COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The appointment of Ms. Catherine D. Gayle to serve as Member of the Civil Service Commission, Board of Commissioners was executed by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on September 25, 2015. The appointment packet was received by the Office of the Speaker Judith T. Won Pat on the same day, and the appointment was subsequently referred to the Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication on September 28, 2015.

The Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication convened a confirmation hearing on Monday, October 19, 2015, at 6:00PM in the Guam Legislature Public Hearing Room. The item on the agenda was the appointment of Ms. Catherine D. Gayle to serve as Member of the Civil Service Commission, Board of Commissioners. The confirmation hearing for the appointment of Ms. Catherine D. Gayle began at 6:05PM and ended at 6:22PM.

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on October 12, 2015, and October 17, 2015, via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Benjamin J.F. Cruz read the public hearing notice statement and called the confirmation hearing of Ms. Catherine Gayle to order:

"Today we only have one item on the agenda: the executive appointment of Ms. Catherine D. Gayle to serve as a member of the Civil Service Commission (CSC), Board of Commissioners. Let's see who signed up...Oh great. Chairman Baza, Mr. Lamorena, Lou Hongyee, Edith Pangelinan, John Nowakowski, and Danny Leon Guerrero. Oh, it's all just in support, huh. Okay, Mr. Chairman."

Mr. Luis R. Baza greeted the Committee, introduced himself as the chairman of the Civil Service Commission, and began his testimony <u>in support</u> of the appointee:

"Håfa Adai and thank you for giving me the opportunity to testify on Catherine Gayle. I, as a chairman, and my commissioners, fully support the appointment of Ms. Gayle, and [incomprehensible] of the Commission to plays a vital role in managing the merit system. We take our work very seriously and the responsibilities we have... a lot of long hours to read those packets you know I'm very happy to know Ms. Gayle's willing to take that with her. Her experience, her training, her background, you know, in personnel, in human resource (HR) management is really a plus for us. We do a lot of human relations, a lot of people management. But at the same time there's a balance in the merit system. We're not pro employees. We're not pro management. We're pro merit system. So I wanted to assure the committee and the senators that that's us. And they always say, "Who is the Civil Service Commission?" "Oh, it's not the executive director, it's really the commissioners." It's true. The director and the staff supports us, but when we make decisions, it's independent. They can do post audits on other issues when Government of Guam complaints come in, but at the end of the day, we're independent. We can actually tell the staff that we do not agree with their recommendation. We can do that as well. That's the independence we have. I would like to strongly recommend Ms. Gayle -Catherine Gayle - to you, for your kind consideration to [have her] be [the] next commissioner. It's not a very easy task and we welcome any individual willing to step up to the plate and do this kind of work. Thank you very much."

Chairman Cruz thanked Chairman Baza and called on the next speaker to provide testimony.

Mr. Alberto "Tony" Lamorena greeted the Committee and began to read from his written testimony (appended to this report) in support of Ms. Gayle's nomination.

Chairman Cruz thanked the first panel of speakers. He asked the Committee for comments, to which they had none. Before calling on the appointee as the next speaker, he added:

"I'm glad you finally realized that there's more power as the chairman of the board rather than being the executive director...[laughter]... And that's why you've accepted that for life. We'll now hear from the nominee. Thank you very much for accepting the appointment."

Ms. Catherine D. Gayle began her testimony:

"Håfa Adai, Vice Speaker Cruz, Senator Torres, and Senator Aguon. Thank you for having me here tonight. It's my great pleasure to be invited to come here tonight and to be nominated for the CSC. I look forward for the opportunity of both serving the government and the island of Guam. As you see, I have over fifteen (15) years experience in the human resource field. Much of it the cases that I believe are similar to the cases that the CSC would deal with. Through those years learning, developing the ability to view with an open eye, unbiased, looking at all the facts in front of you. And I hope to take this experience and bring it to the CSC, but at the same time learn from CSC. I think this is an incredible opportunity to learn from the Commission and the commissioners who have a great wealth of experience and from the cases that are brought forward. I feel that through my years, I believe, I've been perceived as a person with great integrity, a person who is fair and is consistent in her review and in her actions as they've dealt with different HR related matters at the workplace. And I hope to carry that experience to the Commission. Thank you again for having me tonight. And if you have any questions, in terms of my background..."

