COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on April 17, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in *I Liheslaturan Guahan* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment Ms. Conchita D. Bathan to serve as a member of the Guam Land Use Commission, whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointment by Eddie Baza Calvo, *Governor*, On March 27, 2015
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslaturan Guahan* on March 30, 2015
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on March 31, 2015.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Monday, April 13, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on Wednesday, April 15, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

The confirmation hearing for Ms. Conchita D. Bathan commenced at 9:00 a.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairman Ada: notes that the committee has received written testimony in favor of Ms. Bathan's confirmation from the Director of the Department of Land Management and Victim Advocates Reaching Out.

Chairman Ada: then recognizes two members of the Guam Land Use Commission, Ms. Tricee Limtiaco and Mr. John Arroyo.

Chairman Ada: calls those who have sign-up to give written testimony.

Tricee Limtiaco:, *Commissioner, Guam Land Use Commission* (oral testimony): She starts by stating she is currently a commissioner on the Guam Land Use Commission (GLUC) and has

served on the commission for the last two years. She goes on to say in those two years she has worked closely with Ms. Bathan, who participates in all the meetings, whether it's technical meetings or the actual hearings. She says that Ms. Bathan conducts herself with the up-most professionalism and have never shied away from making hard decisions. Ms. Limitaco says she enjoys working Ms. Bathan and has seen on some occasions, Ms. Bathan recuse herself from any issues that came before the commission. She finishes by saying she is there for support and hopes the committee will consider her reappointment.

Chairman Ada: then calls for the appointee to give her testimony.

Conchita D. Bathan, appointee (oral testimony): She starts by thanking Chairperson Ada for holding the confirmation hearing and providing her the opportunity to request support from the body to her reappointment to the Guam Land Use Commission (GLUC). Ms. Bathan then says she would like to take the time to clarify an issue that was published in the Pacific Daily News, where she was named as a shareholder of Finance Pro. She then says for the record she is not and has not been a shareholder of Finance Pro, which is stated in her appointment packet. Being a member if the GLUC is not an easy job, as was pointed out by Ms. Limtiaco early says Ms. Bathan. She says for the most part meeting times run about 4 hours, not including time it takes to prepare for the meeting. Members must be prepared in order to make informed and right decisions she says.

Ms. Bathan: says this is the third time she has been asked to be a member of the GLUC. She has started may in May 2008, when she was first appointed, then reappointed in 2011 and today would be the third appointment to the GLUC. She goes onto say that she considered the people to be the most important and valuable resource of the island. She goes to say the reason is that the people is who she has been appointed to represent and who's best interest she has to serve. Ms. Bathan says throughout her six years of service with the GLUC, she has treated that commitment with the highest integrity and in doing she always keeps in mind why she has been asked to serve, in addition to the commitment to the people she serves. As commissioners, we are expected to utilize our personal knowledge and experience that have been recognized by this community, the leaders who have appointed us and those who have confirmed us, she says.

She says in her previous appointments she has discussed why she wants and what qualifies her to serve as a GLUC member. She goes on to say with her six years of experience with the GLUC, and she would like to share that experience today. First she says, she respects the process that is in place. It is not always easy to make oneself available for meeting or working sessions, with full time jobs. However, she says being present for the entire process is critical to be prepared to make the most informed decision. Second she says, she honors the importance of the decisions the commission makes. She goes on to say as commissioners the work is not isolated to just board meetings. And lastly she says, she fulfills he role as a commissioner with the highest integrity. When there is a personal or professional conflict on any application before the board, she does what is expected of all public servants. She goes on to say that she recuses herself from any matter that she has a conflict with but goes beyond and excuses herself from the boardroom. She then thanks the panel and opens to any questions.

Lawrence Rivera, Chairperson, Guam Land Use Commission (oral testimony): He starts by saying that anytime Ms. Bathan has a conflict of interest she does recuse herself. He goes onto to say that not only does she recuse herself but she does leave the boardroom. We as commissioners try to best serve the people based on the procedures and laws of the Guam Land Use Commission, says Mr. Rivera. He continues with saying that Ms. Bathan brings a lot of institutional knowledge on construction and things of that nature. Mr. Rivera says that she is an asset to the commission. He goes on to say she is always open-minded and relies on the expertise of the Department of Land Management and the application review committee. He finishes by saying that he supports the nomination of Ms. Bathan to the GLUC.

