COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 91-33 (LS) was introduced on April 29, 2015, by Senator Mary Torres. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on April 30, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on June 3, 2015, in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill No. 91-33 (LS). The hearing convened at 2:00 p.m. and was adjourned at 2:43 p.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas read the title of Bill No. 91-33 (LS) and yielded to the main author, Senator Mary Torres, for her opening statement.

Senator Mary Torres stated that the bill was introduced at the request of the Guam Chamber of Commerce. She explained that the bill will make it more convenient for businesses to renew their licenses because it allows for renewal on an annual basis after initial issuance.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that the Guam Chamber of Commerce has indicated that they will be submitting written testimony in support of the bill. Without any individuals present to testify, he adjourned the hearing on Bill No. 91-33 (LS).

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development hereby reports out Bill No. 91-33 (LS) with the recommendation

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the current system for issuing and renewing business license on Guam creates a major inconvenience to business owners and employees of the Department of Revenue and Taxation.

It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to to amend current law to allow the Department of Revenue and Taxation to renew these licenses on an annual basis.

Section 2. Chapter 70 of Title 11 Guam Code Annotated §70115 is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

“§70115. Term of License. All licenses and endorsements applicable thereto shall be issued on a ~~fiscal year basis (July 1 to June 30)~~ an annual basis and,

1 regardless of when issued, shall expire ~~on the thirtieth (30th) day of June of the~~
2 ~~year one (1) year after~~ for which issued or renewed.”

3 **Section 3.** Chapter 70 of Title 11 Guam Code Annotated §70116 is hereby
4 *amended* to read as follows:

5 “**§ 70116. Apportionment of Fees.** All original license fees shall be prorated
6 ~~and one-fourth (3) of the annual fee charged for each quarter or portion of a quarter~~
7 ~~remaining in the fiscal year from the date of issuance;~~ charged on an annual basis,
8 commencing at the date of issuance or renewal and ending the day before the
9 following year. The existing fee structure for business license shall remain intact and
10 in effect.”

11 **Section 4.** Chapter 70 of Title 11 Guam Code Annotated §70117 is hereby
12 *amended* to read as follows:

13 “**§70117. Renewal.** A licensee may renew his license at the expiration thereof
14 by the payment of the annual license fee and by filing with the renewal application
15 an affidavit oath and subject to the penalties of perjury that he has continued to
16 comply with all of the prerequisites and qualifications provided by law, rules and
17 regulations which were certified by the proper departments of the government of
18 Guam in the application for his original license. The renewing licensee shall not be
19 required to obtain the approval of the Government of Guam or any department or
20 agency thereof regarding the application of the Zoning Law of the Territory of Guam
21 to the licensee’s business premises provided that the licensed business is located
22 upon the identical premises upon which it was located on the date of the issuance of
23 the previous license.

24 A licensee who fails to renew his license on or before ~~the thirtieth (30th) day~~
25 ~~of June of each year~~ one (1) year or twelve (12) months after it was issued shall be
26 assessed a penalty of one dollar (\$1.00) per each calendar day he is delinquent, which

1 penalty shall become part of the renewal fee. Any licensee who fails to renew his
2 license on or before ~~the thirty-first (31st) day of July~~ the thirty (30) days after the
3 license should have been renewed shall be required to discontinue his business until
4 he renews the license or be subject to an injunction issued by the Superior Court and
5 to prosecution under § 70119. Such failure to renew while continuing the operation
6 of the business shall constitute refusal and failure to obtain a license under the
7 provisions of this Division.

8 **Section 5. Effective Date.** These changes to the term of business licenses
9 shall be made effective the first day of the month following its Enactment.

10 **Section 6. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to
11 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity
12 shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect
13 without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 Act are severable.

Dear Senator San Nicolas:

My name is John P. Camacho. I am the Director of the Department of Revenue and
Taxation (DRT).

Our office has reviewed Bill No.91-32. We appreciate this bill particularly in its intent to
remove major inconvenience to both business owners and employees of DRT.

The purpose of the Business License Law is to protect the health, safety and morals of
the people of Guam. (11 GCA § 70102).

