COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill 75-33 (COR) was introduced on April 13, 2015 by Senator Tina Rose Muña Barnes and was subsequently referred on April 13, 2015 to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on June 19, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on June 24, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 1:03 pm.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada turns the floor over to the sponsor of the Bill.

Senator Barnes: Explains that Bill 75-33 was requested as recognition for Firefighters. It allows them to promote their brotherhood/sisterhood. She adds that another purpose for it is to raise greater awareness to these people and make them more visible in the community. Clarifies that this is not free provision.

Chairperson Ada calls up those who have signed up to give testimony.

Kevin Reilly, *FFII. Guam Fire Department:* Further clarifies that they are not seeking special privileges or waivers. They are requesting special group license plates implemented by Department of Revenue and Tax. Reads testimony (*see attached testimony*)

Chief Joey San Nicolas, *Guam Fire Department*: Shares his support and tells them that he is more for identification and hopes that it will help gain the trust of the community.

Chairperson Ada: Suggests revising the bill and having a policy correction authorizing issuance of firefighter's license plates. After they discuss what Rev and Tax are capable of designing, the Guam Fire Department may come up with a set design.

Chairperson Ada adjourns the public hearing for Bill No. 75-33 (COR).

Written Testimony Regarding Bill No. 75-33 (COR)

June 26, 2015

Hafa Adai Senators,

During a trip stateside in 2012, I noticed that every state had a specialty license plate available for virtually any type of organization. Upon my return, I looked into the costs, requirements, and details associated with these specialty license plates.

I presented the idea for a Firefighter license plate to Fire Chief San Nicolas and he agreed it would be not only a morale booster, but also a revenue generating source for the Government of Guam and the Firefighters Organization (FOAM). Following the Application from the Utah State Tax Commission, the proposed fees would include a mandatory, annual donation from the holder to the FOAM.

After getting approval to move forward, several senators were approached with the proposal. While waiting for feedback, Fire Chief San Nicolas also mentioned the idea to Fire Chief Stanley Torres at Andersen Fire and Emergency Services. It was his suggestion that the license plate be developed for all firefighters working on Guam.

Although firefighters worldwide are part of one brotherhood, I believe the fire services on Guam should be allowed more time to choose a design and have the monies collected deposited into an account agreed upon. The intent original intent was to encourage other agencies, both local and federal, professionals, and organizations, to follow suit. It would open the door for the Rotarians, Girl Scouts, Guam Police, GAIN, etc. to develop a license plate that can be used to collect funds for their specific purpose.

Although I am in favor of this Bill and thankful for the work Senator Barnes has given towards this endeavor, I believe there are issues that need to discussed and agreed upon amongst the personnel of the GFD, ARFF, Navy, and Andersen prior to the final drafting of this measure.

According to information provided by the Department of Revenue and Taxation (DRT), customized license plates may cost anywhere between \$6,000 - \$10,000 for 1,000 plates, or an average of \$2,000. DRT is anable to absorb the additional cost related to customized plates in their current budget (FY15). Additional funding may be needed for subsequent flocal years to accommente additional orders of the customized license plates. The projected flocal impact for FY16 - FY19 assumes other law enforcement departments will follow suft with customized license plates.


