I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Historic Preservation convened a confirmation hearing on Wednesday, May 13, 2015 at 9:00 AM in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of CACILIE E. CRAFT, to serve as the Archaeological Alternate, Guam Historic Preservation Review Board, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by I Maga'lahen Guåhan on March 21, 2015, to March 20, 2019;
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslatura on April 29, 2015;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on Wednesday, April 30, 2015.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Let's start with the appointment of Cacilie E. Craft. Do we have anyone in the listening audience who would like to come up and provide oral testimony? On the sign-up sheet we have Cacilie Craft, the appointee herself, Jolie Liston and Boyd Dixon. Besides the appointee, would anyone of the two like to come up and provide oral testimony or would you be submitting written testimony at a later time? Okay, written testimony would be provided. Ms. Craft, could you please come up? I would like to thank my colleague and Vice Chairperson, Vice Speaker B.J. Cruz for joining me this morning. Before you start, please state your name and what you're here for, where you're from and if you support your nomination or not. Thank you!

**Cacilie E. Craft** – My name is Cacilie E. Craft and I'm here to be nominated to the Archaeologist Alternate position for the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board and the Guam Preservation Trust Board. I support my nomination and if I had been better prepared I would have prepared a written testimony because I am not great at talking about myself, but I could give a brief statement on my background. I did go to school in Santa Rita and Agat so I spent some of my formative years here on Guam, exploring the history and the archaeology of the island. I spent 13 years away from Guam living in Hawaii. I got my bachelors degree from the University of Hawaii. I went on to work in Egypt and that's where I started my archaeological field career. I was awarded my graduate degree in Egyptology and Archaeology from the University of Liverpool in England. I returned to Hawaii and worked for 2-3 years. I was given the opportunity to come back to Guam in 2012 to run the office out here so I've been here since. I really appreciate the opportunity given to me and I do have the archaeological background. I'm not sure if that's all I need to say...I think that's about it.

**Chairperson** – I'd like to thank you and give the Vice Speaker the opportunity to ask any questions. Mr. Vice Speaker?

**Vice Speaker B.J. Cruz** – You said you worked where?

**Cacilie E. Craft** – Garcia and Associates

**Vice Speaker B.J. Cruz** – And they do archaeological work?

**Cacilie E. Craft** – It's a natural and cultural consulting firm.

**Vice Speaker B.J. Cruz** – Since you've been back, what are some of the major projects that you've worked on?

**Cacilie E. Craft** – We have worked on a lot of projects ranging from small private sector projects for example a septic tank in their back yard, all the way to large federal projects. We have projects on the Navy or Air Force areas. We recently completed a monitoring project on Andersen Force base, for example. We've also had projects with the Guam Historic Preservation Resources division last year, we worked with the historian to complete a survey in southern Guam. We've had a wide range of projects.

**Chairperson** – Thank you Mr. Speaker. Also joining us this morning is Senator Tony Ada. Senator Ada, do you have any questions? I want to thank you for coming out Cacilie for stepping up to the plate. I also want to thank the Administration for sending down your appointment. I just have one question for you. If there is one thing that you'd like to see change or enhance to the Guam Preservation Trust, what would you like to share?

**Cacilie E. Craft** – That's a really great question. The Guam Preservation Trust is such a great organization already. The projects that they do to increase awareness of historic preservation on Guam is commendable. I would say just keep doing what they're doing. Finding more historic resources that need preservation and expanding that effort.

**Chairperson** – Well, I want to say thank you again for volunteering and stepping up to the plate. It's exciting...I'm sure they'll have a full quorum and complete the discipline. I do know that Mr. Quinata from the Preservation Trust would submit a written testimony in support of your nomination. I want to say thank you again and I would call your appointment to the Guam Preservation Trust publicly heard. Thank you to all your supporters for coming out.

**For the record:** Two (2) written testimonies were submitted in favor of Cacilie E. Craft's appointment. They are from Judith R. Amesbury, Archaeologist, Micronesian Archaeological Research Services, Inc. and Dr. Boyd Dixon, Senior Archaeologist, Cardno. Both testimonies are attached for review.




