



II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. stated that the Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Library and Women's Affairs will conduct a public hearing on: the Appointment of Tes Reyes-Burrier as a Member, Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency (CAHA), the Appointment of Francis J. Guerrero as a Member, Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency (CAHA), the Appointment of Eloy P. Hara as a Member, Guam Community College Board of Trustees.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. mentioned that a 5 day notice was sent on June 3, 2015 and a 48 hour notice was sent on June 8, 2015 and that all testimonies should be addressed to Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D. and will be accepted via hand delivery at the Speaker's office; Speaker's mailbox

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. stated on record that written testimony was received by Bruce E. Pecon, Enrique C. Cruz, Deborah Belanger, and President Mary Okada.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. called up Carmen Santos, CPA and Mr. Eloy P. Hara.

Ms. Carmen Santos, VP Finance & Administration at Guam Community College testified on behalf of Dr. Mary Okada, President of GCC. Her written testimony is appended to the committee report.

Mr. Eloy P. Hara also testified in support of his own nomination. He stated, "Thank you, Madam Speaker, for giving me this opportunity to testify on my own behalf for my nomination as board of trustee for Guam Community College." His written testimony is appended to the Committee Report.

Mr. Eloy P. Hara stated, "However, because in both my application and brief biography, there are details that are not incorporated but would add to being able to accomplishing my position as board of trustees. As an example, I've lived in 12 states of the United States and 10 different countries throughout my Navy career and my life. Most especially living in that many states in the United States, if you notice in my resume, I did 10 colleges and universities in practically every state that I lived in. So I have a very extensive know how a higher institution works and functions. This would be very helpful because wherever I've gone I've learned by listening and viewing and being a part of the institution. So another detail that is not in there is that I was a high school student in Guam in 1953. High school back then had a program called the Industrial Arts which comprised, and I took all the following courses: Basic Woodwork; Automotive Mechanic; Basic Electricity; Body and Fender, and I even took Home Economics. I was the only male student in a class of 30 girls taking home economics, cooking, sewing ironing, and things like that. So similarly the Guam Community College is an institution, too, that promotes that kind of basic knowledge apart from academia like the University of Guam. So I do have all of those backgrounds. Another thing, during my tour, with both the Guam Power and as the assistant general manager and also as the executive director of Guam Civil Service Commission, I not only revised and updated the Guam Power Authority's policy and procedures manual, which took me 2 years to accomplish, I also, when I was Civil Service's executive director, I guided and helped facilitate the update of Department of Administration's rules and regulation policies and procedures. It's something I took up on myself, with the permission of Department of Administration director, which was Bill Aflague at the time. So I do go out of my way and out of my so-called little fence when it was necessary for me to reach out and assist other agencies towards accomplishing work. And another part that is only shown in my resume is that I was a member of American Water Works Authority and attended their seminars, and conferences 4 times a year. And the American Public Power, Public Utilities Commission, also

under the APPA, I was a member of the executive management committee. We are the committee that actually scheduled all the conferences, seminars, and training for the entire American public power of the United States, which includes Guam, Virgin Islands, and Puerto Rico. So I do have all of those extensive backgrounds in both education and training. And networking is one of the biggest strength in attending all these national institutions. Because I'm able to network, I don't know everything myself, but whenever there is something I need to find out, it's very easy for me to call certain people, certain places, and certain positions and I can get all the answers. So I have all those kind of strengths that I believe I can use very well into promoting and improving Guam Community College and continue to move it further. And, honestly, since I was appointed, I started looking and reading up on Guam Community College and Dr. Okada has done a tremendous job. And I would like to join her team in continuing that progress as she moves on. More recently, she's going into this project now where she and the University of Guam have tasked Guam Power, for example, to install renewable energy throughout the campus. And having just left the Consolidated Commission on Utilities, there really wouldn't be anybody better to coordinate the effort between Guam Power Authority, the University of Guam, and Guam Community College in accomplishing and installing, for example, the solar and wind power to power up both the Guam Community College and the University of Guam. So all of those experiences, I'm bringing over to Guam Community College. With that, I now ask that your committee highly supports my nomination and hopefully confirm my appointment and thank you in advance for hopefully a positive support. Thank you, Madam Speaker."

Mr. Eloy P. Hara also spoke about having spoken with Jane Flores and understanding about programs that have moved from Guam Community College into all of Guam's high schools. He has an idea of trying to enhance those concepts in the high schools. Speaker Won Pat acknowledged the existence of the programs in the high schools and recalls when the programs began in middle/junior high school and how those courses have shifted to different courses now. Speaker Won Pat discussed about conversations with families who speak about the children who are currently ill equipped with every day skills – losing basic survival skills that we would like our kids to have to be prepared to head out into the world.

Mr. Eloy P. Hara also continued and spoke of his grandson who is great with his hands and model handiwork, and while is a high school graduate and JROTC participant, he isn't able to attend college because he doesn't have the aptitude. He encouraged him to get a certificate from GCC to be able to get a better job. Speaker Won Pat responded acknowledging how we can help advance those like his grandson and woman she has heard of that wish to be able to learn basic skills in a short course. Speaker Won Pat acknowledged Mr. Hara's background and wealth of knowledge, and hopes those tools could aid.

Mr. Eloy P. Hara spoke of being married to a native Indian and recalls CEDARS, and parallels it to his experience with Native American work with automotive programs and the likes under the Native American Indian program. He concluded that he is a hands-on person and wishes to be able to facilitate the programs.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. also concluded by stating her hopes that Mr. Hara will be able to take his knowledge and experience and work with other departments. She thanked Mr. Hara for accepting the nomination.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Library, and Women's Affairs to which was referred the appointment of Eloy P. Hara as Member, Guam Community College Board of Trustees does hereby report out with the recommendation To CONFIRM.





ELOY P. HARA (Biography)

Director Eloy Perez Hara is a Guam native who presently resides at Sinajana Village with his wife Consolacion Crisostomo Hara. They have five children, three live in the mainland U.S., in Kansas and Oklahoma, and two daughters in Chalan Pago, Guam; the Hara's have eight grandchildren. Director Hara was recently the Vice-Chairman of the Consolidated Commission of Utilities (CCU) for GWA from January 2007 to January 2015. Director Hara was also recently President and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of International Technology, Incorporated dba ITI – Power \$avers, which he co-founded.

Director Hara is a graduate of George Washington High School, Mongmong, Guam and then attended Father Duenas Memorial Seminar (FDMS) for two years. At FDMS he completed college preparatory courses prior to attending Saint Lawrence College at Mount Calvary, Wisconsin. 