Chairman Cruz thanked the appointee and expounded on the circumstances surrounding the scheduling of the confirmation hearing:

"Well thank you very much, first of all, for willing to serve on the Commission. I scheduled the hearing as soon as I could because I know how important this commission is and I wanted to make sure we weren't going to have any issues as it relates to quorum. And this nomination will go before the legislature this week for confirmation because I feel it imperative that we keep this commission fully staffed to be able to move this forward. And I really believe it's important to protect the merit system. And they weren't joking about the hours. I hope you understand the number of nights that they meet."

Ms. Gayle replied to Chairman Cruz's comment on the amount of time the CSC members met:

"Yes, I know. It is a commitment. And I was looking. I was looking at the website, looking at the cases, looking at the agenda, and I understand."

Chairman Cruz followed up by asking in jest, to which was followed by laughter: "And your husband is okay with that?"

Ms. Gayle responded:

"He's committed, too. This is a partnership. It has to be a partnership."

Chairman Cruz asked the appointee, based on her resume, whether she had completed all her studies and received a Masters in Business Administration.

Ms. Gayle answered:

"I finished all the courses and my final dissertation, which I submitted this year, in June. But through this particular university, it's a very lengthy process and goes through several panels of review. And it's at its final stage now, and I'll be notified in November just what type of degree it will be conferred. So the post graduate is completed. You get a post graduate degree but at what level, I won't know until the final review of the paper that I submitted."

Chairman Cruz congratulated Ms. Gayle.

Ms. Gayle thanked Chairman Cruz.

Chairman Cruz added:

"You can do your dissertation on the studies you do in this commission." [laughter]

Ms. Gayle responded:

"Yes...No, it's an example. It's thousands of pages of reading, in preparation, in research for that particular paper, so perhaps I can apply some of that to this upcoming work here."

Chairman Cruz continued:

"Okay, well I notice you have considerable experience so I really have no questions. And I'm just really excited that we have someone with this kind of background from the private sector. We've taken them from the government sector and we moved them all from being in the CSC up to the board. But what we need now are those of you from the private sector. I know the Society for

Human Resource Management (SHRM) is very big on island and it's very nice for those of you from the private sector willing to step up and come on board to lend your expertise and your experience."

Senator Mary Camacho Torres provided comments:

"Mrs. Gayle, it's very nice to meet you. And it's exciting to see that you're well qualified and you had a lot of HR training experience. And I had a lot of experience with the CSC, working in the government and one thing I can say is they certainly take their responsibility in determining what is ultimately the livelihood of the government employees to heart. And I've seen that in their dedication at the CSC. But I was wondering, you mentioned that you you've gone on the website and you've reviewed [the CSC]... Do you have an understanding of what their responsibilities are and what their caseload is presently? And we recently passed a law that mandated the use of an administrative law judge to help facilitate and help accelerate the disposition of cases. But have you had any thoughts on what you see as some of the challenges in the Commission and how you can lend some assistance to your fellow commissioners, upon appointment and in confirmation?"

Ms. Gayle responded:

"Well, I'm very new. So it's just a cursory review of the cases and of the website and the agenda. So at this time, not. But I do have an understanding about the law judge and its passing and it's going through a process right now of review. And I think that that is a fantastic move – a step forward – in terms of perhaps a better management of caseload is to have that particular role in place."

