And if you know we change the confirmation hearing to the more medical you know my daughter has a rotator arm. Anyway, I was just looking at your resume and your application packet. I tell you filling it out by hand is great because you did not leave out anything. I don't have any questions I just want you to know that you have my full support and my vote and I hope that the Chairman will place your nomination on this coming session. Thank you very much again for coming home and making Guam & our future better where its gonna be. Thank you.

Chairman Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr: Thank You Senator Ada, Senator Aguon.

Senator Frank Aguon: Sometimes it would be appropriate to just say ditto but in this particular case the Vice Chair is very correct that thank you not only for coming back home and giving back to your community but most important you offer yourself to our island community in this particular capacity. The only question that I would normally post to an individual point is weather in fact he or she is able to make time for the meeting and make sure that in fact that to the course of the entire year you can be accountable to your service as a member of the board and most importantly to our people. I claim that from just your enthusiasm to be that physical therapy that you applied but I claim that to your enthusiasm and really from your testimony this morning so that question is not really post it but thank you again for offering yourself to our island community and most importantly in this very critical board. And we certainly or I look forward to your contribution to the next couple of years. Thank you very much Dr. Claros.

Dr. Claros: Thank you Senator Aguon.

Chairman Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr: Thank you Senator Aguon. Senator Morison or Senator McCreadie.

Senator Brant McCreadie: Thank you Mr. Chair. I want to thank you for taking the initiative to be appointed for the next 3 years. You know I have the experience of having 5 surgeries and I know what it's like to get rehabilitated and sit there for a year or 2. Two years on just trying to get back and so it's more important that you have knowledge here that maybe we didn't have before. As we grow in community numbers and you talk about rehabilitation and preventive measure that we can do to rehabilitate injured athlete but to curve childhood obesity, diabetes which is huge in Guam. You are a description of somebody who all we talk about in the next generation leading the way and the next generation making it better that this generation. And so you offer us something we don't have and I think that it's very important to note that when you do your job correctly and you go off island and you get educated and you come back and you want to use that institutional knowledge to the island of Guam, it's a no brainer. We have a bill



coming up in the south. What you do is you help people to live better healthy quality lifestyle and you save life and save money because in the long run you save money. You don't increase hospital bed you decrease it. So in the perfect world 10 to 20 years from now you have decrease hospital bed if you institute your program and your knowledge that you have in Guam. I don't have any questions, I just want to thank you and would like to see what happened at the end of your 3 years to see where we stand as far as healthier and better productive community so thank you very much, you have my full support.

Senator Mary Torres: Dr. Claros I just want to thank you very much for your commitment to serve on the board and I'm looking at your very excellent resume and listening to your testimony, seeing your very professional demeanor. 
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



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Hafa Adai and good morning Senator Rodriguez,

Members of the Committee on Health, Ladies and gentlemen,

I am grateful and fortunate to talk before the Committee on Health on my appointment as the Physical Therapist representative to the Guam Board of Allied Health.

I would first like to thank the Honorable Eddie Baza Calvo for appointing me to be the Physical Therapy representative to the Guam Board of Allied Health.

My name is Ryan Robert Menidola Claros. I was born and raised in Guam, attending both parochial and public school from kindergarten though 12th grade. I graduated from Father Duenas Memorial High School in 1998 and attended the University of Guam for two semesters prior to leaving to San Diego, Ca where I lived from 2000-2012. While living stateside I was able gain great experience and a wealth of knowledge obtaining a B.S degree in Kinesiology with an emphasis in Fitness, Nutrition and Health, a M.S degree in Exercise Physiology; both from San Diego State University and a Doctoral Degree in Physical Therapy from the University of Saint Augustine for Health Sciences.

Upon returning to the island in early 2013, I have partnered to form Custom Fitness, LLC. Guam's only multidisciplinary facility which fills the gaps of health and wellness that people are not aware of or knowledgeable about. Additionally, I currently work at the University of Guam as a full-time Assistant Professor in the School of Nursing and Health Sciences and also as the advisor for all pre-Physical Therapy students.

This is my first appointment to any Government of Guam related board I am excited not only to learn from the rest of the board members but also to contribute. My

main interest is to advocate for the profession of Physical Therapy. Not only are there a very limited number of Physical Therapy practices available, but residents are also unaware of the "value" of Physical Therapy.

Here is an excerpt taken from the American Physical Therapy Association (APTA) on the value of a PT.

"Physical therapists help patients regain function in their daily lives. Physical therapy is also a highly effective alternative to prescription medication and surgery for many conditions. PTs commonly work with patients to alleviate pain correlated with the neck, shoulders, lower back, and knees in addition to providing low cost options for the treatment of chronic conditions. Research shows that individuals who receive regular physical therapy treatment experience greater improvement in function and decreased pain intensity."

I would like to be able to give back to the island that has given me so much and I hope that I can help by being an advocate for Physical Therapy. I believe the benefits of Physical Therapy are life changing and can drastically improve the quality of life for the people of Guam.

Again, I would like to thank Senator Rodriguez and the Members of the Committee on Health for allowing me this opportunity to speak before you all.

The Committee will accept oral and written testimony on the following:

*The Executive Appointment of Mr. William Castro to serve as the Director of the Bureau of Statistics and Plans.

*The Executive Appointment of Dr. Ryan Claros, DTP, as the Physical Therapist Representative on the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners.

*Bill No. 51-33 (COR) - By Sen. B.T. McCreadie - An act to add a new § 80125 to Chapter 80, Division 4, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the establishment of *I Espitåt Håya* in the South, and for other purposes; to amend §§ 97103(a) and 97102(e) of Chapter 97, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, relative to funding for *I Espitåt Håya*; to add a new § 3809.1 of Chapter 3, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, relative to requiring the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) to enter into a contractual arrangement with the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for the shared use of underutilized resources and facilities at the Southern Regional Community Health Center (SRCHC) in *Inalåhan* (Inarajan), in order to facilitate establishment of *I Espitåt Håya*; and to repeal and re-enact § 3810 of Chapter 3, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, relative to requiring DPHSS and GMHA to conduct an annual assessment on the need for and feasibility of providing extended medical services at the Northern Regional Community Health Center (NRCHC).
