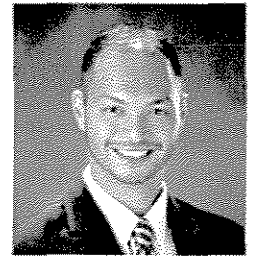

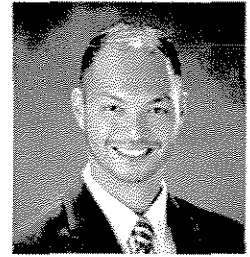

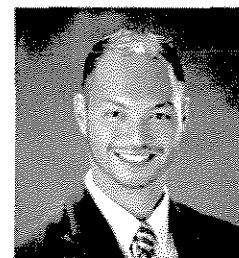

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 98-33 (COR) was introduced on May 14, 2015, by Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr.. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on May 14, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on June 3, 2015, in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Bill No. 98-33 (COR). The hearing convened at 2:00 p.m. and was adjourned at 2:43 p.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas read the title of Bill No. 98-33 (COR). He noted the absence of the bill's author, Senator Frank Aguon, Jr., and asked Senator Mary Torres to read a sponsor statement that was provided to the Committee (attached herein).

Senator Mary Torres read Senator Aguon's statement in which it explained the need for an increase in law enforcement officers within Guam's public safety agencies to ensure the safety of the island community. The

statement explained that members of the Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve (CVPR) receive the same training and that they perform a majority of the duties as full-time police officers. Bill No. 98-33 (COR) would provide preferential credit for CVPR members who apply for law enforcement officer positions in the government of Guam.

Chairman San Nicolas thanked Senator Torres and, after noting that no individuals were present to testify, he adjourned the hearing on Bill No. 98-33 (COR).

I want to begin my sponsor statement by thanking you for holding today's public hearing on Bill No. 98-33 (COR), "An act to amend §4104 of Article 1, Chapter 4, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated; Relative to providing preferential credit for Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve Members who apply for Uniformed Police Officer positions within the Guam Police Department." Unfortunately, I could not be with you today because of a previously scheduled commitment.

I would also like to extend a warm welcome and my sincere appreciation to those individuals providing testimony on Bill No. 98-33 (COR), before, during, and after this scheduled public hearing. It is with your support and contribution that we, as a legislature, are able to craft legislation that will benefit the people of Guam, and in this case, more specifically, the Guam Police Department and its efforts at ensuring the public's safety.

Bill No. 98-33 (COR) recognizes the need for an increase in the number of Law Enforcement Officers in our public safety agencies. During a recent Oversight Hearing of the Guam Police Department held by the Committee on the Guam U.S. Military Relocation, Public Safety, and Judiciary, Captain Eric Fisher went on record to state that the Guam Police Department is understaffed, overworked, and overwhelmed, and that is simply unacceptable.

Bill No. 98-33 (COR) further recognizes the competency of those individuals who serve in the Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve (CVPR) of the Guam Police Department. As members of the CVPR, they each receive the same training in law enforcement, operational techniques, and procedures for natural and man-made disasters as their full-time counterparts. When serving in an official capacity, members of the CVPR are authorized to provide backup manpower for the suppression of crime, preserve law and order, fight and control fires, and assist in civil emergencies alongside Police Officers of the Guam Police Department.

Bill No. 98-33 (COR), if enacted, would provide ten (10) points of preferential credit to members of the CVPR, who are in good standing with the program, when applying to Law Enforcement Officer positions within the Government of Guam, most urgently, the Guam Police Department. CVPR members would also have to attain at least two thousand eighty (2,080) cumulative service hours in order to avail of the opportunity. This ensures that any future, full-time Law Enforcement Officers transitioning from the CPVR have both the experience *and* expertise necessary for a successful transition.

As Chairman of the Committee that oversees Public Safety, one of my top priorities in the 33rd Guam Legislature is to ensure that our Law Enforcement Officers receive the support they need to continue their excellent job in keeping our streets safe. I look forward to working with my senatorial colleagues, our Law Enforcement Officers, and the general public, to ensure that we craft the best possible version of this particular measure and discussing it on the floor during the next available session.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve Program of the Guam Police
4 Department (GPD) provides training in law enforcement, operational techniques
5 and procedures for natural and man-made disasters the members of the Civilian
6 Volunteer Police Reserve (CVPR). When serving in an official capacity, members
7 of the CVPR are authorized to provide backup manpower for the suppression of
8 crime, preserve law and order, fight and control fires, and to assist in civil
9 emergencies alongside police officers of the Guam Police Department.

10 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide preferential
11 credit to members of the Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve Program who would
12 like to serve as a full-time police officer within the Guam Police Department, and
13 who are in good standing with program requirements after having served a
14 minimum number of service credit hours to the island community.

1 **Section 2.** § 4104 of Article 1, Chapter 4, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated is
2 hereby *amended* to read:

3 **“§ 4104. Preferences.**

4 (a) No preference *shall* be given in the government service,
5 except that residents of Guam who are physically or mentally
6 impaired, but are physically and mentally able to perform efficiently
7 and safely the duties of the job being applied for as certified by the
8 Director of Public Health and Social Services, or who are veterans of
9 the Armed Forces of the United States, or who are former members of
10 the Guam Police Combat Patrol, as certified by the Chief of Police, or
11 graduates of the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission
12 Academy operated pursuant to 17 GCA § 32201, as enacted by Public
13 Law Number 24-331, with respect to employment in those positions
14 identified in 17 GCA § 32301(b), as enacted by Public Law Number
15 24-331, *shall* receive a preferential credit of five (5) points, which
16 *shall* be added to their competitive examination score, and such
17 veterans or former members who are disabled as a result of their
18 service in the Armed Forces or Combat Patrol, or who are active
19 members of the Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve Program that have
20 attained at least two thousand eighty (2,080) cumulative service hours
21 of community service and are graduates of the Peace Officer
22 Standards and Training Commission Academy operated pursuant to
23 17 GCA § 32201, as enacted by Public Law Number 24-331, with
24 respect to employment in those positions identified in 17 GCA §
25 32301(b), as enacted by Public Law Number 24-331, shall receive a
26 preferential credit of ten (10) points which *shall* be added to their
27 passing score. In addition, if two (2) applicants for government

1 service are equally qualified for the position to be filled, and one (1) is
2 a beneficiary of a preference pursuant to this Subsection, while the
3 other is not, the former shall be given the first offer of position.”

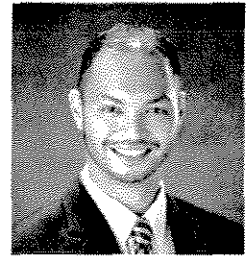
