At this time, I'd like to call up the first panel of individuals here to testify. The first name on the sign in sheet is Mr. Jim Richardson from the National Park Service. Please come up and provide your oral testimony.

MR. JIM RICHARDSON: Good morning Senators and members of the public. I am Jim Richardson, Superintend from the War in the Pacific National Historic Park. I'm here to support the nomination of Mr. David T. Lotz to the Historic Preservation Review Board. I've known Dave now for a year and half and I know him to be a very good worker for the nation, through the National Park Service but also for the people of Guam and the history of Guam. He's very knowledgeable, and I actually call him our Historian. For many years he has been involved in exactly what is needed for this board and I highly recommend him. Thank you!

<u>CHAIRPERSON:</u> Thank you very much! If there's anyone else that would like to speak on behalf of Mr. Lotz and Ms. Liston, please come forward. Ms. Lynda Aguon, would you like to come forward? I am going to call the appointees up afterwards. Please come forward and state your name and if you're in support or not in support of the nominees and where you're from.

MS. LYNDA AGUON: Hafa adai my name is Lynda Aguon and I'm the Guam State Historic Preservation Officer for the Department of Parks and Recreation. On behalf of the Director and Deputy Director, they are in full support of the two (2) nominees. They couldn't be here because of pressing matters with the Governor's office. I've known Dave since 1983 when he was the Parks Administrator of the Department of Parks and Recreation and I started my career as the Archeological Technician. I've known him to be very straight forward and get the job done, although he can be vicious but I think it's appropriate of his position as Parks Administrator. I know that he's done a lot of the data entry for property historic. He's been around and he knows what's out there and what needs to be done like the back of his hand. I am in full support of his nomination for the Historic Preservation Review Board. He is like a guiding light for me; he knows what he's doing. He gives guidance where he feels that I need. I am in full support for Dave's nomination. I am also in support of Jolie Liston's nomination to the board as well. I've known Jolie about 3 or 4 years. She is an outstanding researcher, outstanding archeaologist and has done work in the Micronesia, Palau, Yap and she knows her job like the back of her hand. She has done the Manenggon concentration camp nomination and the Chaguian massacre site as well. They are both on the National Register. Jolie sees the wrong and wants to right it and I appreciate it. So I'm in full support for her nomination as well.

<u>CHAIRPERSON:</u> Thank you Ms. Aguon, hagu mas! Any questions for Ms. Aguon? None at this time, so I would like to call up the nominees to come forward please. Before I have them speak, I would like to state for the record that a written testimony for Mr. Lotz and Ms. Liston were submitted by Mr. Joe Quinata of the Guam Preservation Trust and he is in full support of both nominees. (*testimony attached for review*) Please proceed Mr. Lotz.

MR. DAVID T. LOTZ: Good morning Senators. My name is David T. Lotz and this is my second nomination to the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board. I am here to read my testimony on the appointment to the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board unless you decided that I don't need to. In summary, I've been on Guam since 1970, it's home and started at the Department of Parks and Recreation. When I retired I worked at AAFB, doing similar work as the War in the National Park. That's basically it in a nut shell. *Mr. Lotz's written testimony is attached for review*.

CHAIRPERSON: Thank you Mr. Lotz. Ms. Liston, please proceed.

MS. JOLIE LISTON: My name is Jolie Liston. I was here on Guam in the 90's to work on Tarague and Orote. I was here for 2 years. I'm here on Guam now for 4 years now. Most of my time was in the parts of Micronesia. I was a cultural research manager and archeologist for 28 years and I feel that my knowledge on the federal guidelines from both the federal and Micronesia standpoint will benefit the community.

CHAIRPERSON: Thank you Ms. Liston. Anyone have a comment or question?

<u>SENATOR NERISSA UNDERWOOD:</u> I just want to thank the both of you for accepting the nomination. What do you think are the critical policy issues that are facing the Guam Preservation Review Board?

MR. DAVID T. LOTZ: Critical issues...I think continuing the public education and ensuring our cultural resources are adequately preserved but also ensuring that we work with the private sector and the land use agencies because as we progress and develop, it's essential that we preserve our cultural resources.