Chairman: Ada then opens for questions from the panel.

Chairperson Ada: He starts by saying that Ms. Bathan brings to the table her expertise and experience in construction industry, which adds to the current expertise already sitting on the commission. He then when there is a conflict of interest, she would recuse herself and leave the room. Chairperson Ada continues by saying the types of projects that come to the GLUC, in many cases are presumed to be large construction projects that would require some zone variance. He continues by saying with Ms. Bathan being a CEO of a big construction company and major competitor in the industry, he asks if those conflicts come up frequently?

Ms. Bathan: She replies that she believes they have submitted a few applications that are before the GLUC but she has recused herself from those meetings.

Chairperson Ada: He asks Ms. Bathan, for the six years that she has been on the commission, there has only been three instances that she had to recuse herself? He then says one, because the company that she is the head of is coming before the GLUC.

Ms. Bathan: She replies that she cannot remember exactly how many times but does stat that there were only a few times.

Senator Respicio: He starts by thanking Ms. Bathan for her continued willingness to serve the people in this capacity. He goes on to say that he wants to focus on the testimony written in support by the Director of the Department of Land Management. He says that Director Borja keened in on individual attributes and the strengths brought to the GLUC. The Director recognizes her ability and experiences in the construction industry and points out that she helps to find solutions when necessary so clients can enjoy the best and highest use of their property, says Senator Respicio. He then clarifies that the clients mentioned in the Directors letter are the applicants of the GLUC. He then says that he is convinces that Ms. Bathan is able to compartmentalize and bifurcate her position and employer verses her responsibilities to the GLUC. Senator Respicio then asks Ms. Bathan to recall an incident where she was faced with a difficult decision and the outcome.

Ms. Bathan: She replies by saying it was when she was first appointed in 2008, the late Senator Pangelinan, was asking her hard questions about her appointment. She had the impression that he felt that she was appointed to specifically approve an application, the Ypao Luxury Condominium. She goes on to say that during the public hearing for that application, she voted

no because she felt it was the right thing to do. She then said the following day the Senator Pangelinan called to apologize because he thought wrong about her.

Senator McCreadie: He starts by thanking Ms. Bathan for accepting another nomination and she has his full support. With extensive institutional knowledge it is a no brainer, says Senator McCreadie. He continues by saying he is glad that Ms. Bathan cleared up the issue written in the Pacific Daily News, although he didn't read the article, it is not as if he needed her to clarify the issue to give his support. He then mentions the testimony provided by Victims Advocate Reaching Out (VARO), which shows that Ms. Bathan is a very busy person but when they call she answers. He says that he sees that 2/3 of her life is committed to public service, he then asks her to keep up the good work for the island. He finishes by saying that she has his full support.

Senator Rodriguez: He starts by congratulating Ms. Bathan on her reappointment. He then says that he got to know Ms. Bathan on a personal level over the years. Getting to know someone and the people they surround themselves with helps to get to know someone, says Senator Rodriguez. That is how he got to know Ms. Bathan. He continues by saying he wants to highlight the points made by Senator McCreadie, that she is a busy person but still finds the time to volunteer with such an important organization as VARO. He goes on to ask her standing on the Legislature does spot zoning?

Ms. Bathan: She replies by saying the Legislative Body created a law, and the community has a purgative to come to the body and request zone changes and variances. She says however, if they feel that the application before them is not supported by the public or is having issues, Ms. Bathan says the commission prefers those application be brought to the commission.

Senator Morrison: He starts thanking Ms. Bathan for wanting to maintain the institutional knowledge at the GLUC. He goes on to say that he echoes the concerns made by Senator Rodriguez. He then says as the former Director at the Bureau of Statistics and Plans, he had to work closely with technical folks who sat on the application review committee. It was always a challenge even at that end, he says. He goes on to say that there was also a time when a recommendation was made to the body, from the GLUC to suspend applications that would come before the body and it was respected at that time. He then asks if Ms. Bathan thinks there should be a mechanism in place that prior to any request at the Legislature, it must still go through the GLUC?