The unspoken reason for the issuance and renewal of business licenses is to collect
taxes. Please allow me to show you some timelines. The payment of real property taxes
is due on December 15th for the first installment and February 20th for the second
installment. The deadline for the filing of income tax is April 15th of each year. Any
applicant for the renewal of a business license must be in compliance with all tax filings
and tax payments pursuant to 11 GCA § 70130. Business licenses must be renewed
on or before June 30th of each year. It is our observation that during the renewal period,
business owners make the outmost effort to comply with tax filings and tax payments,
particularly for income tax filings and tax payments.

If the renewal period is changed from the fixed date of June 30th of each year to any one
year period from any date of issuance of renewal of business license, what would be the
effect on collection of taxes, particularly income taxes? Would DRT be able to collect
the amount of taxes that the agency is able to collect in June of each year? The answer
is not certain.

A change in a fixed date for the renewal of business licenses from the deadline of June 30th to a year round period will require changes to the business license software to change the parameters for the issuance and expiration of licenses. It is our experience that these costs must be determined and be appropriated before any changes must be made.

It is true that some licenses such as driver's licenses and motor vehicle registration are renewed year round each working day. It must be pointed out there is no tax compliance required for the renewal of driver's licensed or registration of motor vehicle. Applicants are only required to pay for the drivers' license fee or motor registration fee.

Most importantly, it must be brought to the attention of the Committee that the following events are now happening at the DRT:

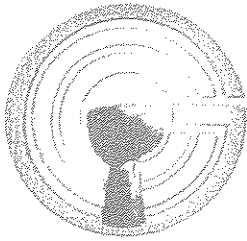
1. Effective May 1, 2015, General Licensing and Registration Branch (Business License) has started renewing licenses for the period July 1, 2015 to July 1, 2016. This will enable business owners to renew business licenses within a period of sixty days. The last day for renewal period is still June 30, 2015.
2. Effective April 1, 2015, online renewal of business licenses is once again made available by DRT to enable business owners who are current in their tax filings and tax payments. The renewal application for licenses with Business License and payment of the business license fee can be done online. For those who would like to avail of this facility, business owners do not need to come to DRT to renew their business licenses.

It is our hope that the above actions will minimize the inconvenience to business owners and to the employees of DRT.

Given the above reasons, at this time, DRT is not in favor of the changes as proposed in Bill 91-33.

Dear Mr. Chairman,

On behalf of the Board of Directors and Membership of the Guam Chamber of Commerce, thank you for the opportunity to submit our comments on Bill No. 91-33 (COR). The Guam Chamber of Commerce is a strong advocate of pro-business legislation and as such supports the intent of Bill No. 91-33 (COR), which would amend the business license renewal date from the current fixed date of June 30th of each year to a business license anniversary date, thus allowing renewals to be spread throughout the year.

The legislation is a step in the right direction in helping to alleviate the inconvenient long lines often caused by the sheer number of individuals and business entities conducting renewals at the same time at the Department of Revenue and Taxation. Additionally, spreading the work related to renewals across the calendar year will allow employees of the Department to manage its operations and resources more efficiently. The measure not only makes it more convenient and flexible for businesses to renew their licenses on a timely manner, it will also help to promote Guam as a 'business-friendly environment' to potential businesses and investors.

Although Bill No. 91-33 (COR) provides an effective date of this mandate to take place on the first day of the following month of its enactment, it does not take into consideration the thousands of business licenses already in place which are scheduled as "June renewals". As such, we would like to recommend the inclusion of a section in the legislation, which would allow an existing business license to attain a renewal date consistent with the month the license was originally established. So, if upon passage of the bill, a licensee attained their business license in August of 2014 (with an expiration date of June 2015), during the renewal in June they would be provided a renewal of August 2016 instead of June 2016. Their license fees would also be pro-rated in this manner. This amendment would essentially iron out the spreading of renewals within an eighteen-month time period.

In summary, the Author of Bill No. 91-33 (COR) is to be commended for taking this positive step to assist in enhancing commerce activity and making it easy to do business in Guam. It is practical legislation that benefits the community as well as future investors. The Guam Chamber of Commerce supports the measure with the inclusion of the recommendation. Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony.

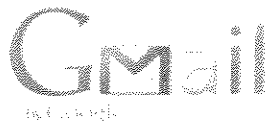

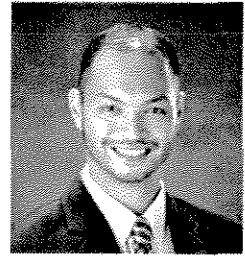
