **5:30PM** and ended at **5:41PM**.

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on March 16, 2015, and March 21, 2015, via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Benjamin J.F. Cruz announced Bill No. 49-33 (COR), and allowed the sponsor of the bill to make a statement.

Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. thanked Chairman Cruz for hearing Bill No. 49-33 (COR) and continued with his sponsor statement:

"[Bill No. 49-33 (COR) is] pretty straight forward: it would allocate the balance of funds previously appropriated to the Guam Police Department (GPD) specifically for vehicles and for radios for the vehicles, and there is a balance slightly under Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) that [GPD is] requesting that [it] be utilized specifically for handheld radios. So this legislation would appropriate that remaining balance specifically for that purpose. Thank you, Mr. Chairman."

Chairman Cruz thanked Senator Aguon and recognized individuals who are present to testify: Capt. Fred A. Bordallo, Jr., Chief of Police, Guam Police Department; Mr. Joshua F. Tenorio, Administrator of the Courts, Judiciary of Guam; and Maj. Fred M. Chargualaf, Bureau Chief, Guam Police Department.

Capt. Fred A. Bordallo, Jr. greeted Chairman Cruz and the rest of the Committee, and thanked them for the opportunity to testify <u>in support</u> of Bill No. 49-33 (COR) in the capacity as GPD Chief of Police. He stated that the sum requested would be used to purchase two (2) Motorola APXTM 6000 portable radios, plus accompanying accessories such as spare batteries, battery chargers, speakers, microphones, earpieces. He added that he spoke with Guam Homeland Security/Office of Civil Defense (GHS/OCD) Interoperable Communications Coordinator Mr. Bradley A. Hokanson about the specific model and quoted each radio to cost "about \$4,965.33 apiece."

Chairman Cruz thanked Chief Bordallo and asked Major Chargualaf for his testimony.

Maj. Fred M. Chargualaf greeted Chairman Cruz and the Committee, and introduced himself as the Bureau Chief for GPD and "the overseer of the finances as well as the vehicle fleet." He gave testimony <u>in support</u> of Bill No. 49-33 (COR), attesting to the importance of radio communication in the line of duty. He continued:

"Other than our firearms that we issue to our personnel, the radio communications in the vehicle as well as the handheld – it's probably one of the most vital pieces of equipment in terms of executing our mandate, which is to save lives. That radio can make a difference between the safety of the officer, but more importantly saving a life and protecting the citizens of our island."

Mr. Joshua F. Tenorio greeted Chairman Cruz and introduced himself as the Administrator of the Courts of the Judiciary of Guam. To preface his testimony <u>in</u> <u>support</u> of Bill No. 49-33 (COR), he stated he is testifying for this legislation – despite its

material irrelevance to the Judiciary—because of the close partnership between the Courts and GPD and the opportunity to bring to the Committee's attention an impending procurement issue due to Motorola's analog-to-digital shift in radio communication. Mr. Tenorio explained that since Motorola is phasing out outdated equipment supporting the current system infrastructure in favor of digital standards and will no longer provide product support next year, first responders will have to replace their old radios with more compliant models. He also mentioned that an executive branch coordinating committee (Interoperable Communications Working Group, established by Executive Order 2012-12) is trying to identify federal funding for public safety communication system upgrades. He said that since the Court is not a first responder, it will likely to be one of the last to replace its radios, which, save for approximately five units, will all be unsupported next year. He added that the Court is looking for ways to obtain the costly radios, which are critical equipment for Marshals and probation officers out in the field who need to communicate with GPD, the Guam Fire Department (GFD) and the rest of the first responders.

Chairman Cruz asked the panel if there was a cost-benefit analysis conducted for these handheld portable radios in light of an incident wherein a police officer with a radio who was first at a scene had to borrow a cellular phone from a civilian to keep in contact with multiple locations. The Chairman inquired whether addressing old statute that prohibits the government from underwriting the cost of cellphones could mitigate this public safety dilemma.

Chief Bordallo responded that he is aware that "there's been in the past an experience in the government of Guam cellphone use" and he believes that local public safety agencies would be willing to explore communication alternatives to radio equipment. He added that he has been talking to Senator Thomas A. Morrison about technology, specifically, types of communication platforms. He stressed that encryption and the cost of ensuring encryption are some of the most important issues in communication among emergency responders. He said government-issued cellphones are used in other jurisdictions and he is of the opinion that this trend is something that can be explored by this administration's public safety team.

Mr. Tenorio responded that the Judiciary has vetted and is in support of the use of government-issued cellphones. He said that although the Court may even consider push-to-talk phones as an option within court premises, radios are still necessary for "these operations that require more than just two people communicating." He gave as an example a situation in March 2015 when an individual to be served a warrant for arrest committed suicide and required communication between the marshals and GPD, and between the first responders and GFD. He said that personally agrees that the Chairman's suggestion merit but "at a certain level of joint operations [radios] come in handy." He added tangentially that the Judiciary is working on reducing the number of radio units down to optimum quantities for field operations and joint exercises.

Chairman Cruz corrected Mr. Tenorio, stating that rather than making a suggestion, he was merely relaying a comment made by a business community member whose opinion he values greatly and whose insight he wanted to share. The Chairman said that he reasoned that incidences of abuse of government-issued cellphones have led to legislation prohibiting the government from underwriting cellphones; however, this individual was not satisfied with that rationale. The Chairman stated that he will now have a better answer to this particular inquiry since GPD and the Judiciary have stated that such alternative equipment and communication platform are being considered for certain situations.

On account that there were neither further questions from the Committee nor other individuals present to testify, **Chairman Cruz** considered Bill No. 49-33 (COR) as heard.
