COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill 76-33 (COR) was introduced on April 14, 2015, by Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on April 14, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development convened a public hearing on April 23, 2015, in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill 76-33 (COR). The hearing convened hearing convened at 6:04 p.m. and was adjourned at 7:17 p.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas read the title of Bill No. 76-33 and proceeded to read a sponsor statement provided by Senator Dennis Rodriguez (*see attached*). The statement mentioned that the legislation was introduced at the request of the Department of Public Health and Social Services and would clarify the qualifications for the territorial epidemiologist position. It further stated that such action would make it easier for the Department to recruit individuals for the position. Chairman San Nicolas opened the floor for public testimony.

Suzanne Kaneshiro read a prepared statement in support of Bill No. 76-33 (*see attached*). She pointed out the disconnect between the Department of Administration's job description and the Guam Code Annotated's qualifications with regards to the territorial epidemiologist position. She spoke about the importance of the territorial epidemiologist position to the operations of the Department and outlined a few of the position's responsibilities. Dr. Kaneshiro stated her support for the proposed modifications to existing law contained in the bill.

Chairman San Nicolas opened the floor to his colleagues.

Senator Tom Ada asked if the proposed changes would disqualify future applicants who received medical degrees from foreign countries.

Dr. Kaneshiro answered that the changes would only allow graduates of medical schools approved by the American Medical Association to qualify.

Senator Ada pointed out that qualifications have been modified to now allow degree holders from international schools to qualify for certain positions in the field of engineering and asked if language in Bill No. 76-33 should be worded similarly.

Dr. Kaneshiro stated that she believes that current language should be modified to allow individuals who possess M.P.H. degrees in epidemiology to qualify for the territorial epidemiologist position because it needs to be filled.

Senator Ada stated that the bill's language needs to be further clarified and explain which organization would be responsible for determining which recognized schools would be acceptable and meet the qualifications.

Speaker Judi Won Pat asked Dr. Kaneshiro for clarification on her testimony with regards to the types of degrees allowable under the proposed modified language that would qualify an individual for the territorial epidemiologist position.

Dr. Kaneshiro stated that the proposed modifications would lower the criteria by allowing an individual who possesses a M.P.H. or equivalent degree to qualify for the position where as the current language requires a M.D. or D.V.M.

Speaker Won Pat spoke about a national shift away from epidemiology to genetics and asked how that might apply to Guam's situation.

Dr. Kaneshiro stated that geneticists would be more difficult to attract and acquire. She reiterated the need for an epidemiologist at the Department.

Speaker Won Pat stated that requiring a specific amount of experience or training in the field of epidemiology or biostatistics, as proposed in the bill, may potentially narrow the hiring pool even further.

Vice Speaker Benjamin Cruz stated that the proposed language would expand the pool of potential applicants. He echoed the concern of Senator Ada that potential applicants should not be disqualified simply because their degree is not from a school approved by the American Medical Association.

Dr. Kaneshiro stated that she was open to that suggestion.

Senator Ada suggested that the proposed bill include language that requires experience or training in epidemiology as part of the qualifications of the position to which Dr. Kaneshiro agreed.

Senator Mary Torres asked Dr. Kaneshiro to explain why the bill includes the deletion of the licensed veterinarian as part of the requirements.

Dr. Kaneshiro answered that she did not know why that change was made in the bill.

Senator Torres stated that jurisdictions in the nation commonly include D.V.M. as part of the qualifications for epidemiologist positions.

Chairman San Nicolas thanked Dr. Kaneshiro for her attendance and for answering the questions posed to her. He stated that he would have to confer with the author of the legislation to address the concerns brought up in the hearing. Chairman San Nicolas mentioned several of the concerns from his colleagues before declaring Bill No. 76-33 officially heard.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development hereby reports out Bill 76-33 (COR), with the recommendation

Thank you Mr. Chairman for the opportunity to provide this brief sponsor statement on Bill 76-33, an Act to amend § 3201.1(a) of Chapter 3, Division 1, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, to provide for the qualifications of the Epidemiologist of the Department of Public Health and Social Services.

