Rodriguez, Jr.**

The public hearing on agenda item Bill No. 6-33(COR) was called to order at 9:10AM.

**II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION.**

**Chairman & Sponsor, Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr.**

For the record I’d just like to discuss briefly what Bill 6 does. What this is, is that there is a recent law that was passed that would require GEDA to provide the legislature a formula metrics measurable goals that would ensure that for industries specific, for those specific industries that we offer qualifying certificates, that there is measurable goals in a metrics of formula that they use and instead of them going through the Triple A process were allowing them to still stay within the timeframe that has been set in public law which is about 90 days but to provide the legislature these proposals so that from there this body can move forward. So there being no here to testify, Bill 6 has been heard by this body.

DEVELOPMENT OF PROPOSED INDUSTRY SPECIFIC

RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFYING CERTIFICATE  
PROGRAM.**

1       **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2       **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent:** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that the Guam Economic Development Authority should develop and directly  
4 submit to the Legislature industry specific policy, criteria and measurable goals  
5 ensuring the appropriate stimulation of legitimate investment of new economic  
6 development. Further, that the development of the proposed submission should not  
7 be seen as a rule making process to be conducted pursuant to Article 3 of Chapter  
8 9, 5 GCA.

9       *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the requested submission is necessary as a  
10 working tool in the refinement of the Qualifying Certificate program. It is,  
11 therefore, the *intent* of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to utilize the submission by the  
12 Committee on Economic Development as a framework to develop and refine  
13 through legislative processes the Qualifying Certificate program of the Guam  
14 Economic Development Authority.

1 It is further the intent to amend § 58146.1 to provide for the development  
2 and direct submission to the Legislature without going through the Administrative  
3 Adjudication Law.

4 **Section 2.** § 58146.1 of Chapter 58, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, is  
5 *amended*, to read:

6 **“§ 58146.1. Qualifying Certificate; Abeyance Thereof. Development of**  
7 **Industry Specific Policy, ~~Regulations~~, Criteria and Measurable Goals.**

8 (a) The Guam Economic Development Authority shall submit, by no later  
9 sixty (60) days from the date of enactment of this Act, proposed ~~and duly~~  
10 ~~promulgated~~, industry specific policy, criteria and measurable goals and which  
11 shall not include industry specific development projects already satisfactorily  
12 established on Guam, so as to ensure that the government not unnecessarily waive  
13 needed revenue for an industry specific project category that already exists or is  
14 satisfactorily established, to the Legislature ~~for approval, as provided pursuant to~~  
15 ~~Article 3 of Chapter 9, 5 GCA~~. In the event the mandated industry specific policy,  
16 ~~regulations~~, criteria and measurable goals are not submitted, timely, pursuant to  
17 this Subsection (a), then, the following shall become effective ninety (90) day from  
18 the date of enactment of this Act:

19 (1) Hotel Qualifying Certificate; Provisional Abeyance thereof.  
20 Except as provided pursuant to Article 2 of Chapter 58, 12, GCA, no  
21 renewal of Qualifying Certificates, for hotels shall be approved and issued  
22 until such time as the Guam Economic Development Authority has  
23 developed, ~~pursuant to Article 3 of Chapter 9, 5 GCA~~, industry specific  
24 policy, ~~regulations~~, criteria and measurable goals ensuring appropriate  
25 stimulation of legitimate investment of new economic development; and



1           (2) General Industry Specific; Provisional Abeyance thereof. No  
2 new Qualifying Certificates, or the renewal of Qualifying Certificates, shall  
3 be approved and issued until such time as the Guam Economic Development  
4 Authority has developed, ~~pursuant to Article 3 of Chapter 9, 5 GCA,~~  
5 industry specific policy, ~~regulations,~~ criteria and measurable goals ensuring  
6 the appropriate stimulation of legitimate investment of new economic  
7 development, and which shall not include industry specific development  
8 projects already satisfactorily established on Guam, so as to ensure that the  
9 government not unnecessarily waive needed revenue for an industry specific  
10 project category that already exists or is satisfactorily established.”

11           **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to  
12 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such  
13 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be  
14 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the  
15 provisions of this Act are severable.

16           **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall become immediately effective  
17 upon enactment.



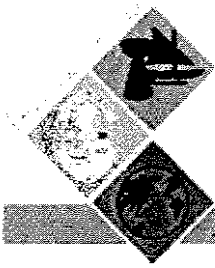

*Håfa Adai* Chairman Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr., and members of the *Committee on Health, Economic Development, Homeland Security, and Senior Citizens*. Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in favor of Bill 6-33 (COR).

Thank you, Senator Rodriguez for your support and commitment to working with GEDA to revamp the Qualifying Certificate (QC) program to ensure that it remains Guam's single most valuable tool to attract investment to the island. GEDA supports the intent of Bill 6 as it provides GEDA an opportunity to better work within the timeline mandated by Public Law 32-233.

I would like to assure the Legislature that GEDA is currently working towards drafting the "proposed industry specific, policy, criteria and measurable goals" for the QC program as mandated by law. This process is a policy guideline for future QC applications and not meant to change the existing rules and regulations that have already been substantiated and duly promulgated. In fact, it has always been GEDA's policy that any projects of this type be vetted with the utmost transparency and is substantiated with as much stakeholder input as possible.

GEDA fully supports amended language in Bill 6-33 as it will allow for a more transparent and useful document to be provided to the Legislature. We thank Senator Rodriguez and the Legislature for their assistance, and strongly support the passage of Bill 6.

Rodriguez, Jr. - An act to add a representative from the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority and the Department of Public Health and Social Services to the Government of Guam Group Health Insurance Negotiating Team, to delete the requirement for the solicitation of an exclusive group health insurance contract and require only the solicitation of three (3) non-exclusive contracts for a contract term of two (2) years, by amending §4302 (c) and §4302 (e) of Article 3, Chapter 4, 4 GCA.
- **Bill 17-33 (COR)**- Introduced by Sen. Tina Rose Muna-Barnes - An act to amend §§18102, 18103, 18105, 18105.1, 18106, 18108, 18112, 18113, 18114, 18121, 18125, 18126, 18128.4, 18128.5, 18128.7, 18128.8, 18129, 18131, and 18133 of Division 1 of Chapter 18 of Title 10 Guam Code Annotated, relative to the Barbering and Cosmetology Act of 2010.
