### **COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST**

### I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Christine W. Baleto to serve as the Director of the Department of Administration was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on February 26, 2016. The nomination package was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on February 29, 2016, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on March 2, 2016.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a confirmation hearing on April 28, 2016, in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the nomination of Mr. Schnabel. The hearing convened at 5:34 p.m. and was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on April 21, 2016, and again on April 26, 2016. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura*'s website beginning on April 21, 2016.

#### II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

**Senator Mary Torres**, serving as presiding officer of the hearing, convened the hearing on the nomination of Christine Baleto. She yielded the floor to the first panel to present their testimony.

**Attorney General Elizabeth Barrett-Anderson** spoke in support of the nomination and provided written testimony (see attached). She described her relationship with Ms. Baleto whom, when serving as Executive Officer for Sanctuary Inc., she was able to work with in her capacity as Juvenile Drug Court Judge.

**Dr. Lisa Natividad** spoke in favor of the nomination. She described their working relationship serving at the helm of Sanctuary, Inc. and how they worked to improve the financial situation of the organization. She stated that the nominee would be a tremendous asset to the government of Guam. She encouraged the Legislature to support Ms. Baleto's nomination.

**Former Senator Tony Lamorena** testified in favor of the nomination. He spoke about her involvement in helping various community causes. He explained that the Department of Administration is essential to the operations of the government and that continuity is important. He asked the Legislature to support the nomination.

**President Robert Underwood** read a prepared statement in support of the nomination (see attached).

Philip Flores read a prepared statement in support of Ms. Baleto's nomination (see attached).

**Former Senator Joanne Brown** spoke in favor of the nomination. She mentioned her previous working relationship when Ms. Baleto served of the Port Authority of Guam board. She explained that the responsibilities of the Department of Administration are great and Ms. Baleto has demonstrated the ability and capability to lead the agency. She asked favorable consideration for the nomination.

**Kristina Blaz** thanked the nominee for her willingness to take the position and said she believed that the Ms. Baleto is more than capable of doing the job.

**Senator Torres** called the nominee forward to present her testimony.

Christine Baleto explained her initial impression serving in an acting capacity at the Department of Administration. She spoke about her experience in finance, accounting, financial reporting, budgeting, and organizational and personnel management. Ms. Baleto explained her reasons for wanting to serve in the government and thanked her department staff assisting her in learning more about the operations of the Department. She asked for favorable consideration of her nomination.

**Senator Tony Ada** praised the nominee for her character and her willingness to serve. He thanked Ms. Baleto for her hard work in the Department and expressed his support for her nomination.

**Senator Brant McCreadie** thanked the public for their attendance in support of Ms. Baleto. He stated that he wants to see the nominee excel in her position and expressed his support for her nomination.

**Senator Nerissa Underwood** stated the complexities of the job and thanked Ms. Baleto for her willingness to assume the job of Director. She asked about what some of the challenges facing the government are.

**Ms. Baleto** explained that there are challenges with the personnel department and improving the equipment and process to hire prospective employees. She stated that she is working with the Office of Technology to make the accounting system more efficient for the benefit of the entire government. Ms. Baleto mentioned that more training needs to be implemented to improve the procurement process. She praised each of the Department's employees for their hard work.

**Senator Underwood** reiterated the importance of the Department of Administration to the operations of the entire government of Guam. She also mentioned the importance of having a central database that can be used by the government and the general public to view the finances of the government.

**Ms. Baleto** stated that the Office of Technology is working on establishing a more efficient and convenient system.

**Speaker Judith Won Pat** stated that she is a relative of the nominee. She mentioned Ms. Baleto's initial experience in her acting capacity made her more knowledgeable about the role of the Department and made her a stronger nominee. Speaker Won Pat praised the nominee for her character, work ethic, education, and experience.

**Senator Torres** asked Ms. Baleto her how she intends to maximize training and educational opportunities for government personnel.

**Ms. Baleto** stated that the Department is looking to fill critical positions. She mentioned that she wants to implement longevity training for certain positions so that the institutional knowledge is not lost as a result of staffing changes.

**Senator Torres** asked for a status update on the appeals resulting for the implementation of the Competitive Wage Act.

**Ms. Baleto** stated that the responses are almost finalized and are scheduled to be sent out by the end of May.

**Senator Tommy Morrison** thanked the individuals who provided testimony. He mentioned that he is pleased with the Office of Technology for working to expand the services available to the public. He expressed his support for the nomination.

**Senator Rory Respicio** spoke about his past working relationship with Ms. Baleto while he was serving at the Department of Youth Affairs and she at Sanctuary Inc. He spoke about the task ahead of leading the Department of Administration but expressed confidence in the nominee's ability to do the job. He indicated his support for Ms. Baleto's nomination.

Vice Speaker BJ Cruz spoke about his relationship with Ms. Baleto when he served as Chairman of the Board for Sanctuary Inc. while she was Executive Director. He spoke about the need to develop an easier database for sharing information with regards to government finances and praised the Department for looking into it. He expressed support for the nomination.

Senator Torres invited Clifford Guzman to present his testimony.

**Mr. Guzman** spoke about his previous work with Ms. Baleto at Sanctuary Inc. He mentioned that he has always been impressed with her managerial and organizational skills which will serve as beneficial assets in her new role. He explained, as a former Director of the Department of Administration, the need for a good team to run the operations and stated that Ms. Baleto has a good team under her. He expressed his support for her nomination.

Senator Torres concluded the hearing on the nomination.

#### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS



Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the nomination of Ms. Christine W. Baleto.



Again, thank you very much for this opportunity. I truly hope you consider Ms. Baleto for the DOA Directorship.




I have also watched her give back to the community by leading Sanctuary and more recently serving on the board of the Port Authority of Guam.
