



Committee Report Digest

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Library, and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on Tuesday, February 2, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. On the agenda was the consideration on the Appointment of Frank P. Arriola; Member, Guam Community College Board of Trustees.

Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators; 5 days notice was sent on January 26, 2016 and the 48 hours notice was sent on January 29, 2016 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.

Began by thanking Vice Chair of the Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Libraries, and Women's Affairs, Senator Nerissa Underwood; and fellow colleagues, Senator Brant McCreadie; Senator Mary Torres for attending.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. announced that the purpose of the hearing to hear two appointments – for Frank P. Arriola and Gina Y. Ramos to serve as members of the Guam Community College (GCC) Board of Regents Board of Trustees – and Bill 235-33 (LS), Relative to the operational start up costs for the Guam Museum; Bill 242-33 (COR), relative to interim admission, events, and membership fees for the Guam Museum; and Bill 245-33, relative to authorizing the Guam Public Library System to lease the portion of the building referred to as the "Internet Café" for the purpose of operating and managing a high quality and reasonably priced café.

After confirming that all notices of public hearing were sent out and after announcing that all testimonies may be sent via electronic mail or hand-delivered to her office, or hand delivered to Reproduction at the address of the Guam Legislature Building, Speaker began the hearing.

Starting with the first appointee, Mr. Frank P. Arriola, Speaker Won Pat called up Mr. Eloy Hara, Gina Ramos, and Dr. Okada to testify; and finally, Mr. Frank P. Arriola.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. acknowledged and thanked Senator Tommy Morrison for joining the hearing.

Mr. Eloy P. Hara

Current board member of GCC Board of Trustees, Mr. Eloy Hara, expressed his support for the appointment of Mr. Frank Arriola. Mr. Hara indicated that Chairperson, Deborah Belanger, had submitted a written testimony, and that he would like to read that on behalf of Ms. Belanger, and then speak a few minutes on his own in support of Mr. Hara. Refer to the submitted written testimony for the reappointment of Mr. Frank Arriola.

Mr. Hara then continued to read GCC Board of Regents Board of Trustees Chairperson Bollinger's testimony for Mr. Gina Ramos' reappointment. Refer to the submitted written testimony for the reappointment of Ms. Gina Ramos.

Mr. Hara expressed that while he just recently began serving on the Board of Trustees, in the short time that he has served, both Mr. Arriola and Ms. Ramos have proved to be an asset to the Board and in fulfilling GCC's mission. Hr. Hara strongly supports both Mr. Arriola and Ms. Ramos' appointment.

Ms. Gina Y. Ramos

Current board member of GCC Board of Trustees, Ms. Ramos, expressed support of Mr. Frank Arriola's reappointment. Refer to submitted written testimony for the reappointment of Mr. Frank Arriola.

Dr. Mary Okada

GCC president, Dr. Okada, greeted and thanked the Senators on the panel before expressing her support for Mr. Arriola and the ways in which his business expertise have been invaluable and greatly benefited the collage. Refer to submitted written testimony for the reappointment of Mr. Frank Arriola.

Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.

Thanked the panel for their testimonies, informed that there were no questions at that time, and moved to call Mr. Arriola for his testimony.

Mr. Frank P. Arriola

Thanked the panel of senators for the opportunity to testify before introducing himself; expressing gratitude for serving the Collage; and expressing approval to serve a third term on the GCC Board of Regents Board of Trustees. Refer to submitted written testimony for the reappointment of Mr. Frank Arriola.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. Asked Mr. Arriola, it being his third term, why he was interested to serving yet another.

Mr. Frank P. Arriola

Expressed that he was interested in serving yet another term on the Board of Regents Board of Trustees because he was passionate about the College, and about participating and learning more about the needs of students and the future of the island's workforce.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. Went on to ask about Arriola's attendance and participation.

Mr. Frank P. Arriola

Responded that his attendance has been excellent, and that most of the times that he missed a meeting, it was to attend off-island GCC trainings, functions, or community colleges conferences, at which Speaker Won Pat expressed her appreciation for Arriola's time, in response, before calling on Vice Chair Underwood for any comments.

Senator N.B. Underwood

Inquired with Arriola, since he had experience serving on the GCC Board of Regents Board of Trustees as well as the Tri Board, about the identification of the common core of data shared between DOE, UOG and GCC for the purpose of conducting longitudinal studies to track the success of institutions. Underwood asked the question of where the Board is regarding proposed policy for this.

Dr. Mary Okada

Explained that individuals from the educational research office met with reps from DOE and UOG to talk about the common data that needs to be identified; and, that recently they met to participate in a potential grant opportunity. She informed, however, that it was decided the grant was not going to be submitted by DOE. There have since been several meetings dedicated to the discussion of common core data and, Okada expressed, it just needs to be followed up on.

Mr. Arriola

Responded, expressing the Board – as well as the President – supports the proposal. Arriola reiterated GCC's commitment to providing students the pathway they need to succeed.

Senator N.B. Underwood

Based on Arriola's experience serving as a member on the Board and witnessing the many successes GCC has had, Underwood inquired of the challenges of he has encountered.

Mr. Frank P. Arriola

Acknowledged that the program runs efficiently with its leadership and that the biggest challenge, in response to Underwood, is trying to anticipate where the school will need to be to remain accredited. He assured that as facility and property manager, he assists with the budget, timelines, and its and potential impacts on students.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. Welcomed Senator V. Anthony Tony Ada.

Senator Brant McCreadie

Acknowledged Arriola's passion and added that Arriola is also very committed, before recognizing Arriola's goal to improve and recognizing the Board and the President's work in employing capital improvements. McCreadie expressed strong support.

Senator Mary Torres

Indicated her full support and expressed that the GCC Board of Regent Board of Trustees has a very successful formula. She ended by expressing her "si yu'os ma'åse" to Arriola for willingness to continue serving.

Senator Thomas A. Morrison

Gave his full support, acknowledging the headway GCC has made and also the commitment Arriola has given to supporting and helping kids in his coaching.

Senator Tony Ada

Expressed his full support and thanked Arriola for taking the Governor's call to serve on this Board, and for his commitment and accomplishments.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.

Mentioned that Ms. Lourdes M. Perez provided written testimony. She also acknowledged Ms. Deborah Belanger, and asked if she would like to speak in addition to the written testimony that was read on her behalf earlier.

Ms. Deborah Belanger

Thanked the Senators for their support and expressed how proud she was to work with such a hard-working and cohesive Board.

Speaker Won Pat Ed.D is in full support of the confirmation hearing and concluded the public hearing at 11:43 a.m. and also mentioned if there are additional letters of support to email it to <u>fbtorres@judiwonpat.com</u>. 



- Bill No. 242-33 (COR): An act to add a new Subsection (y) to §87104 of Chapter 87 of Title 5 Guam Code Annotated, relative to interim admission, event, and membership fees for the Guam Museum.
- Bill No. 245-33 (COR) An act to add a new Subsection (a)(1) to section 80128 of Chapter 80, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to authorizing the Guam Public Library System to lease the portion of the building referred to as the "Internet Café" for the purpose of operating and managing a high quality and reasonably priced Café.