"But in terms of what I can bring: maybe somewhat of the private sector. But I know this whole CSC is quite distinct and the rules in play are actually quite distinct. I'll be able to apply the same, I would say, process, in the sense that even in the private sector, what really counts is evidence and facts and rules. Although one might look at a case and say, "Oh, this is an obvious decision," you must really understand the rules that are at play and the evidence that applies to those rules. So I'll bring that in. but I do know that the particular commission members are working themselves are extremely experienced so I think from the get-go it's going to be a lot of me learning from the fellow commission members."

Senator Torres continued:

"And of course, it's one of those jobs where they give so much of themselves. And they're really held in a very bright public light and public eye. As we said, the matters do affect the livelihood of the employees and I commend you for wanting to serve in this way, because I think of all the boards, this is probably

the one that they probably take home with them. You know, you're professional but it affects you in such a way because you are dealing with people in their lives and the families that are affected by their jobs. But I just wanted to say congratulations for stepping up to the role. Thank you very much for wanting to serve in this capacity. And I want to say that when you come on board, I'm sure you're going to enjoy the company because they're just really are an amazing people. And dedicated beyond the ordinary, in my estimate. Thank you."

Ms. Gayle thanked Senator Torres.

Senator Frank B. Aguon, Jr. proceeded with his remarks:

"I, too, would also like to thank you very much for extending yourself and allowing [yourself] to serve in this capacity. I think it's very critical as this is one of the agencies that really has a tremendous amount of autonomy, affecting people's lives... employees inclusive, all the management, all the agencies. I thank you so much for leaning forward. Very impressed. I know the chairman mentioned earlier, but [I am] very impressed with your human resources background. Just so that for the satisfaction of our people out there in the community who are watching, you initiated, at least just based on your resume, [it] was 1997, you were the assistant vice president for HR for a particular private company, then you transitioned to another company in 2003, and served as the HR manager, and then continued in 2008 to a different company - all in the private sector - as the vice president and head of the human resources, and then you presently serve as HR director for DFS Guam. So that's eighteen (18) years collectively, of working and serving from a human resources perspective. Just with that kind of experience and that kind of knowledge, I'm very pleased to not only be here to listen to your comments and highlight some of your expertise, but I'd like to ask you if you can extend yourself just a little further."

"In addition to entertaining all of these cases, as they come out, and review them - I know that's going to be very time consuming - but with eighteen (18) years of wonderful, outstanding expertise in this arena, if there are any laws that we can amend or update or if there are any rules and regulations that you consider need updating, reflect not only technology not only the processes, I'm asking you to please share that with the chairman or the other commission members, with the executive director, and also with the oversight chair, because we always want to make sure we have a system in place, that is fair and applied equity across the board in terms of making your decisions. And I mentioned because it really impacts the lives of many of our people. So I ask you, if you are able to, because you bring so much expertise in the human resource department, I think that will always be helpful in helping us, guiding us in the policy making perspective, in

terms of looking at laws and helping fellow commission members as well as the executive director looking at the rules and regulations that perhaps can be enhanced. But I know you have some very good laws and policies to the employees. But let me close with... I know that you have some outstanding commission members that I'm sure you've met, working with the executive director and with the wonderful staff and management at the CSC, we certainly wish you the best in your service. And once again thank you for extending yourself to the people of Guam. Thank you, Mr. Chair."

Ms. Gayle thanked Senator Aguon.

Chairman Cruz thanked the individuals who provided testimony and asked if anybody else wished to speak:

"Thank you very much. I think they've said it all. So with there being no other questions, we can consider this heard. Did you want to speak? No? That's alright. [laughter] Alright, thank you very much..."

Ms. Gayle thanked the Committee.

Chairman Cruz thanked the panel of speakers for testifying. He read the closing statements, adjourned the confirmation hearing, and added:

"We will be reporting this to the floor for action this week. Okay. Thank you."

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Appropriations and Adjudication to which was referred the executive appointment of Ms. Catherine D. Gayle to serve as Member of the Civil Service Commission, Board of Commissioners for a term of six (6) years, beginning on the date of her confirmation until September 24, 2021, with a recommendation TO