The question was answered by Mr. Rivera.

Senator Morrison: He goes on to say that he knows the ARC has been very cautious of the government land patterns and protecting our resources. He then says that when the requests come to his office, he asks them if they have first gone through the proper process. Senator Morrison says that he always sends them back because of his prior experience with the Bureau of Statistics and Plans. He understands there is a Northern and Central land use plan that is in place to be used as a guide for making decisions. Senator Morrison asked, if they are familiar with that plan.

Mr. Rivera: He is not familiar with this plan from the top of his head. He explains their Chief Planner would be the one familiar with it. The planner does the analysis and makes

recommendations to the commission. According to Mr. Rivera the commission lacks a master plan and that it would be nice to have one.

Senator Morrison: Suggest working with Bureau of Statistics and Plans to view the plan, which is really a guideline to help with decision making. He pledges his full support for the nominee.

Vice Speaker Cruz: Says legislature exists for two reasons. One is the budget and the other is advice and consent, which he takes very important. He does not blame the nominees for the shortcomings that is created by the legislature. Vice Speaker Cruz acknowledges that Ms. Bathan is correct when she did not list Finance Pro on her resume, because she is not a shareholder. The problem is the application form only asks for statement for financial interest and does not ask what other commission or boards do you sit on. He explains that it is impossible to keep track of all the LLC's and LLP's. Ms. Bathan's 2014 registration to Rev and Tax has her listed as the Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer for Finance Pro. The document shows that Ms. Bathan does not own any interest in the company regardless of what title she holds. Vice Speaker has not been able to determine yet if Finance Pro is an LLC or LLP under Core Tech. Vice Speaker Cruz asked Ms. Bathan how many construction applications for homes have Finance Pro had before the Land Use Commission has she walked out off, because of conflict of interest.

Ms. Bathan: She will recuse herself when it concerns Finance Pro, Core Tech, or any company that she is affiliated with. Ms. Bathan believes this is not an issue to be discussed during this nomination hearing.

Vice Speaker Cruz: Asked Ms. Bathan if she took part in the discussion or vote on Talaverde.

Ms. Bathan: That was decided before she was appointed.

Vice Speaker Cruz: He is trying to figure out if Ms. Bathan was involved in the discussion of Talaverde. That's the issue not with Ms. Bathan, but with the application form, because it clearly states financial interest. It shows that you have no interest in Finance Pro, but you are the Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, which you are not required to list. He goes on by saying how would any other board members would know you held these titles without having to list them. Vice Speaker Cruz believes it is a problem that the legislature and the governors office to correct this issue.

Ms. Bathan: Explains, that before the appointment hearing she had met with Senator Tom Ada to ensure her application packet was filled out correctly. She asked Senator Tom Ada if she had to list Finance Pro on her application and Sen. Ada responded no, because she has no financial interest in Finance Pro. She believes that as servants of the community it is her conscience that should dictate us as a public servant.

Vice Speaker: Cruz: He truly appreciate's that and wish they had more people like Ms. Bathan. The thing is there is no way for anyone to police or follow it because of the way it is written. He asked Ms. Bathan how many LLC's and LLP's are you an officer in besides Finance Pro.

Ms. Bathan: Responded by asking if that issue a matter of her nomination.

Vice Speaker Cruz: That is what I am trying to figure out. It is hard to figure out if it is an issue for your nomination, because its hard to know what LLC's and LLP's you are a part of. Vice Speaker Cruz ask should a finance company that does construction for home loans be listed, so whether or not the application involving loans with that company are before the TLUC. What are things are you an officer off that should be divulged, so the legislature and director knows to not send you this binder, because she has an interest. It may not be a financial interest, but holds positions within the company.

Ms. Bathan: Explains that she is a part of two companies. One is Finance Pro and the other is Core Tech. She implies that she will recuse herself from the commission. Ms. Bathan says that Guam is such a small island and its hard to not have an interest in a lot of things.