<u>SENATOR NERISSA UNDERWOOD:</u> So when you're talking about public education are you looking at having them in the public school system?

MR. DAVID T. LOTZ: I'm looking at all public resources. It is important that people understand that cultural resources could be impacted.

SENATOR NERISSA UNDERWOOD: Jolie?

MS. JOLIE LISTON: I agree with Dave with respect to the public education. Education in a sense that archeology is a wholelistic study. It involves the heritage in a legacy of the past that goes into the environment and what the environment was in the past and how it involves us in the future. Making cultural resource management relative to today's issues.

SENATOR NERISSA UNDERWOOD: Thank you Jolie.

CHAIRPERSON: Senator Mary Torres do you have any questions or comments?

<u>SENATOR MARY TORRES:</u> Thank you Madam Chair. First of all, I want to thank you both for accepting the nomination. Mr. Lotz, Congratulations, I understand that you are a recipient of the 2012 Ancient Order of the Samurai?

DAVID T. LOTZ: Yes, thank you!

<u>SENATOR MARY TORRES:</u> You're welcome! That makes you almost blood. (audience laughs) I want to ask what your thoughts are on the artifacts that have been sent off island and removed from the island, what are your thoughts about bringing them back home?

DAVID T. LOTZ: I think it just should be done.

<u>JOLIE LISTON:</u> I think a well thought method of bringing them back and a well thought system in place of curation.



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<u>CHAIRPERSON:</u> She introduces GEDA members that have just arrived. Senator Espaldon do you have any questions?

<u>SENATOR JIM ESPALDON:</u> I have no questions Madam Chair only comments. Mr. Lotz, everyone knows you. I look forward to your involvement in the preservation of our culture. It's very important that you keep a keen eye out for our government. Mr. Lotz and Ms. Liston, thank you for putting yourselves forward. Thank you Madam Chair, that's my only comment.

<u>CHAIRPERSON:</u> You're welcome, thank you. Senator Rodriguez, do you have any questions or comments?

<u>SENATOR DENNIS RODRIGUEZ, JR.:</u> Thank you Madam Chair. I just want to thank you both for giving yourselves to the community. Mr. Lotz, I don't know you very well, but I know your wife Beverly and I want to thank her for her service to the GMHA volunteer association. That's all Madam Chair.

<u>CHAIRPERSON:</u> I too want to say thank you for stepping up to the plate to the both of you. For coming on board and accepting your appointment by the Governor. Your passion and love for our island in making sure that our preservation is done correctly is the main reason for your appointment to this board. I say to you both thank you!

<u>DR. KELLY MARSH TAITANO:</u> Hafa adai and as you mentioned, my name is Dr. Kelly Marsh Taitano. She reads her written testimony for Jolie Liston and David T. Lotz. (*written testimony attached*) I've actually been a member of this board and I know for a fact that these two individuals will go above and beyond. 





Senator Barnes:

I have recently been appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo to a second term of four years on the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board for the discipline of planning This appointment concurrently serves on the Board for the Guam Preservation Trust. I am thus appearing for confirmation by the Guam Legislature.

The Guam Historic Preservation Review Board has responsibilities under Federal and Guam law relative to protecting historic sites by listing on the Guam Register of Historic Places and nomination to the National Register of Historic Places. In addition, the Board reviews the broader requirements for preservation planning. Within the last year the Board approved the nomination of the Manenggon Concentration Camp to the National Register which was subsequently listed. In addition, the Board has reviewed and approved guidelines for our traditional cultural properties and cultural practices.

The Guam Preservation Trust has a mandate to preserve and restore cultural resources on our island. Currently the Trust is nearing completion of the historic Guam Legislature Building in Hagatna and restoring homes in historic Inarajan village.

My commitment to preserving the cultural resources of Guam originated with employment by the Department of Parks and Recreation from the 1970s into the 1990s. Subsequently, I was employed at Andersen Air Force Base with responsibilities comprising protecting natural and cultural resources.