At the request of the Department of Public Health & Social Services, I introduced this measure in order to provide for the qualifications of the Territorial Epidemiologist. It is the intent of this legislation to clarify the qualifications for this position and make it easier for the department to recruit physicians or a similarly qualified graduate from an American Medical Association approved medical school with a M.D. degree and certification by the American Board of Prevention Medicine, or graduation from a recognized school of public health with a M.P.H. degree (epidemiology major) from an accredited school with a graduate degree in epidemiology or biostatistics and 1-2 years of experience in the field of epidemiology to serve as the Territorial Epidemiologist.

The requisite qualifications would still continue to ensure the health and safety of the public.

I look forward to any additional testimony the public will present to strengthen this bill.

Thank you for moving this forward.

Testimony on Bill 76-33

My name is Suzanne Sison Kaneshiro and I am the Chief Public Health Officer at the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS). I am in support of Bill 76-33 which amends the qualifications of the Territorial Epidemiologist. There is disconnect between the Department of Administration's job description on what the qualifications of a Territorial Epidemiologist should be and Section 3201.1 (a) of Chapter 3, Division 1, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated (GCA). According to GCA, "the Guam Epidemiologist shall be a Guam-licensed physician or licensed veterinarian" while DOA states that the minimum experience and training of the Territorial Epidemiologist includes:

"graduation from an American Medical Association-approved medical school with a MD degree, graduation from a recognized School of Public Health with a MPH degree (epidemiology major) and certification by the American Board of Prevention Medicine; OR

graduation from an American Veterinary Medical Association-approved veterinary medical school with a DVM degree, graduation from a recognized school with a MPH degree (epidemiology major) and certification by the American Board of Veterinary Prevention Medicine; OR

any equivalent combination of training and experience beyond the master's degree, which provides the minimum knowledge, abilities and skills."

The latter allows the Territorial Epidemiologist to hold a MPH degree in Epidemiology and not be limited to a MD or DVM degree.

The management of the Guam Cancer Registry is not the only responsibility of the Territorial Epidemiologist. Public Law 24-198 which the section refers to, was created to reestablish the Guam Cancer Registry, under the supervision of the Guam Epidemiologist. The duties of the Territorial Epidemiologist as indicated in the DOA job specifications includes, but not limited to, coordinating and supervising epidemiologic investigations; following up laboratory reports of communicable diseases to verify disease outbreaks; conducting epidemiological studies of diseases or conditions; supervising the compilation and analysis of statistical data of communicable and other diseases; and reviewing, formulating and reviewing policies, regulations and laws necessary to protect the public from the spread of communicable diseases.

The position of the Territorial Epidemiologist is a critical one in DPHSS. The Territorial epidemiologist is the one who analyzes the health reports from the community and investigates the causes and effects of diseases and injuries and determines if there is a public health concern to the general population. In the U.S., most epidemiologist positions require a minimum of a master's degree. Depending on the college or university program, graduating epidemiology students earn a Master of Public Health or a Master of Science. A MD or Ph.D. degree is only recommended for epidemiologists involved in clinical research or holding university teaching positions.

The last time the Department of Public Health and Social Services had a full time epidemiologist was in 2004. Prior to his retirement, Dr. Robert Haddock had served as the Territorial Epidemiologist from 1972-2004. It has been very difficult to fill the position because of the low salary associated with the position and the MD/DVM degree requirement. The salary for the Territorial Epidemiologist ranges from \$70,873 - \$88,591. This salary is adequate for someone with a master's degree. In the U.S. the median salary is \$65,270. For someone who holds a MD or DVM degree, this salary is below standard. According to a recent US News article, the average veterinarian salary is \$96,140 and the average salary for a physician is \$188,440 (<http://money.usnews.com/careers/best-jobs/veterinarian/salary>).

Besides modifying the qualification to include a MPH degree with an emphasis in Epidemiology, I would also like to recommend the inclusion of the option of a Master's of Science degree in Epidemiology as an alternative in order to attract more epidemiologists to apply for the position.

Thank you for providing me the opportunity to testify.



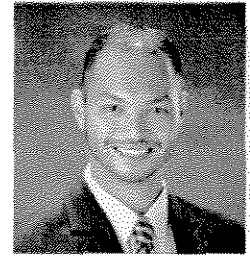