Vice Speaker Cruz: You are an officer in two corporations, which is Finance Pro, Core Tech, Ace, and BC Development . Is that the only four companies we will find your name on at Rev and Tax.

Ms. Bathan: That is what she remembers.

Senator Respicio: Would like to add something to swage the Vice Speaker's concerns, because he does bring up a valid point. Senator Respicio recalls they amended the law on financial disclosure act, which requires boards and commissions to submit directly to the GEC exposing and divulging all their conflicts before that respected entity. He is a member of the work force investment act with the DOL and AHRD. At that level the commissioner is suppose to disclose that information.

Vice Speaker Cruz: He understand that.

Senator Respicio: Explains that it goes beyond the nomination packet and application process. It gives the opportunity as the commissioner to let the commission know what other financial interest you have and sign that you will recuse yourself if it should come before the commission.

Vice Speaker Cruz: He understands that but in this packet Ms. Bathan did not list Finance Pro and she is correct for that. She does not own a share, but does hold positions in that company. Vice Speaker Cruz says that Ms. Bathan only testified on being on four companies and asked her if she is sure about that.

Ms. Bathan: Remembers now, that she is a member of Core Tech Foundation as well. It is a non-profit organization for scholarships.

Vice Speaker Cruz: How about the non-profit organizations companies.

Ms. Bathan: No

Vice Speaker Cruz: Is the first to admit it. It is the form given out by the front office and it is the legislatures own making. It is his responsibility to ask questions like this, if you have any interest in other companies.

Ms. Bathan: Maybe in the future you can revise the form, but for now it unfortunately does not ask to state anything else other than financial interest.

Vice Speaker Cruz: Request the Chairman to request from the nominee to provide an addenda with this application listing all LLC's and LLP's she is an office of that might have any interest that could come before the commission.

Chairman Ada: She already indicated what she is a part of.

Vice Speaker Cruz: I asked her what else she was involved with and then she finally remembered one. He wants to give Ms. Bathan a week to submit an addenda to the chairman. If not then, Vice Speaker Cruz will get the information himself and show the rest of the senators.

Ms. Bathan: She believes that is not fair to be put through this detailed exposure and not the other members.

Senator Respicio: As he pointed out earlier P.L. 24-91 states the disclosure of conflict of interest for government board and commission members. P.L. 24-91 asks two general questions, which addresses Vice Speaker Cruz's issue on how would we know, if a commissioner has a conflict of interest. This makes the individual come forward with the following reasons. P.L. 24-91 requires any appointee to fill out a disclosure form.

Vice Speaker Cruz: Asked Ms. Bathan when was the last time she filled out a disclosure form.

Ms. Bathan: Sometime this year.

Vice Speaker Cruz: Is the committee going to get that or am I going to get it.

Chairman Ada: Is going to get a copy of that form and make it a part of the confirmation packet to satisfy Vice Speaker Cruz's questions.

Vice Speaker Cruz: Is just finding out about these LLC's and LLP's problems, but Ms. Bathan obviously has 14 votes.

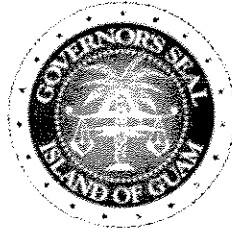
Senator Respicio: Agrees, they should get the disclosure statement forms and take a look at how other commissioners responds to this form. He feels Vice Speaker Cruz's discussion is very helpful for all board and commissions to update these forms annually.

Chairman Ada: Wants to echo that same statement as Senator Respicio as well as reassure Ms. Bathan that she is not being singled out. Chairman Ada calls this public hearing adjourned.

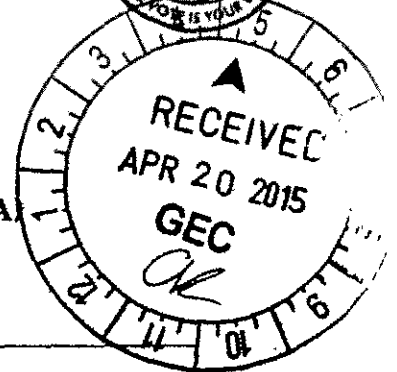




