COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill 90-33 (LS) was introduced on April 27, 2015 by Senator Tina Rose Muña Barnes and was subsequently referred on April 27, 2015 by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement.

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on May 12, 2015 at 1:30 pm in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on Bill 90-33 (LS).

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on May 5, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on May 7, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 1:30pm.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairman Ada: He starts by saying although the sponsor of the bill is not present, he will go ahead and conduct the public hearing for Bill 90-33. Chairperson Ada says that for the record, the provisions of the Bill 90-33 were previously approved unanimously by Legislative Resolution, in the April session by the Guam Legislature. He goes on to say, that on the advice the legislative counsel, Bill 90-33 was introduced in view of the fact that counsel believes land transactions need to be enacted by law as opposed to a Legislative Resolution.

Chairman Ada: this is more of a formality. The legislature has already made its position known regarding this land exchange for the foster home but a public hearing is required.

Chairman Ada: calls upon those who have signed up to give testimony.

Michael Borja, Director of DLM: reads his testimony (see attached)

Chairperson Ada: He states that the committee has every intention to complete the requirements for this public hearing, prepare the committee report to come out for the May session and affirmatively concur with the land exchange for the foster home.

Chairperson Ada: ends the public hearing for Bill No. 90-33 (LS).

Buenas Yan Hafa Adai!

The Department of Land Management appreciates and commends the actions of this Legislature in the passage of Resolution No. 21-33 which approved the lot identified in this bill for the land transfer between the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) and the Department of Public Health and Social Services for a foster care home.

Public Law 32-226 approved the transfer of land between the two agencies, however, it directed the CLTC to identify another lot other than the one originally identified. Three sites were presented to the CLTC commissioners during their February 19, 2015, monthly meeting and the lot selected was unanimously approved by all four commissioners and is identified in this bill. One commissioner asked me to provide additional feedback on the building footprint use on the land. At the March 19, 2015, monthly meeting, I provided a conceptual drawing of the identified lot to the commissioners which depicted the footprint of a residential building and a resource services building on the property. I also noted the need for parking and outdoor recreation. The commissioners had no objections or concerns with the conceptual layout and were satisfied with the updated information.

Testimony on Bill No. 90-33 May 7, 2015

The Chamorro Land Trust Commission, in originally approving a land transfer for lands reserved by Public Health for the use of a foster care home, agreed with the need to assure a facility for Guam's children is provided. The land selected and approved in Resolution No. 21-33 serves this purpose.

Since we believe the passage of Resolution No. 21-33 accomplished the requirements of Public Law 32-226, we yield to this committee on the disposition of this bill.


