

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D stated on record, “Buenas yan Hafa Adai: The Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Library and Women’s Affairs will conduct a public hearing on: the Appointment of Tes Reyes-Burrier as a Member, Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency (CAHA), the Appointment of Francis J. Guerrero as a Member, Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency (CAHA), the Appointment of Eloy P. Hara as a Member, Guam Community College Board of Trustees.”

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. mentioned that a 5 day notice was sent on June 3, 2015 and a 48 hour notice was sent on June 8, 2015 and that all testimonies should be addressed to Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D. and will be accepted via hand delivery at the Speaker's office; Speaker's mailbox at reproduction room of the Main Legislature Building at 155 Hesler Place, Hagatna, Guam 96910; or fbtorres@judiwonpat.com or through facsimile at 472-3589.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. called up Monica Guzman, Mark A. Murer, Don Muna, Joseph Artero Cameron, and Francis Guerrero. Speaker mentioned that if it is a written testimony that a copy should be submitted so it can be appended to the committee report. Speaker Judith T. Won Pat Ed.D. also mentioned to state your name, whether you are representing yourself, agency, or an organization and if you are in support of the nominee

Mrs. Monica Guzman is in full support of Mr. Guerrero’s nomination; her written testimony is appended to the committee report.

Mr. Don Muna is in full support of Mr. Guerrero’s nomination. He is the founder of the Guam International Film Festival. He has known Francis for about 6 years, which is a significant year, because Mr. Don Muna and his brother Kel Muna founded the GIFF along with JD Iriarte. More so, 6 years ago, Francis was one of many, who helped with GIFF which is something good for Guam, something honest. He also mentioned that GIFF provides not only for our community but also internationally. Mr. Muna also mentioned that hundreds and thousands of videos were submitted from over 55 countries over the world and as the only tier film festival throughout the Western Pacific Region. He is in full support of the nomination for Francis J. Guerrero.

Joseph Artero Cameron is in full support; his written testimony is appended to the committee report.

Mr. Mark Murer is in full support; his written testimony is appended to the committee report.

Mr. Francis Guerrero is humbled to be a nominee as a member of CAHA. He is a native CHamoru- locally bred and locally fed. He mentioned that when he thinks of CAHA and everything that they do, there are so many things that he has done to help promote, preserve, and perpetuate culture, arts, and our people. He is very proud of his accomplishments. He mentioned the agility and passion of our people and our culture and that there are so many programs out

there, like GVB with the branding program that has a lot to do for speaking for Guam, globally. He mentioned that what artists do are part of what Guam has to offer to showcase ourselves. He also mentioned what CAHA does to assist our artists is significant and important when the Museum comes up there are going to be things we need to showcase our people with. He is passionate and drives hard in everything he does. He grew up entertaining, learning to sing songs in CHamoru; he was not born in the generation that spoke the language. He also mentioned that growing up he represented the island in goodwill trips and representing Guam to show people what Guam stands for. Since then every opportunity he has held, every position that he has worked with he has tried to use them as a vehicle in promoting the culture. He mentioned that DFS stands out there as one that pushes constantly recognizing and bringing people forward showcasing to our visitors what Guam really is about. The artisans of Guam program that he started 4 years ago have been very prolific. He also mentioned that from that program was born Guam Unique Merchandise Art concept. He goes on saying that GVB has worked hard partnering because of the merits of the program. He mentioned that he had exposure with the CAHA, small grant review committee, when one of the board members asked to assist. He also mentioned that he has a lot in his background where he did presentations on the Guam Museum and the one village one product. He is very excited about serving in the board with the consent of the legislature.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. mentioned that when you look at your application, it is very relevant that you are proud of your culture, you're part of the museum foundation. Speaker mentioned that we are looking at the completion of e early next year and to get the museum ready for FESTPAC and for the people of Guam. Speaker mentioned that Mr. Guerrero's background to use his skills and ideas to completion.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. mentioned that hearing the testimonies provided and by helping other artists like the Muna brothers and Mr. Mark Murer, that she will definitely support Mr. Guerrero's confirmation.
